Always use on a level, even surface.

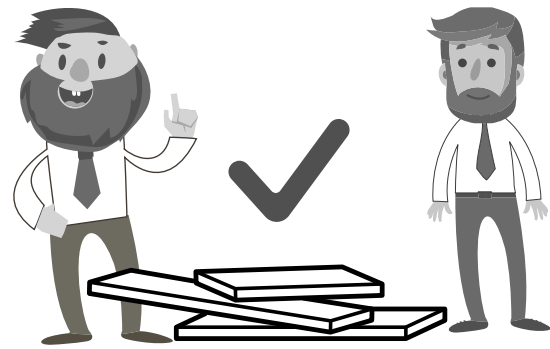
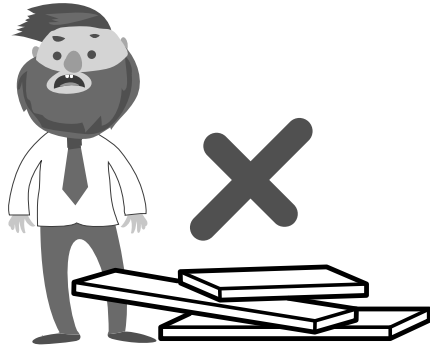

Never drag or push the pieces across a hard or stone floor as this will cause damage to the joints. Use a carpet or a rug for extra care.









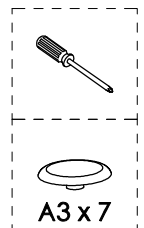
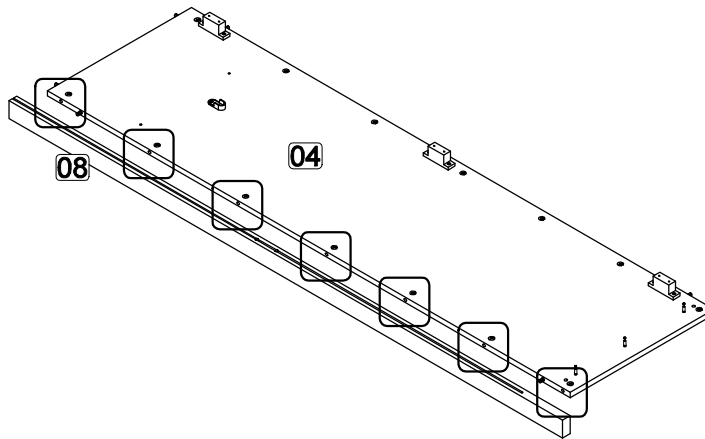
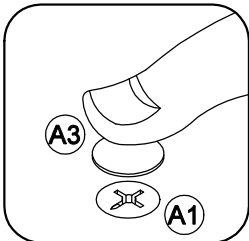
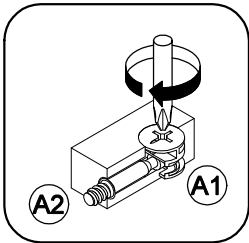
Step 1: Prepare these parts for assembly using hardware parts A1, A2, B, E, F, M and P.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



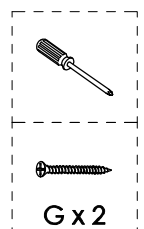
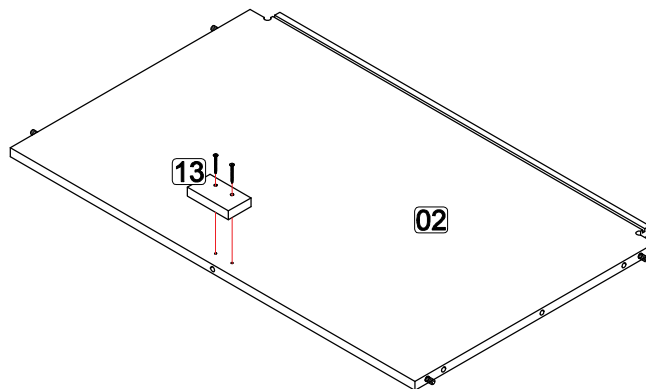
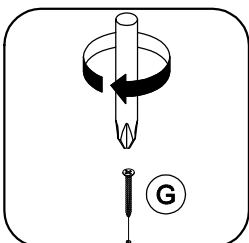
**Step 2: Attach back leg (7) to side panel (3) using hardware A1 and A2 with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**



**Step 3: Attach back leg (8) to side panel (4) using hardware A1 and A2 with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**

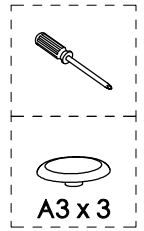
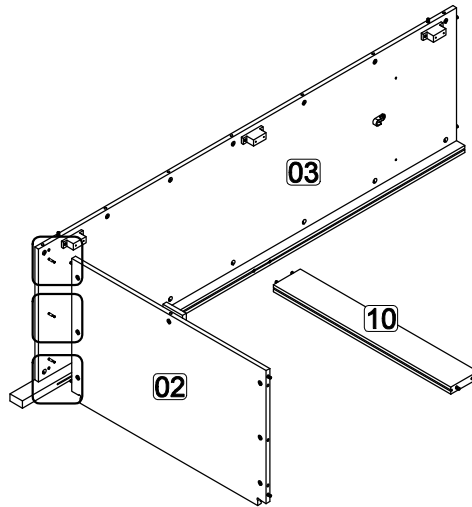
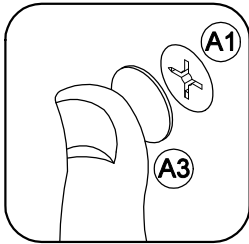
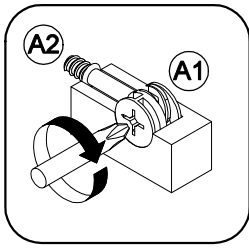


**Step 4: Attach door block (13) to bottom panel (2) using hardware (G) with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**



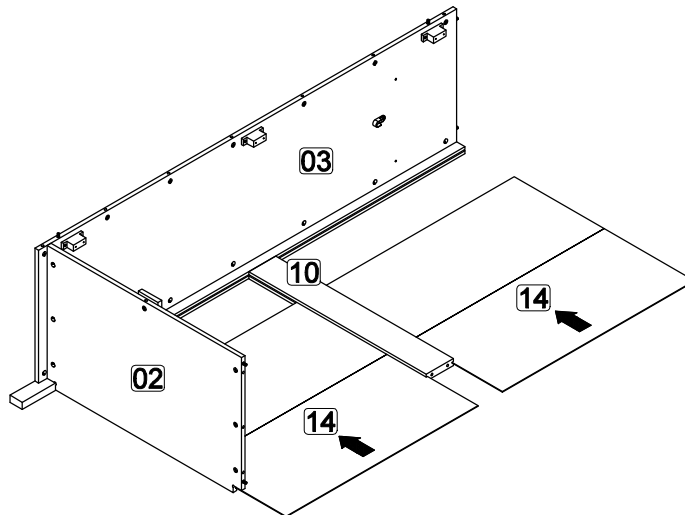
Step 5: Attach bottom panel (2) and back support (10) to side panel (3) using hardware A1 and A2 with a screwdriver (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



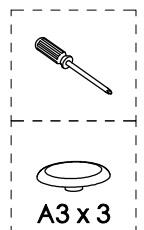
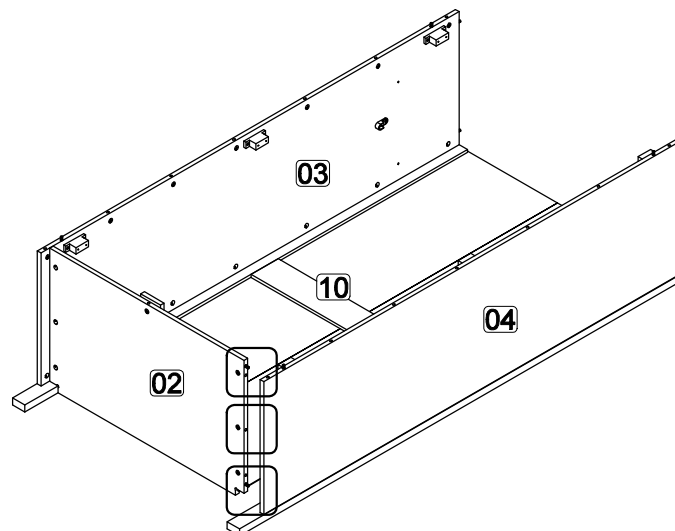
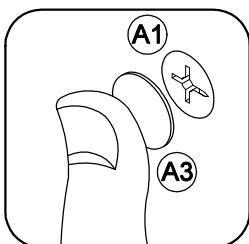
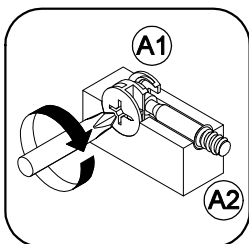
Step 6: Insert back panel (14) along the slot.

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

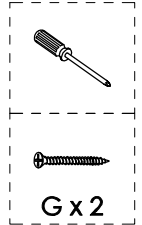
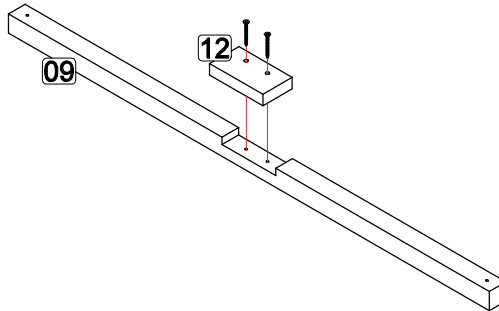
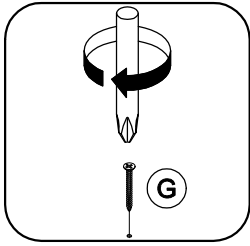


Step 7: Attach side panel (4) to bottom panel (2) and back support (10) using hardware A1 and A2 with a screwdriver (not provided).

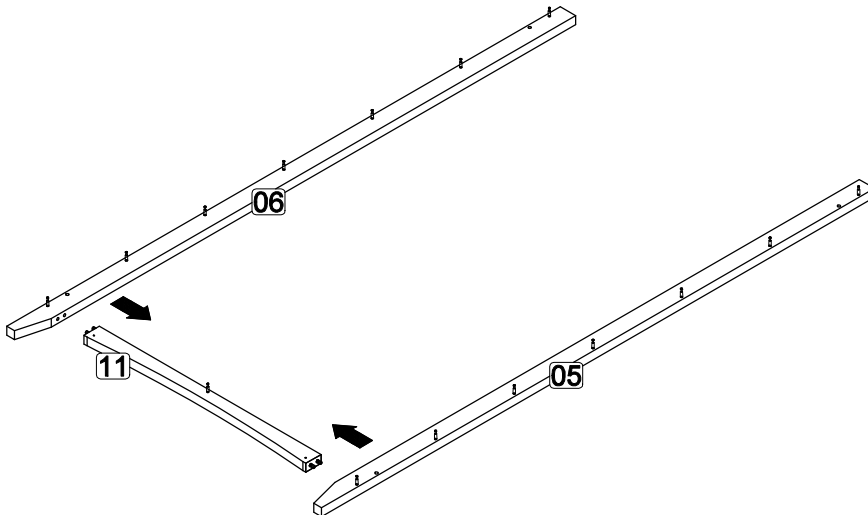

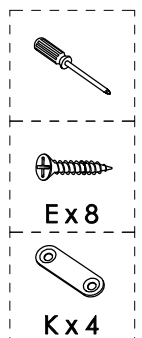
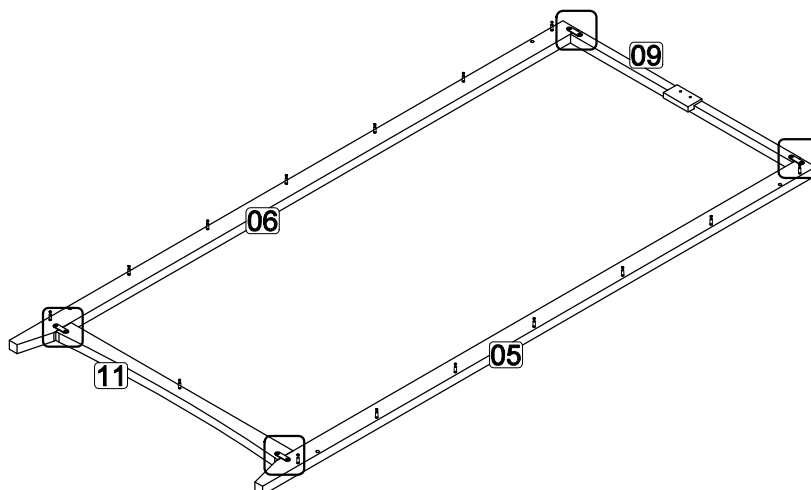
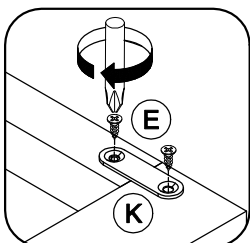
**Step 8: Attach door block (12) to front bar (9) using hardware (G) with a screwdriver (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**

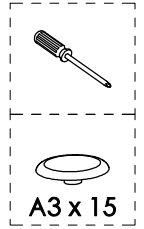
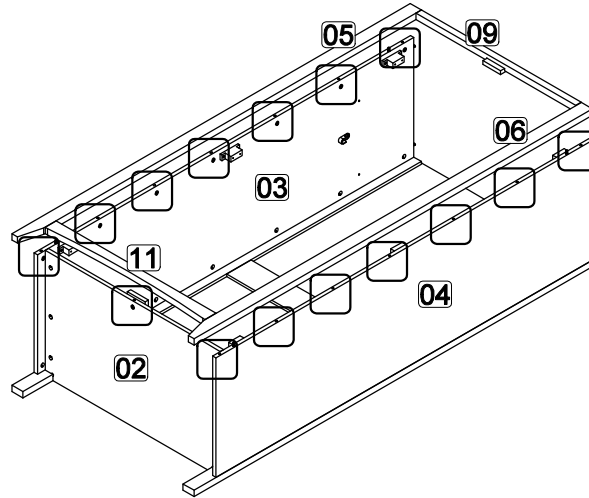
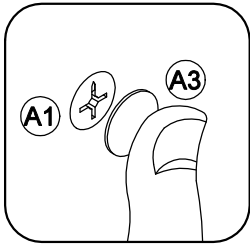
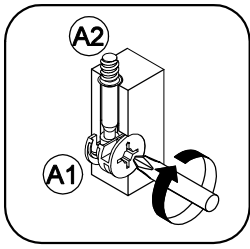


**Step 10: Fix hardware K into front leg (5), (6), front bar (9) and leg panel (11) using hardware E with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**



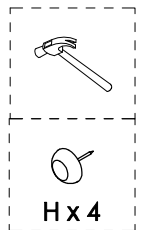
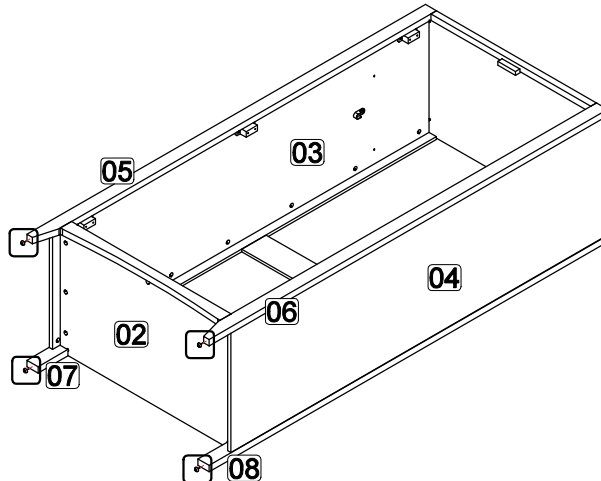
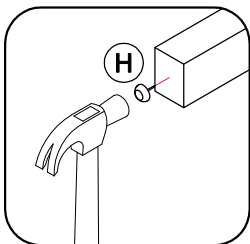
Step 11: Attach front leg (5), (6) and leg panel (11) to bottom panel (2), side panel (3) and (4) using hardware A1 and A2 with a screwdriver (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



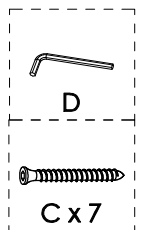
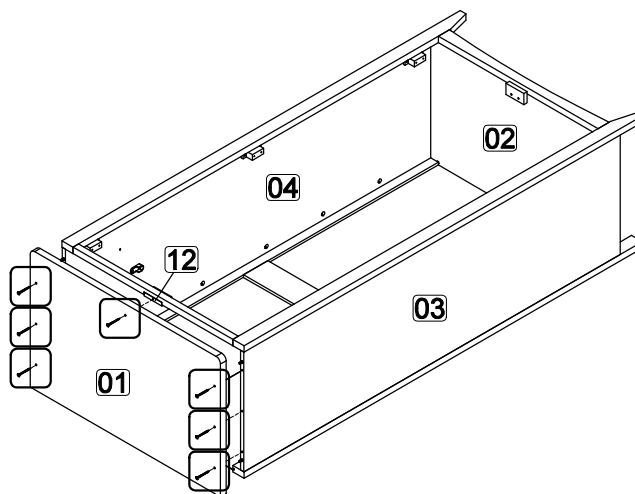
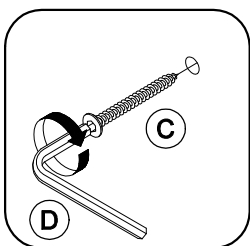
Step 12: Hit hardware H into bottom of front leg (5), (6), back leg (7) and (8).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

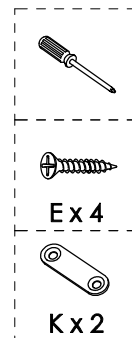
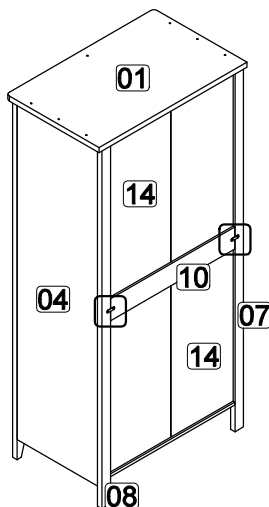
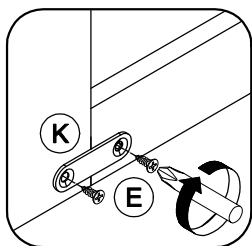


Step 13: Attach top panel (1) to side panel (3), (4) and door block (12) using hardware C and D.

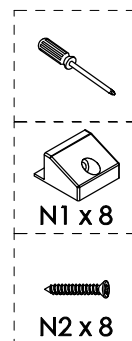
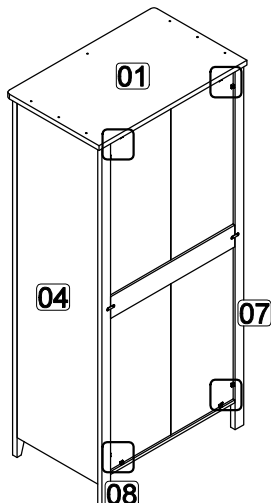
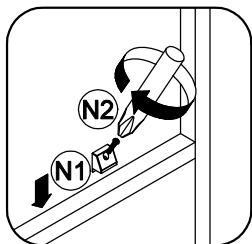
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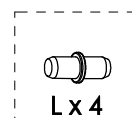
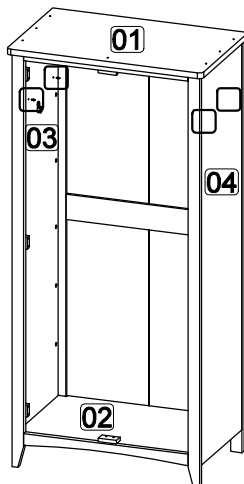
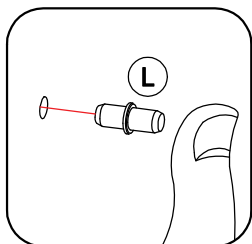
Step 14: Fix hardware K into back leg (7), (8) and back support (10) using hardware E with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



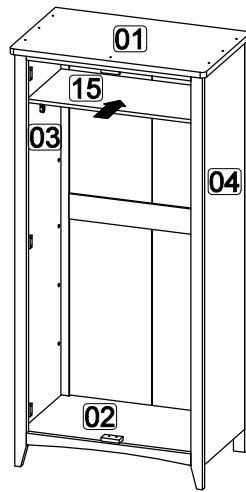
Step 15: Attach hardware N1 into top panel (1), bottom panel (2), back leg (7) and (8) using hardware N2 with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



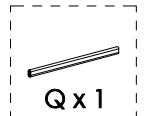
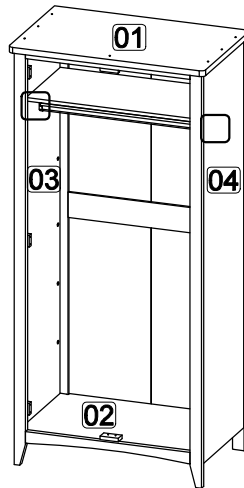
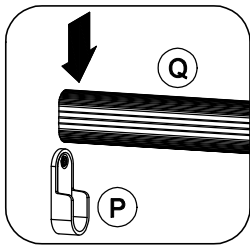
Step 16: Insert hardware L into mounting positions on side panel (3) and (4).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



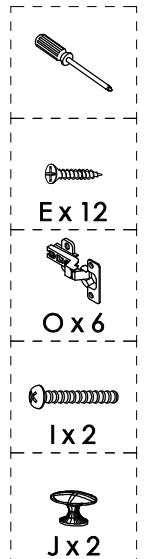
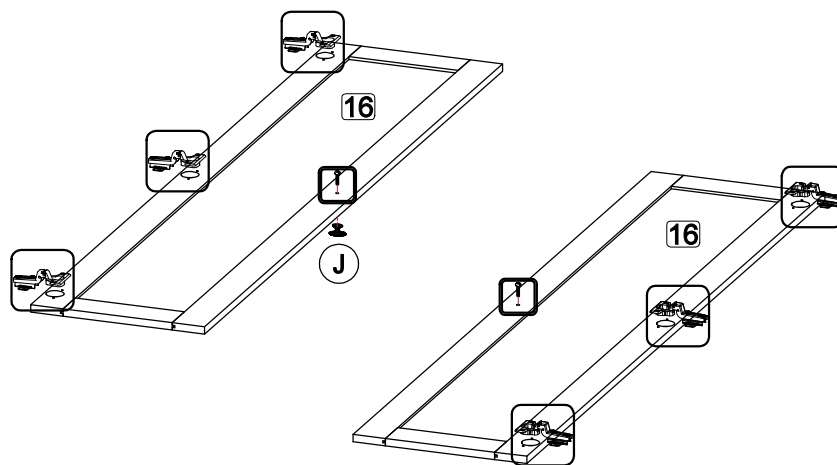
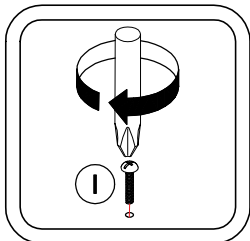
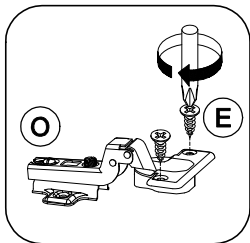
Step 17: Assemble shelf panel (15) between side panel (3) and (4).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



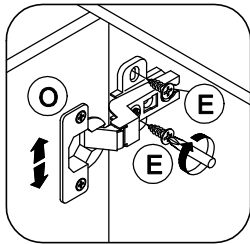
Step 18: Attach hardware Q into hardware P.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



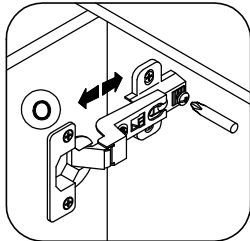
Step 19: Fix hardware O onto door panel (16) by using hardware E.
Fix hardware J onto door panel (16) by using hardware I.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



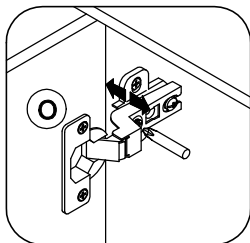
Step 20: Attach door panel (16) to hardware M using hardware E with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



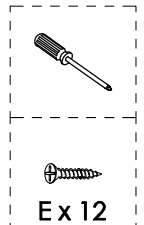
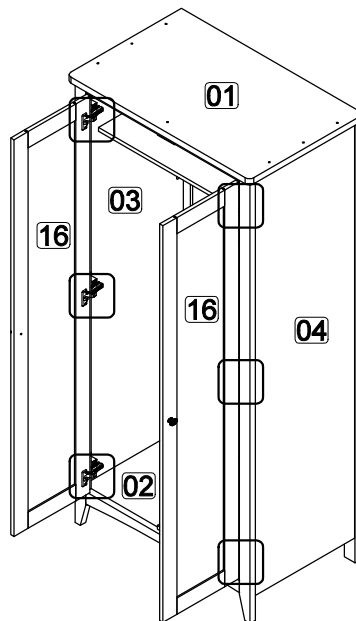
Vertical Adjustment



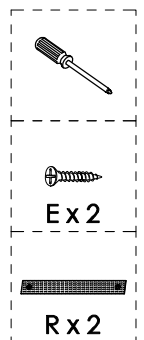
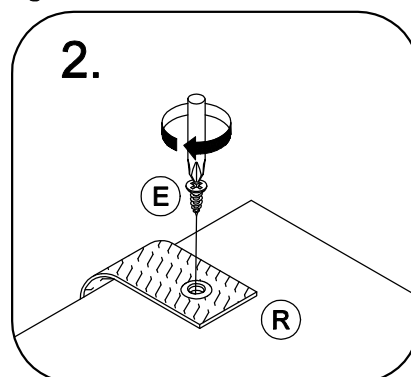
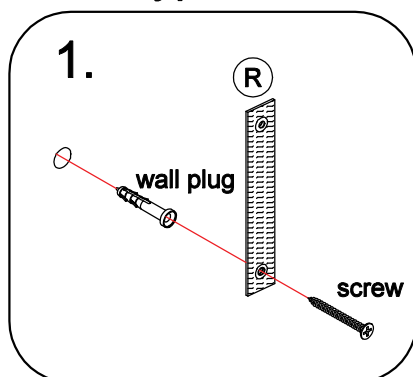
Horizontal Adjustment

Step 21: To secure the item to the wall use hardware R, screw and wall plug using a screwdriver (not provided).
 Then attach hardware part R to the panel (1) using hardware E with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



PLEASE NOTE that wall fixings are not supplied as different wall materials require different fixing devices. You must use fixings devices suitable for the type of wall you intend to mount product to. Ensure the head of any screw used has a diameter greater than the mounting hole and the fixing is safe and secure before use.

Birlea Furniture advise you use the hardware R (2 pcs) are provided to further enhance the safety of this product.

General Care & Maintenance

Wipe clean with a slightly damp cloth.
Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

Periodically check all screw & fixings to ensure they are secure.

When moving your product, carefully lift into place. Never drag or push the product across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints. If the product is used on hard flooring, such as wood or laminated floor, you must place some protection under the legs to stop the product from moving. If this is not adhered to, it could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.
