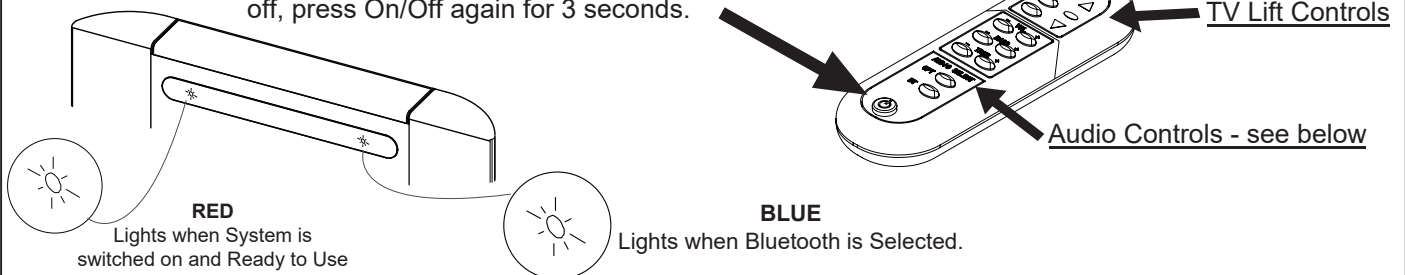
SOUND SYSTEM CONTROL

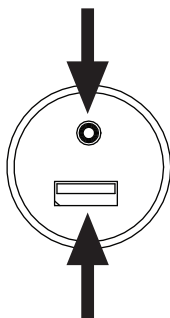
To turn system on, press this On/Off button for 3 seconds.

At end of watching TV, lower the TV to it's resting position and TV will switch off automatically. Music can still be heard so to switch system off, press On/Off again for 3 seconds.



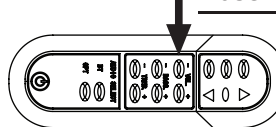

IMPORTANT: Be careful to keep the two HDMI Leads (H) on top of the Base Boards - Main power lead (G) and Aerial lead (J) should be kept under the base boards & fed out under the Headboard so you can connect to your wall sockets.

Make certain cables are not trapped under the Base Board Support Rails.

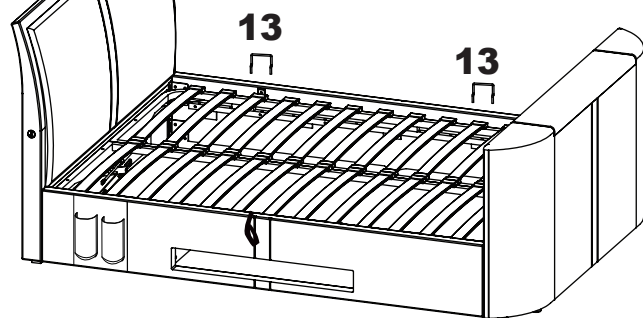
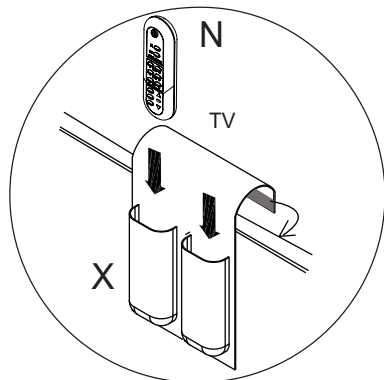
Note: Be very careful what you store under the bed - the top of an item, like a suitcase or a box must not touch the slats or they may be damaged. Maximum storage height is 240mm.



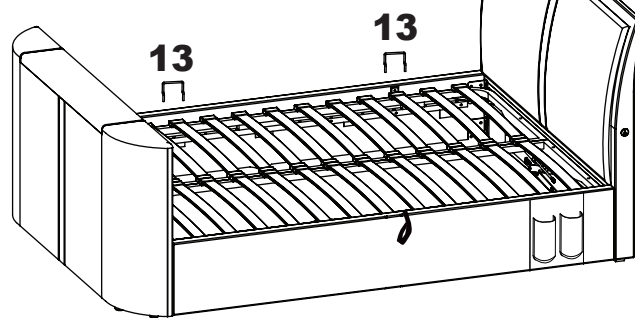
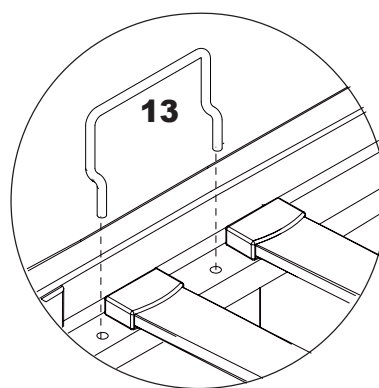
NOTE: Before moving the slat frame, mattress must be placed on the slats as the speed of upward movement is very high and may cause injury. Lift frame with the hand-strap then slowly push down ensuring the edges are aligned with the side panels. If not aligned, check bed is still square (see Step 4). Depending on the weight of the mattress, the speed of the lift will vary so be careful until you get used to the speed. Always use the strap to lift or lower the frame - keep fingers well away from the moving parts.

NOTE: With mattress in place, move the frame up & down five times to lubricate the pistons.

TV BED SAFETY INFORMATION



GENERAL INFORMATION

It is very important not to place any vessel containing liquids, e.g. drinks or vase of flowers, on top of the TV footboard which may accidentally spill and enter the TV compartment as this could cause damage to the TV and/or the TV lifting equipment.

If this happens, please contact your retailer.

Do not expose the bed to an undue level of heat - keep away from radiators.

Never allow anyone to sit on the foot end of the bed - keep children well away from moving parts.

To keep bed clean, we recommend that it be wiped over with a slightly dampened cloth or if fabric, use a light vacuum cleaner; disconnect power before cleaning.

Supplied with the bed is a remote control to operate the TV Lift and when you fit your own TV there is a remote control to operate it as well. Both these remotes use batteries - there are no batteries in the rest of the equipment.

There are strict controls for disposal of batteries - your local council can advise on how to safely dispose of them.

Never burn batteries on an open fire as they could explode.

IMPORTANT POWER INFORMATION

It is essential that the Mains Power Lead (G) is connected to an earthed socket be it a wall socket or extension lead - otherwise there is risk of damage or even electric-shock.

The socket providing the power must be accessible at all times in case you need to switch off the power quickly.

During an electrical or lightening storm - disconnect the power completely as a precaution.

Always un-plug the power when going on holiday or when the bed is not used for an extended period.

If you have young children in the home always disconnect the power at the wall socket for extra safety.

Power outlets, extension leads or adapters must not be overloaded beyond their limit - this can result in fire or electric shock.

Leads supplied with this bed, or other approved mains powered extension leads used to power the equipment, must not be placed where they can be walked on - this is dangerous and could lead to accidents.

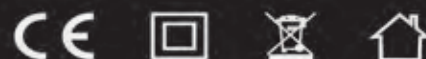
Do not interfere with or modify any cables already fitted and do not add any extra media leads unless they are routed through the ducts as shown in Step 9. All leads must be tightly connected to back of TV, never hanging loose.

Never touch moving parts or any part of the equipment - if something needs to be checked, disconnect the power first.

Do not insert anything into the footboard as this could seriously damage the TV and/or the TV lifting equipment and could, if done carelessly, cause serious damage or injury.

If the equipment doesn't operate normally or if there is any unusual noises, disconnect the power.

TV BED SAFETY INFORMATION



TELEVISION INSTALLATION

Before fixing the slats frame to the bed, please follow the television installation instructions below.

Raise the TV Lift by pressing the TOP button of the remote control.

Connect the TV using the TV Installation hardware packed in the accessory box in Carton 2.

Connect the TV to the mounting bracket plate as in Step 10 or 11.

If necessary, mounting plate can easily be adjusted to move TV up or down.

Connect the TV Power Lead (supplied with TV) by passing plug down one of the ducts, plugging it into the power adapter (if one is supplied with the TV) then into the TV power socket which is on the face of footboard - see Step 3.

This socket is only to be used for the TV as the supply is not constant.

Connect the Aerial & HDMI cable (H&J) by passing down the appropriate duct - see Step 9 & 12.

If required, connect your own media cables through either of the ducts - connect your media equipment when ready.

Please use the cable clips & cable ties (K&L) to make certain there are no loose wires to snag or get trapped.

The TV can now be operated following the TV Operation Guide supplied with your TV.

When finished viewing, lower the TV back into the footboard by pressing DOWN button of the remote control.

The TV will retract into the footboard automatically - power shall be turned off when TV reaches the bottom.

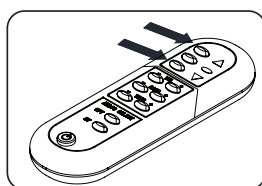
When the UP button is pressed - the TV Lifting Column rises and power to the TV turns back on automatically.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

IMPORTANT: Care should be taken when connecting electrical items. If in any doubt please consult an approved electrician to advise you on the electrical supply to achieve safe connections, to the electrical equipment of the TV Bed.

If your equipment does not operate please check all the power connections, to the wall and to the socket in the footboard. Make sure TV is switched on. (Note: TV will only work when it is in the up position).

Occasionally you may find the radio wave connection between remote control and TV Lift is lost, probably due to atmospheric conditions. In that case please follow these simple instructions:



- ①. Disconnect all mains electric power to the bed, for at least 60 seconds.
- ②. Press UP or DOWN Button on Remote Control and keep holding button down, simultaneously re-connect mains electric power to bed keeping button down for at least a further 5 seconds. TV Lift unit receives signal from Remote Control and lift will begin to move UP or DOWN whichever direction is appropriate.
- ③. Re-connection is now completed.

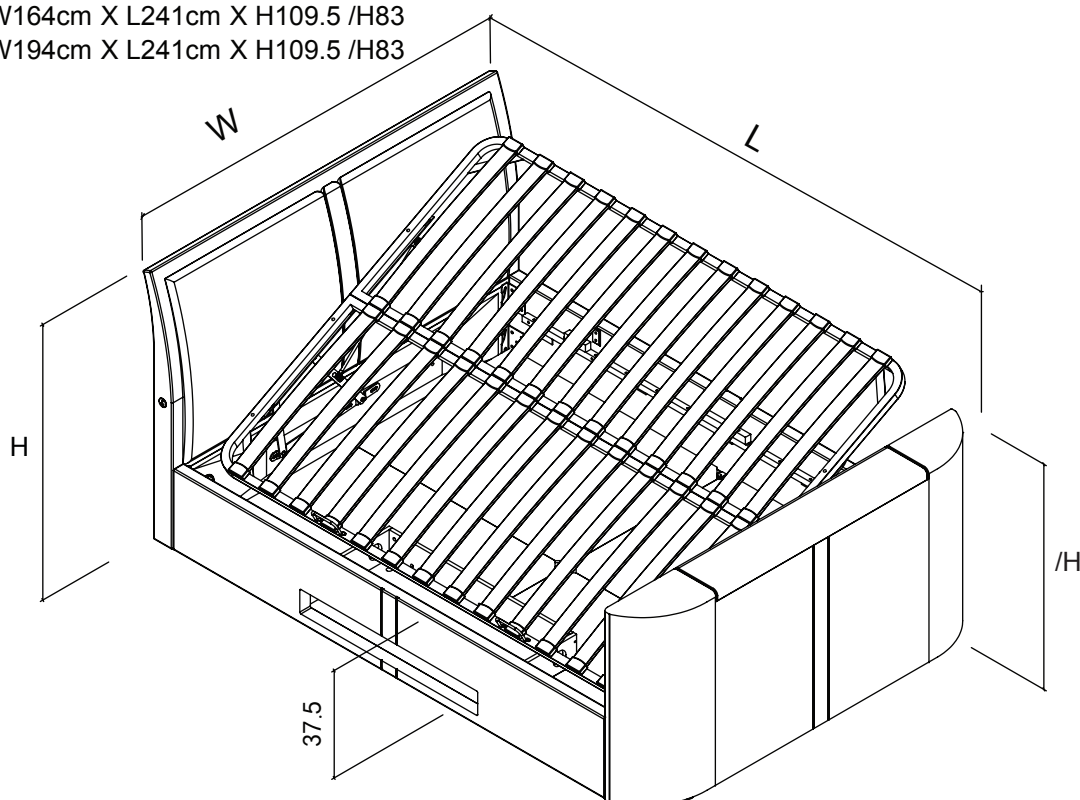

- TAKE CARE WHEN MOVING THE FURNITURE AND NEVER DRAG THE PIECES ACROSS THE FLOOR, AS THIS WILL CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE JOINTS.

We cannot be held responsible for any damage caused to the TV, TV cabling or the TV Bed itself due to incompatibility of any additional equipment installed by the end-user or due to loose and poorly installed cables (see Step 9). 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Important for Ottoman and other gas lift beds

Please follow these final steps to ensure the best experience with your new bed

- Please ensure the pistons are fitted to the bed frame.
- Please place the mattress on top of the bed frame.
- Standing at the foot of the frame (looking at the headboard) open the base and the press quite forcefully down on the mattress – please do not attempt to do this without the mattress being in place.
- Please do not pull on the strap handles.
- Please note as the pistons are full of gas – you will need to press heavily to release the compressed gas.
- Once done the pistons should start operating as normal.



Please dispose of all packaging safely.

General Care & Maintenance

Wipe clean with a slightly damp cloth.
Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

Periodically check all screw & fixings to ensure they are secure.

When moving your product, carefully lift into place. Never drag or push the product across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints. If the product is used on hard flooring, such as wood or laminated floor, you must place some protection under the legs to stop the product from moving. If this is not adhered to, it could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.
