


Assembly Instructions

Fenton Fabric Ottoman Bed



Important before assembly: Read these instructions carefully before assembling or using the product.

Please check the contents of the boxes before attempting to assemble this product. The instructions will have a checklist of parts and fittings.

It would be sensible to lay a rug or a carpet on the floor where you intend to assemble the product, to void scratches and damaging the product or the floor.

Assemble the product as close to its intended final location/room as possible.

Do NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame.

Health & Safety:

This product or some parts of this product will be heavy. Please use an assistant when lifting.

DO NOT jump on the product or any of its parts.


DO NOT use this product if any parts are missing, damaged or worn.

DO NOT use this product unless all fixings are secured.

Please keep small parts out of reach of children.


Always use on a level, even surface.




These tools are not necessary, but may help to assemble certain parts of the product.


Do NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame.







This product or some parts of this product will be heavy. Please use an assistant when lifting.






Step 1: Attach the pump mounting bracket (9) and bracket base (10) to both side rails (4) using hardware parts B,E,F and K. **DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**




Step 2 : Attach the legs (5) to the footend (3) using hardware parts (C) and (K). Then attach the Side wings (2) to the headboard (1) using hardware (C), (E), (F) and (K).



Step 3 : Attach the side rails (4) by pushing the brackets down into place and secure the bolts using hardware part L as shown. DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 4: Attach the support legs (8) to the centre rail (7) using hardware parts B and K. DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 5: Attach the centre rail (7).


DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 6: Insert the bottom panel (15) to the below frame and secure using hardware part J and a screwdriver (not provided). DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.




Step 7: Insert the centre rail (6) to the headend (1) and footend (3) and secure using hardware part A,E,F and K. DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Step 8 : Unscrew the Pre-attached hex-nut of gas spring (11) and attach it back again as shown. Please fully tighten the nut.




Step 9: Must place the wooden frame (13 & 14) in correct position (please follow the position as shown in diagram).





WARNING: Take care when assembling the base, assemble the ottoman as closed to its final position. The Ottoman has a powerful mechanism and after assembly should only be opened when the mattress is in place.

Step 10 : Assemble the wooden frame (13) and the wooden frame (14) to the bracket using hardware parts (D), (G), (H), (I), (K) and (M). **DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**



Step 11: Attach the wooden frame bracket (12) to the back of the wooden frame using hardware parts (J) and a screwdriver (not provided). **DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**





Additional Information:

- Caution. This bed uses a pressurised mechanism.
- Use caution when operating Always use two hands at arm's length, and only where illustrated on the product.
- You must ensure the mattress is on the bed frame before lifting the mechanism Failure to do so may result in injury.
- Please ensure Children and pets are kept away from the bed when operating the bed mechanism.
- If removing the mattress, make sure that the frame is secured as it could flip open.
- Only use the storage compartment when the frame is fully raised in the 'up' position.
- No children and animals are left unattended when the frame is in the 'up' position.
- Do not remain on the bed whilst the lifting mechanism is in use.
- •Beware of Entrapment Keep both hands clear of mechanism when operating the mechanism.
- When lifting the bed remove all bedding Except the fitted sheet.







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Important for Ottoman and other gas lift beds

Please follow these final steps to ensure the best experience with your new bed

- Please ensure the pistons are fitted to the bed frame.
- Please place the mattress on top of the bed frame.
- Standing at the foot of the frame (looking at the headboard) open the base and the press quite forcefully down on the mattress please do not attempt to do this without the mattress being in place.
- Please do not pull on the strap handles.
- Please note as the pistons are full of gas you will need to press heavily to release the compressed gas.
- Once done the pistons should start operating as normal.







Please dispose of all packaging safely.

General Care & Maintenance

Wipe clean with a slightly damp cloth. Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

Periodically check all screw & fixings to ensure they are secure.

When moving your product, carefully lift into place. Never drag or push the pieces across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints and could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.
