# Marlow 2 Drawer Storage Bed



## Important before assembly: Read these instructions carefully before assembling or using the product.

Please check the contents of the boxes before attempting to assemble this product. The instructions will have a checklist of parts and fittings.

It would be sensible to lay a rug or a carpet on the floor where you intend to assemble the product, to void scratches and damaging the product or the floor.

Assemble the product as close to its intended final location/room as possible.

Do NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame.

#### Health & Safety:

This product or some parts of this product will be heavy. Please use an assistant when lifting.

DO NOT jump on the product or any of its parts.


DO NOT use this product if any parts are missing, damaged or worn.

Please keep small parts out of reach of children.


Always use on a level, even surface.




These tools are not necessary, but may help to assemble certain parts of the product.

Do NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame.







This product or some parts of this product will be heavy. Please use an assistant when lifting.



\* There is one CSK screw 16mm as spares.


Step 1: Join together the drawer front (9), drawer back (10) and drawer side (12) using hardware part K and screwdriver (not provided). Repeat for the remaining drawer.

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 2 : Slide the drawer base (11) into position on all both drawer . Secure with hardware part  ${\sf F}$  and small mallet ( not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage




Step 3 : Secure the drawer support (13) using hardware part J and screwdriver( not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 4: Attach the drawer runner from pack 1 (7) using hardware part H and screwdriver( not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 5: Attach the drawer runners (8) to the drawer holder side panels (14) using hardware part H and a screwdriver (not provided). DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage

the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 6: Insert hardware parts A and G to the drawer holder side panels (14) using a small mallet (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 7: Insert hardware parts A and G to the drawer holder mid panels (15) using a small mallet (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.





Step 8: Insert hardware parts A to the drawer base support panels (16) using a small mallet (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 9: Secure the drawer holder panels & drawer holder mid panels & drawer base support panels together as shown using hardware parts B and L.






Step 10: Insert hardware part C to the side rails (3) using a screwdriver (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 11: Attach the assembled drawer holder frame to the side rails (3). DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 12: Using hardware parts D , L and M then insert hardware part  ${\sf E}$  as shown.

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 13: Attach the legs (6) to the headend (1) and footend (2).


 $\operatorname{DO}$  NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 14: Secure the frame using hardware parts L ,M and N. DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Step 15: Attach the centre rail (5) to the headend (1) and footend (2) using hardware part I and a screwdriver(not provided)



Step 16: Attach the slats (4) to the side rails (3) and centre rail (5) using hardware parts O and P.Insert the assembled drawers to the bed frame.



Please dispose of all packaging safely.

#### **General Care & Maintenance**

Wipe clean with a slightly damp cloth. Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

Periodically check all screw & fixings to ensure they are secure.

When moving your product, carefully lift into place. Never drag or push the pieces across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints and could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.
