Please check the contents of the boxes before attempting to assemble this product. The instructions will have a checklist of parts and fittings.

Assemble the product as close to its intended final location/room as possible.

Always use on a level, even surface.

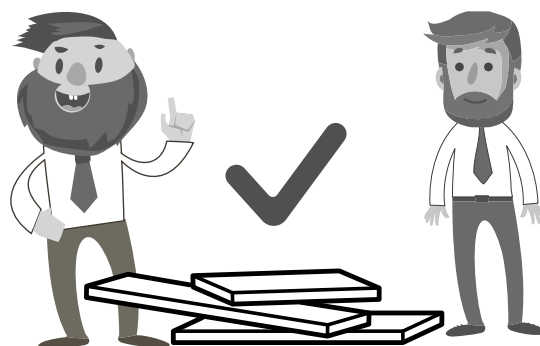
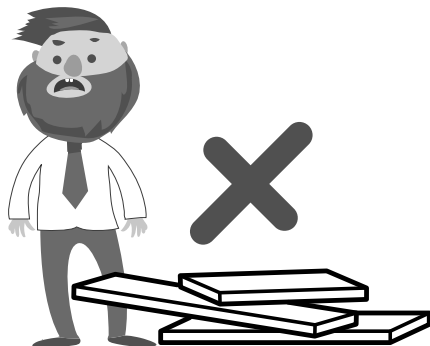
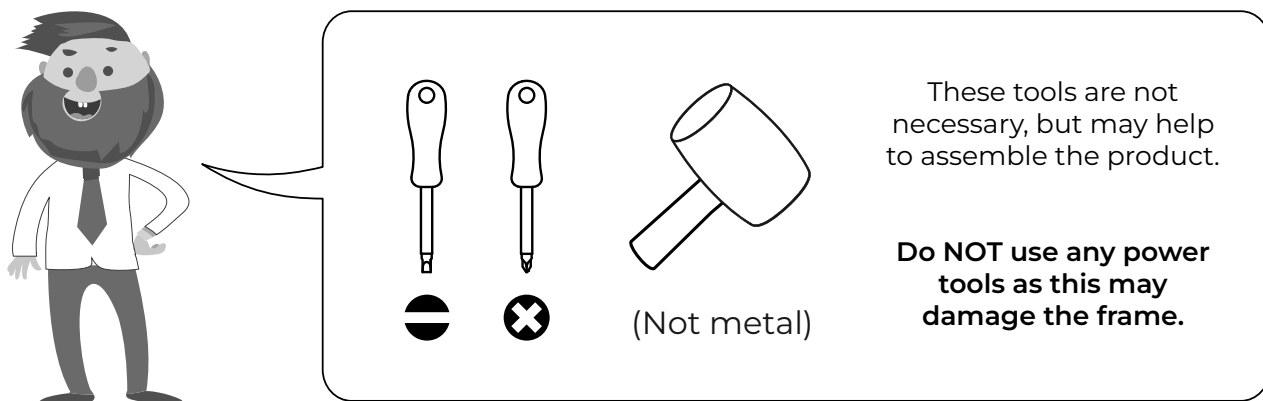

DO NOT use this product if any parts are missing, damaged or worn.

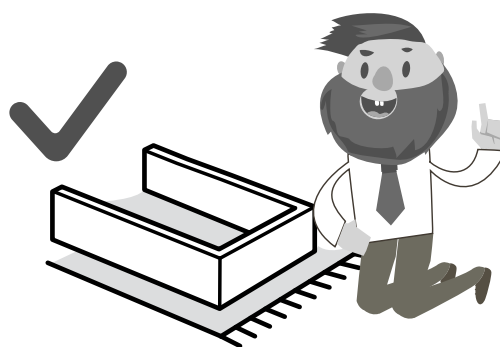
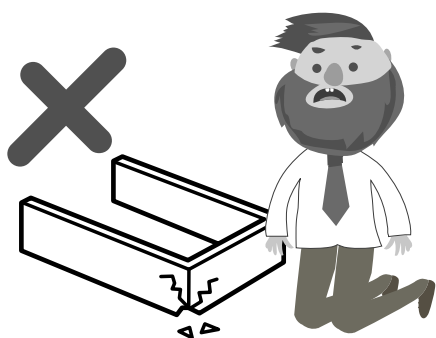










Never drag or push the pieces across a hard or stone floor as this will cause damage to the joints. Use a carpet or a rug for extra care.



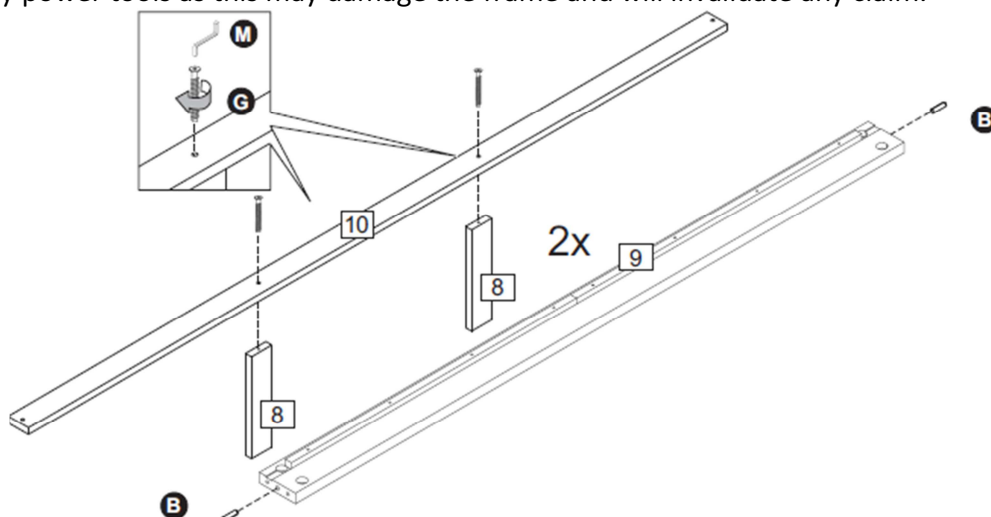

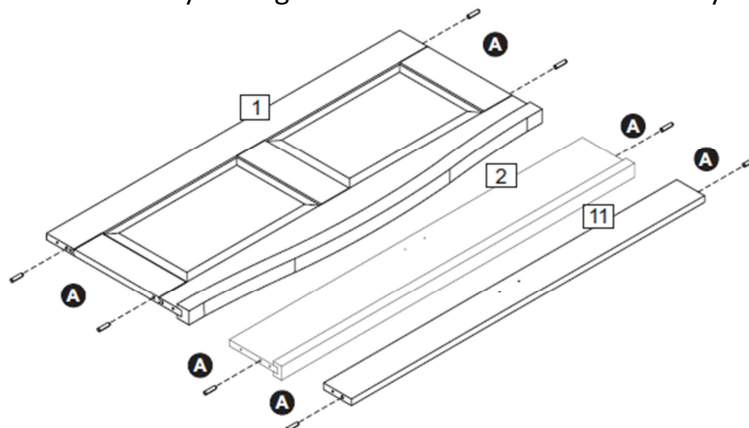

Step 1: Attach the support legs (8) to the centre rail (10) using hardware parts G and M. Insert hardware part B using a small mallet (not provided).

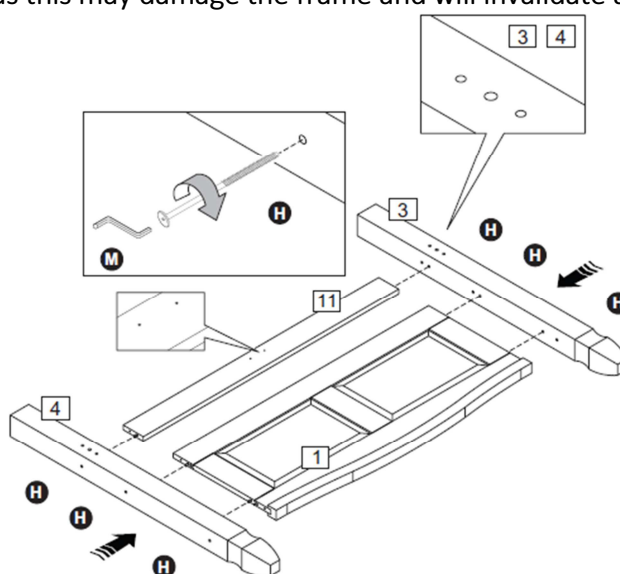
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



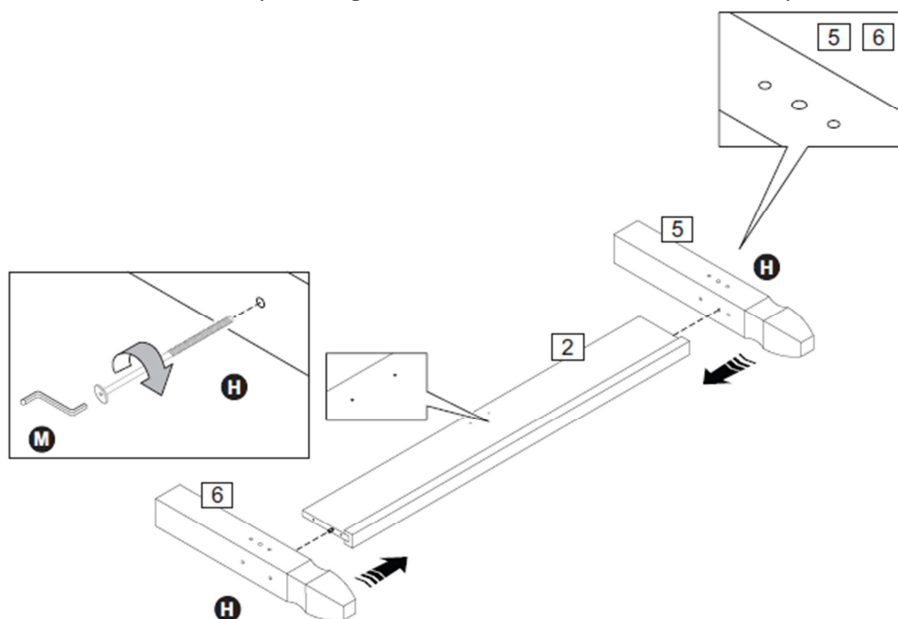
Step 2: Insert hardware part A using a small mallet (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



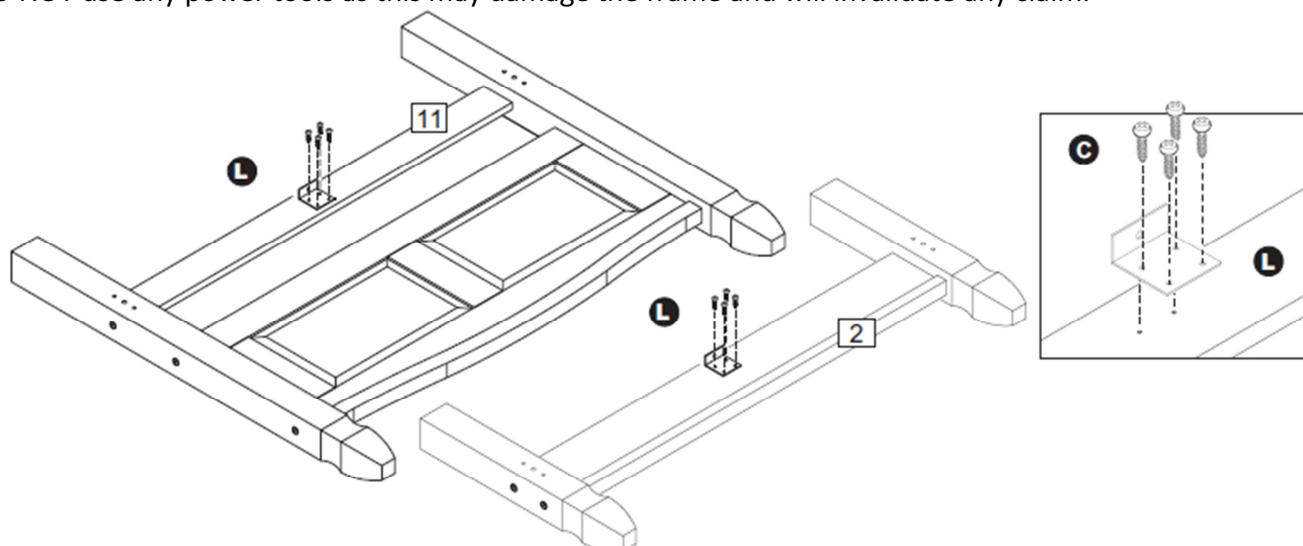
Step 3: Attach the left headend post (3) and right headend post (4) to the headend panel (1) and headend rail (11) using hardware parts H and M.
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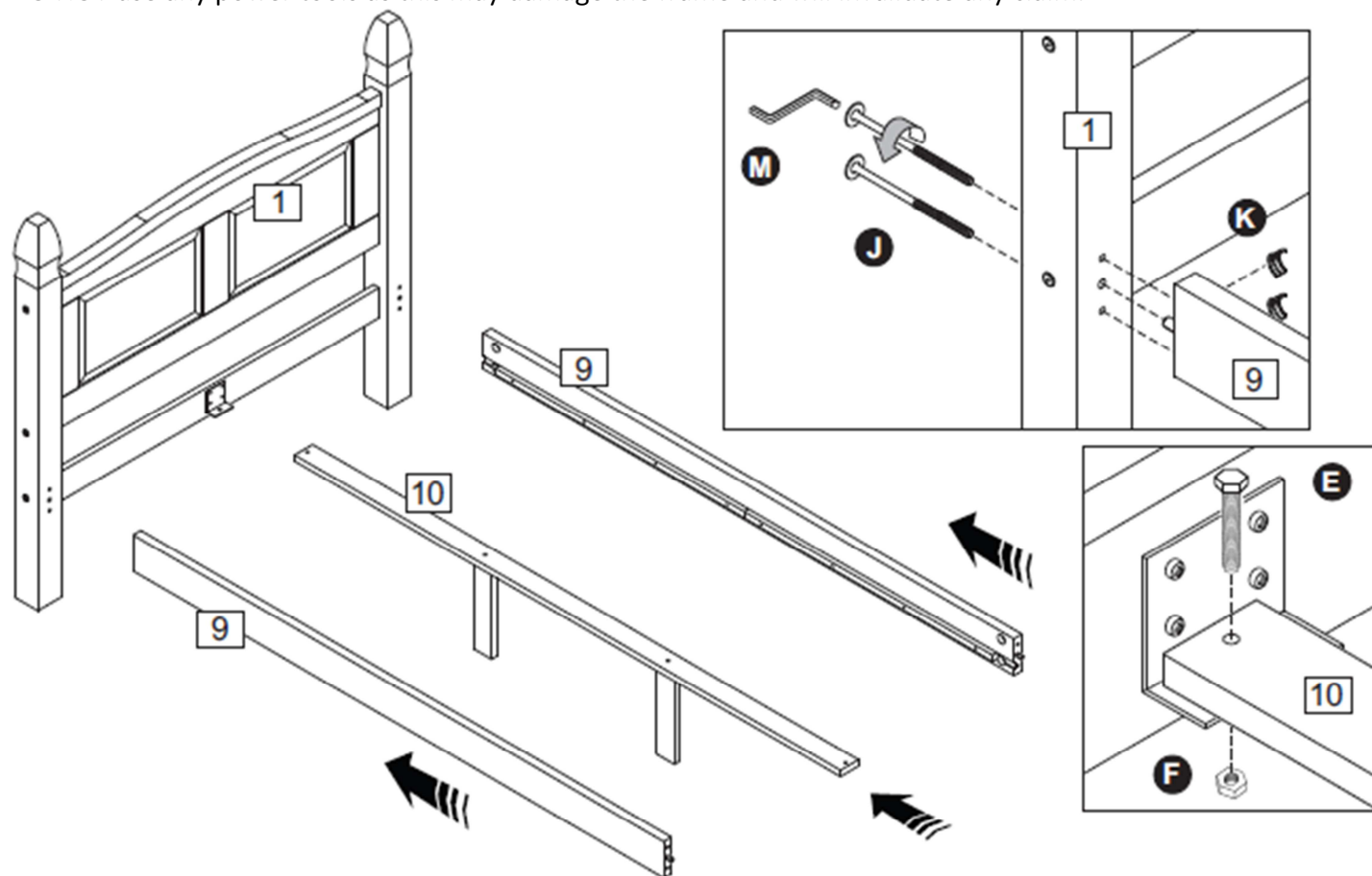
Step 4: Attach the left footend post (6) and right footend post (5) to the footend panel (2) using hardware parts H and M.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Step 5: Secure hardware part L using hardware part C and a screwdriver (not provided).
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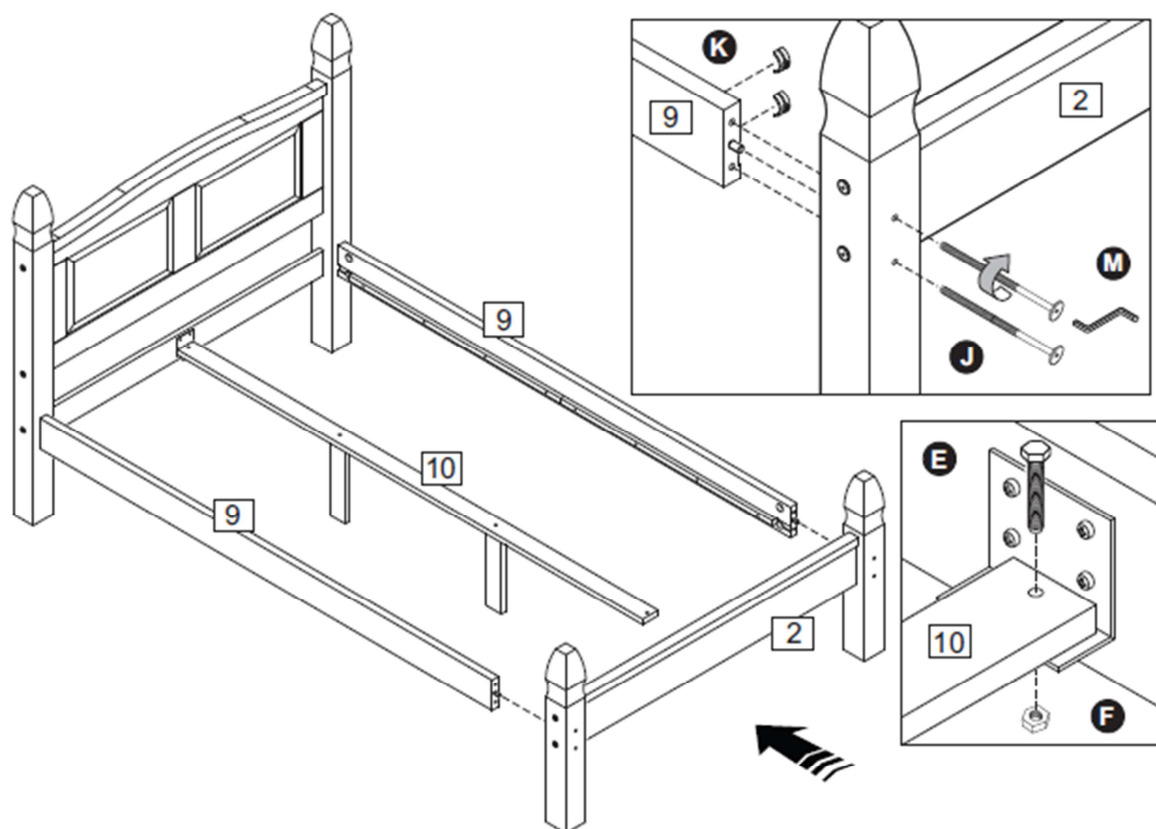


Step 6: Attach the side rails (9) using hardware parts J, K and M. Secure the centre rail (10) using hardware parts E and F.
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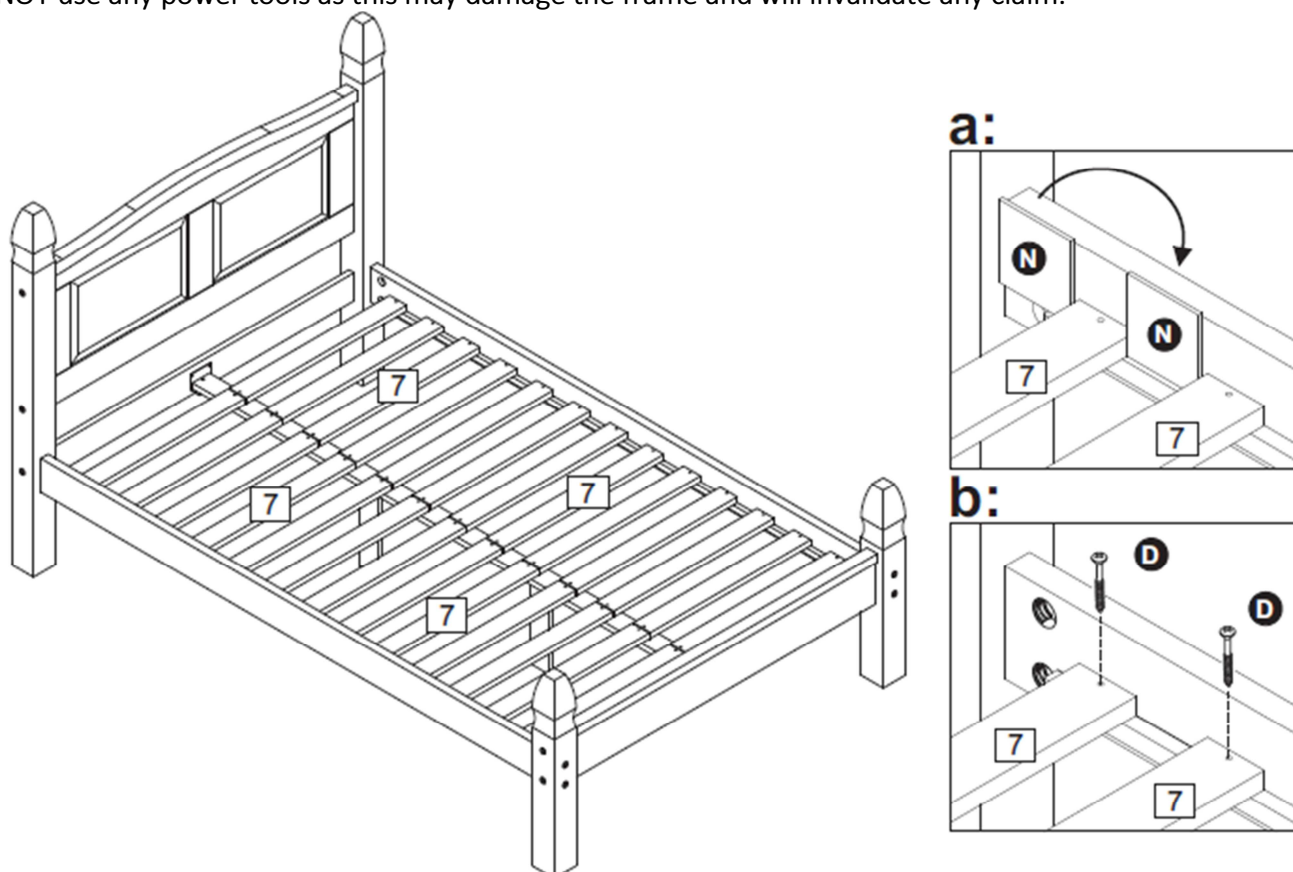
Step 7: Join the two sections together using hardware parts J, K and M. Secure the centre rail (10) using hardware parts E and F.

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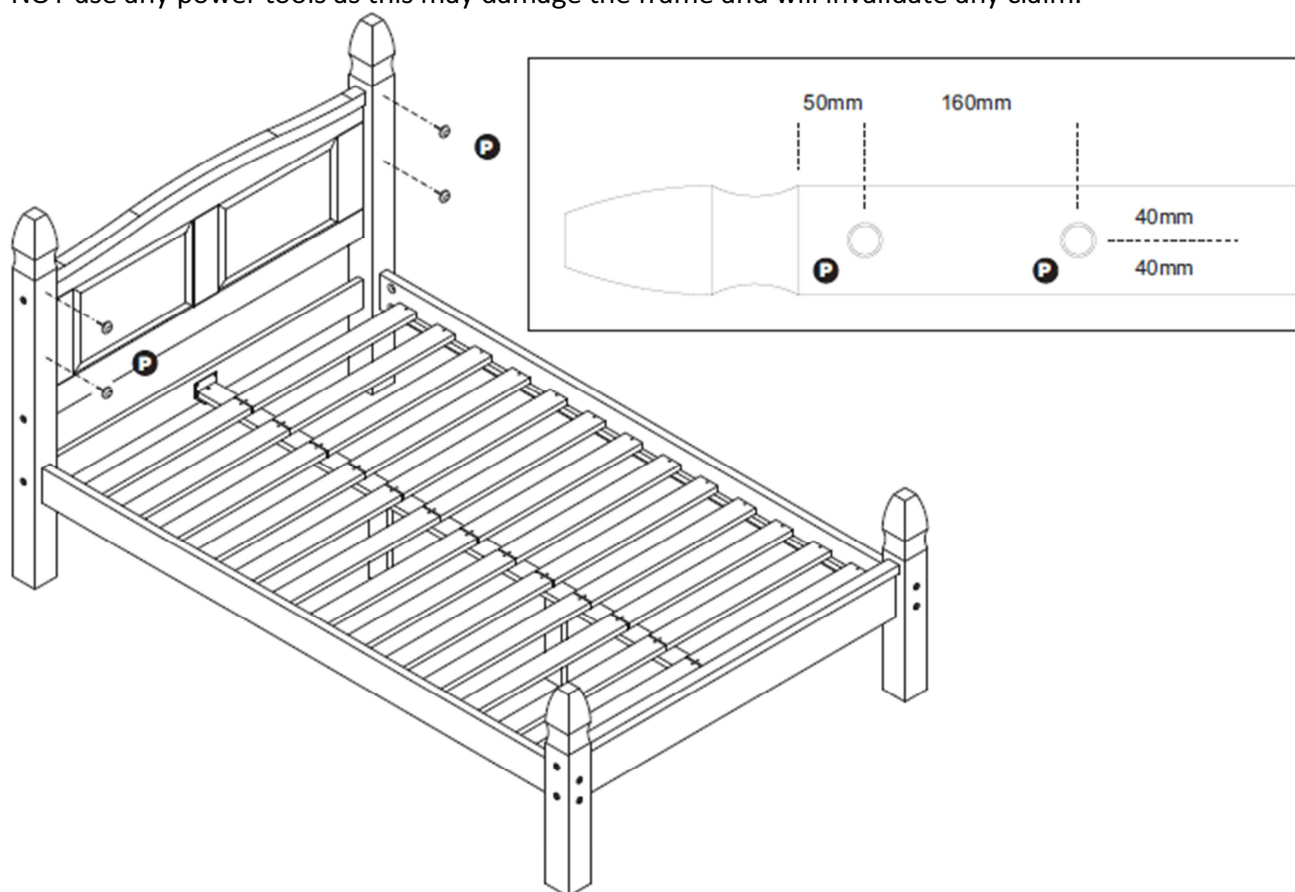


Step 8: Secure the slats (7) using hardware parts D and N with a screwdriver (not provided). Make sure to start at the ends and work towards the middle.

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Step 9: Insert hardware part P using a small mallet (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Note: When everything has been assembled, tighten all bolts and attach the wooden buttons to the holes on the bed posts.

Please dispose of all packaging safely.

General Care & Maintenance

Wipe clean with a slightly damp cloth.
Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

Periodically check all screw & fixings to ensure they are secure.

When moving your product, carefully lift into place. Never drag or push the product across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints. If the product is used on hard flooring, such as wood or laminated floor, you must place some protection under the legs to stop the product from moving. If this is not adhered to, it could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.
