Always use on a level, even surface.

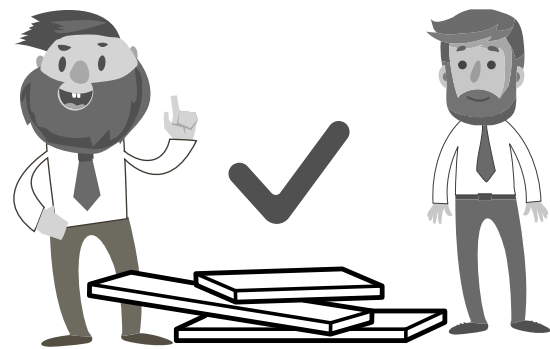
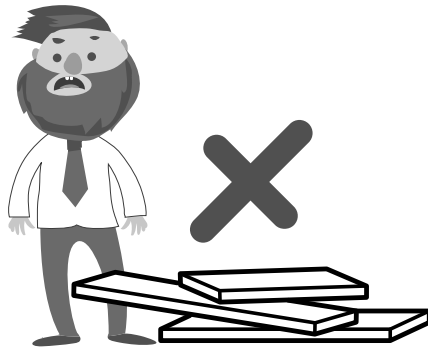
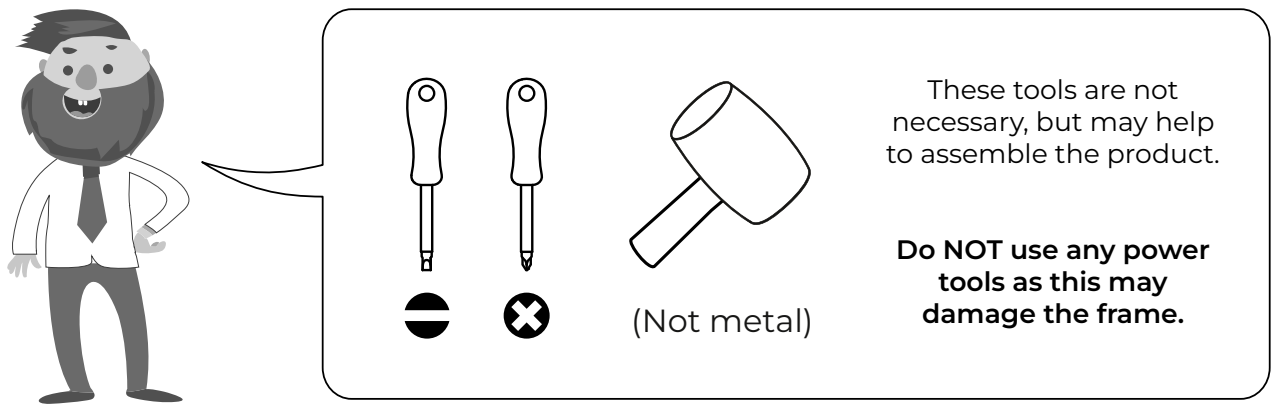









Never drag or push the pieces across a hard or stone floor as this will cause damage to the joints. Use a carpet or a rug for extra care.




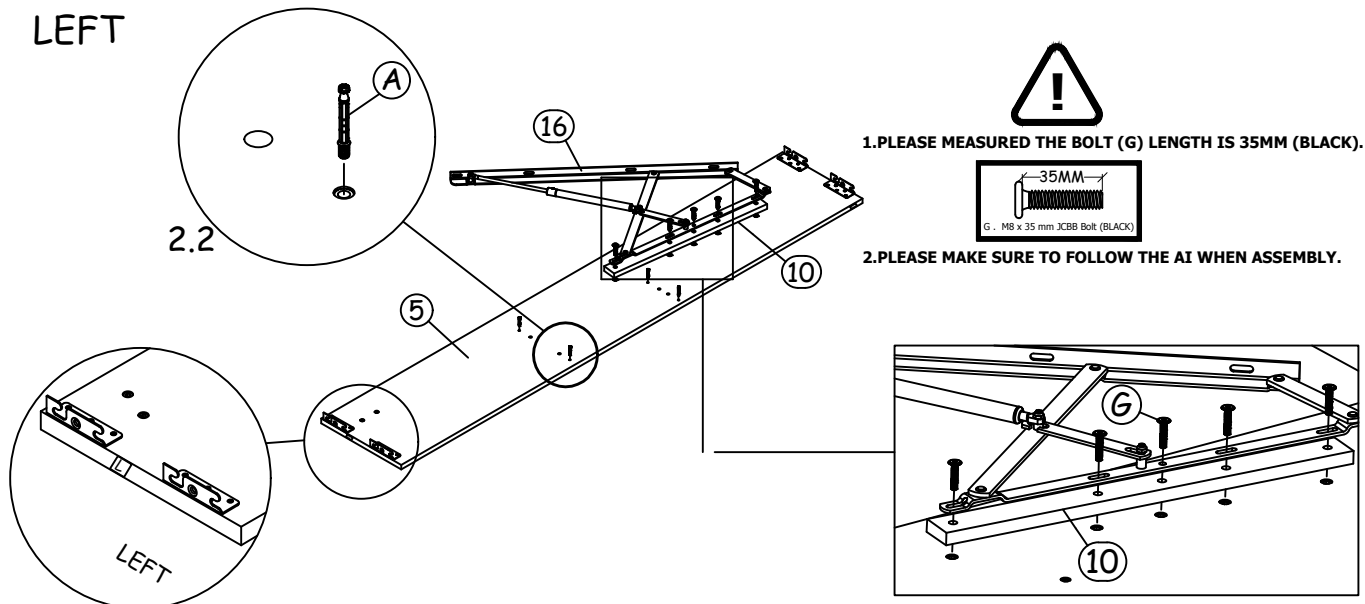
Step 1: Attach the headboard frame (1) and back storage panel (9) to the left wooden post (2) and right wooden post (3). Secure the headboard frame using hardware parts **B**, **D** and **P**, then secure the back storage panel with hardware parts **B**, **H** and **I**.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



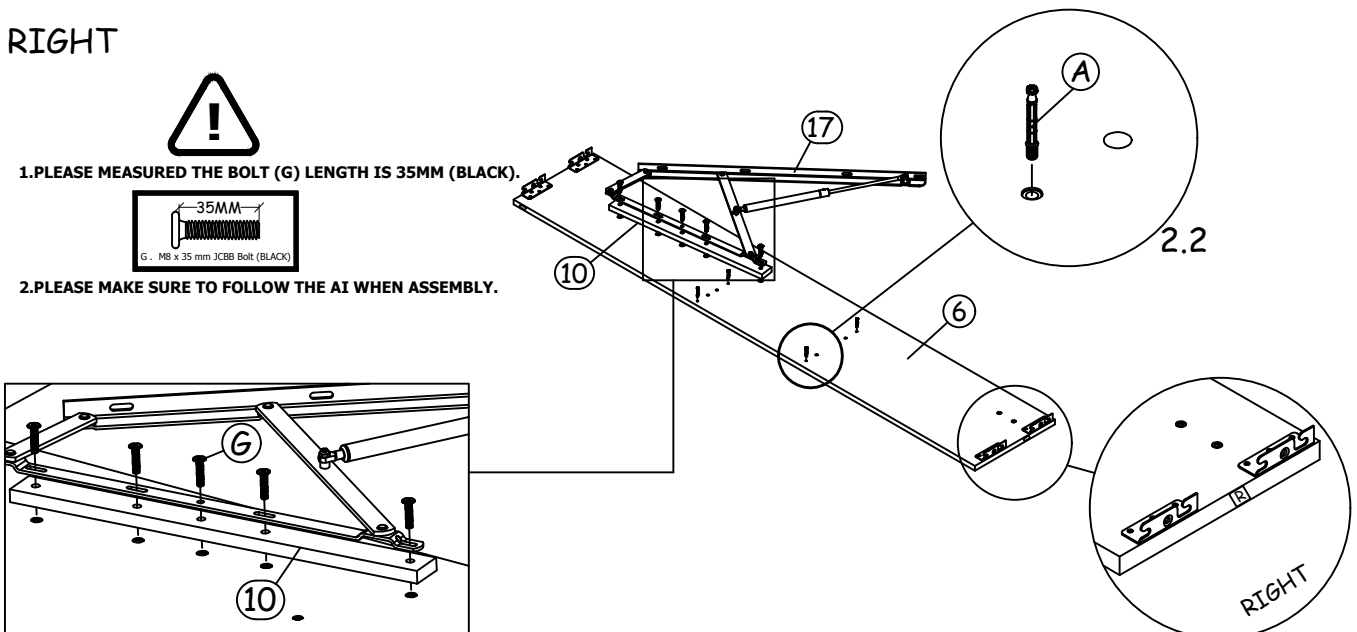
Step 2: Firstly, Loosen the **Hex Nut** from the Left & Right Hydraulic Base Support ,then fix the hydraulic pump to each hydraulic base using the same **Hex Nut & V**. (shown in diagram 2.1.)
Next, fix the left & right hydraulic spacer together with hydraulic base supporter to the both side rails using bolts **G** and than screw the minifix part **A** to the both side rails as shown in diagram 2.2.



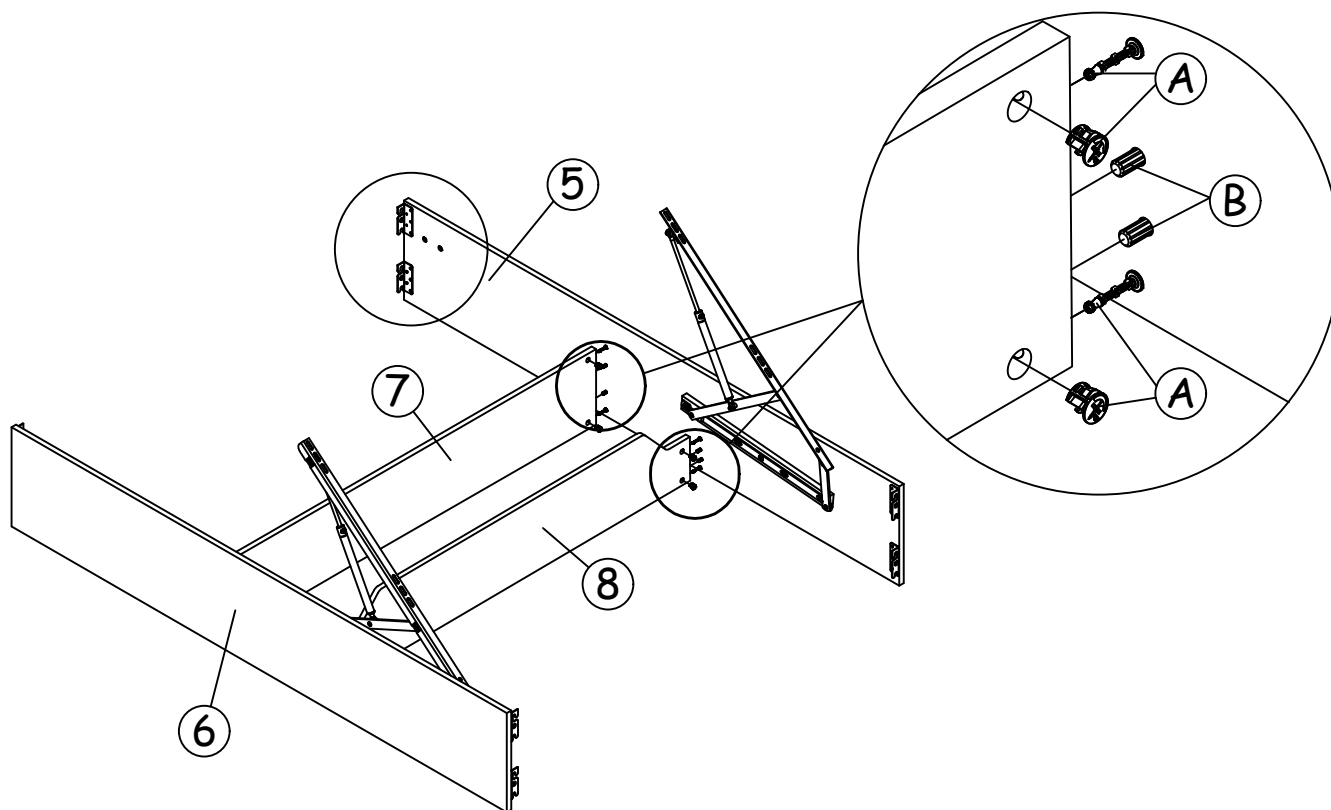

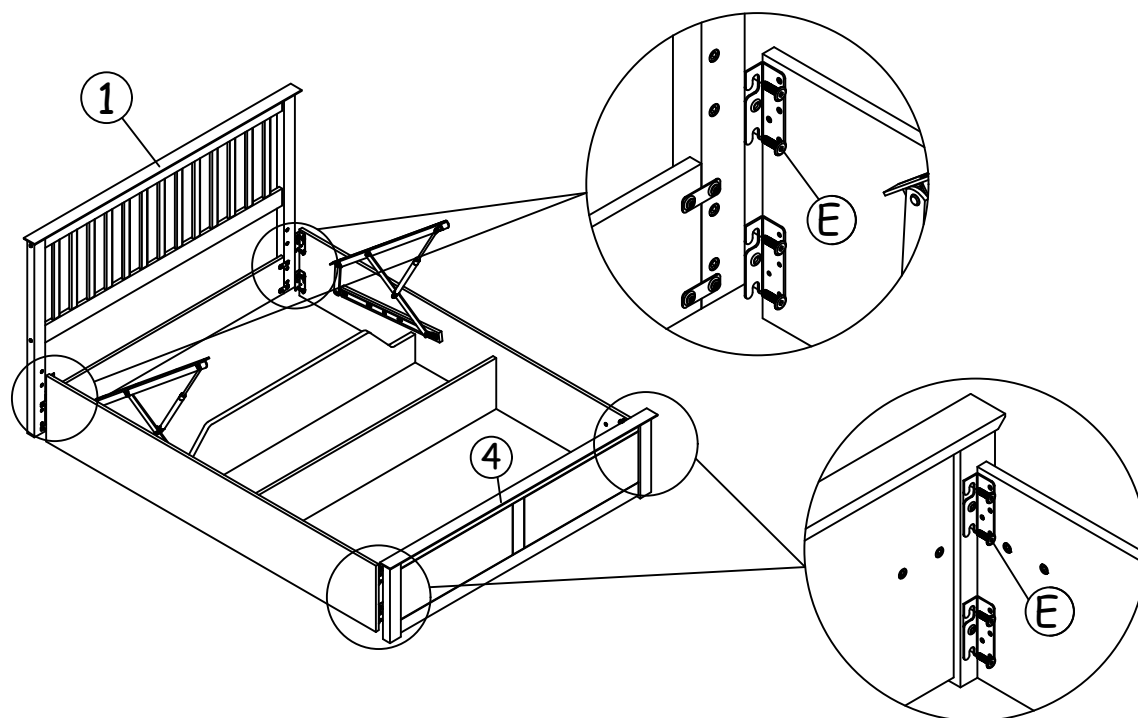

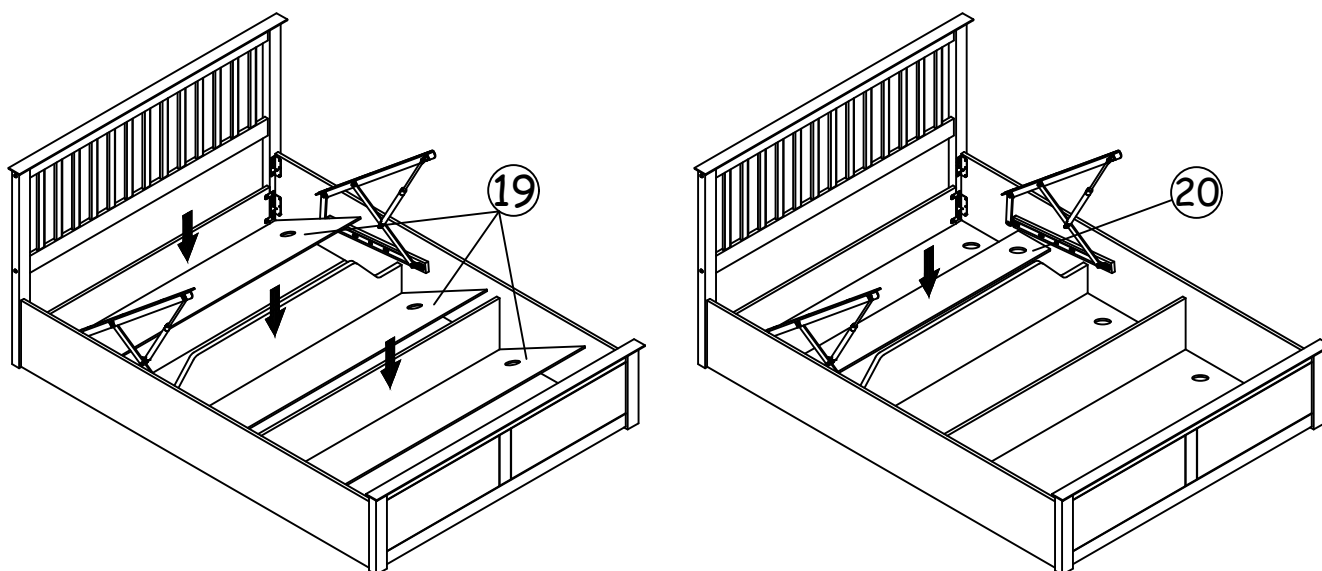
Step 3: Join together the left side rail (5) and right side rail (6) with the centre storage panels ① (7) and centre storage panels ②(8) by using hardware parts **A** and **B**.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



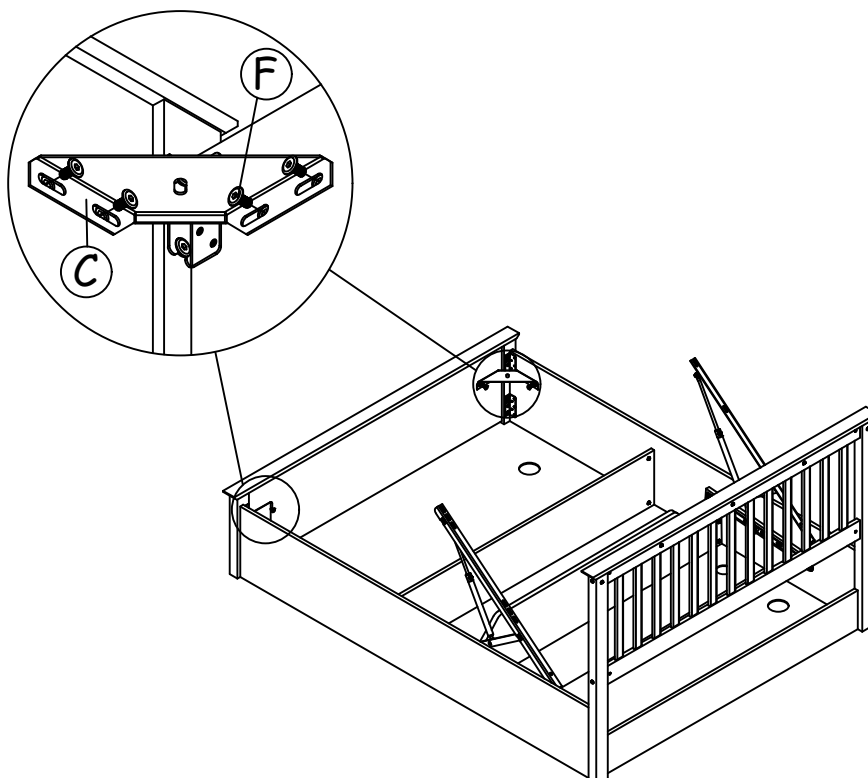
Step 4: Attach the headboard frame (1) and footboard (4) using hardware part **E**.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Step 5: Insert the large base panel (19) and small base panel (20) .
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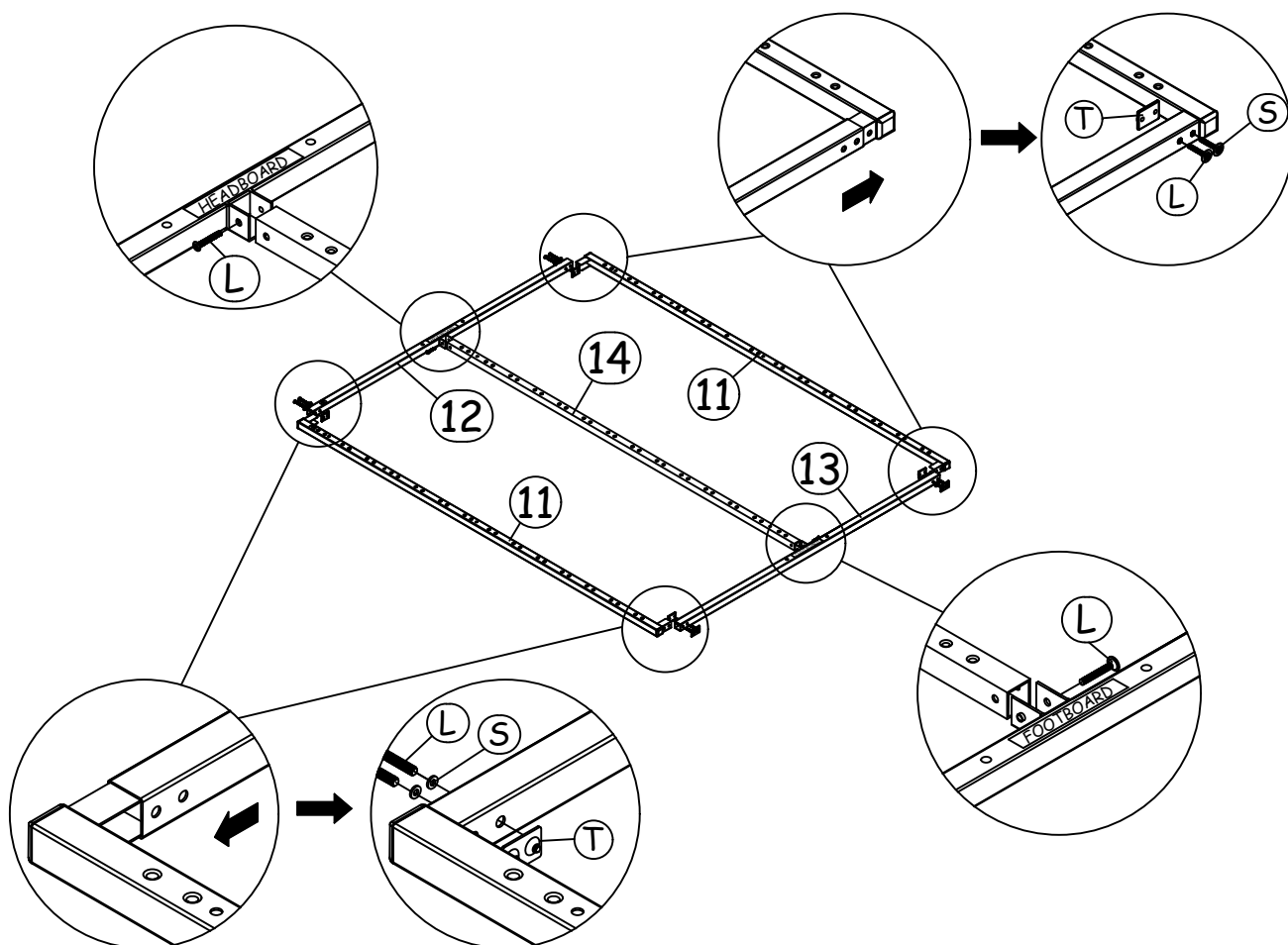
Step 6: Fix metal corner block **C** to the edge of footboard and side rails with bolt **F** as shown.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Step 7: Join together all the bed base parts (11),(12),(13) and (14) by using hardware parts **L,S,T**.

Important note: Please assemble follow arrow direction.

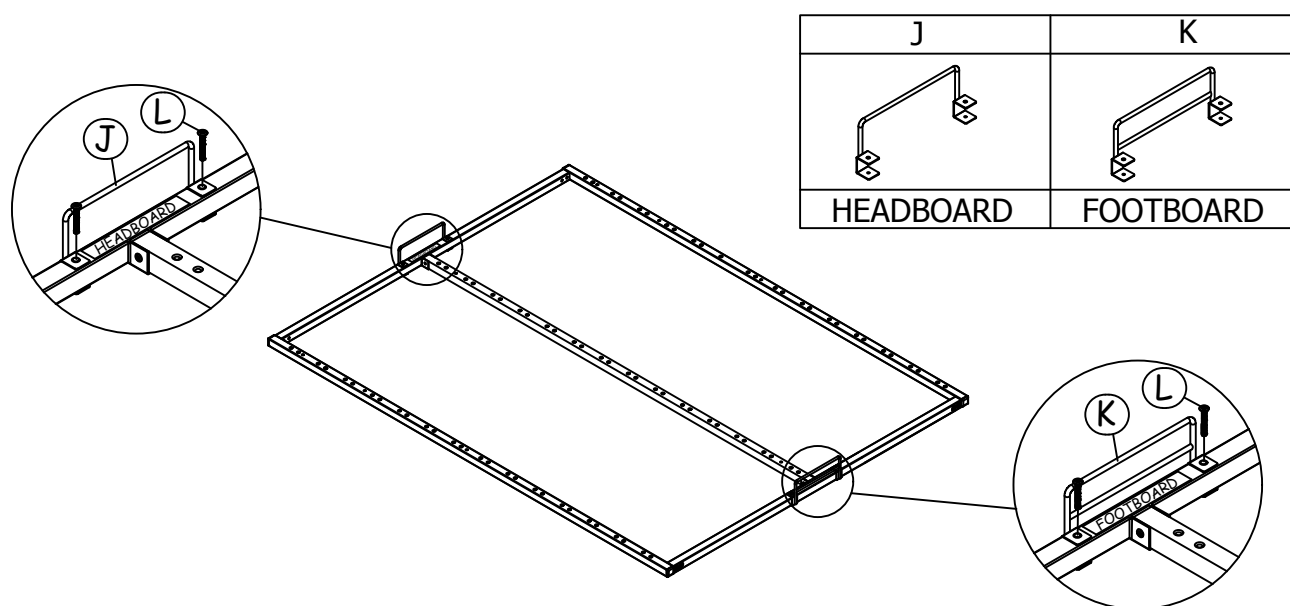

Step 8: Attach hardware parts **J** and **K** using hardware part **L**.

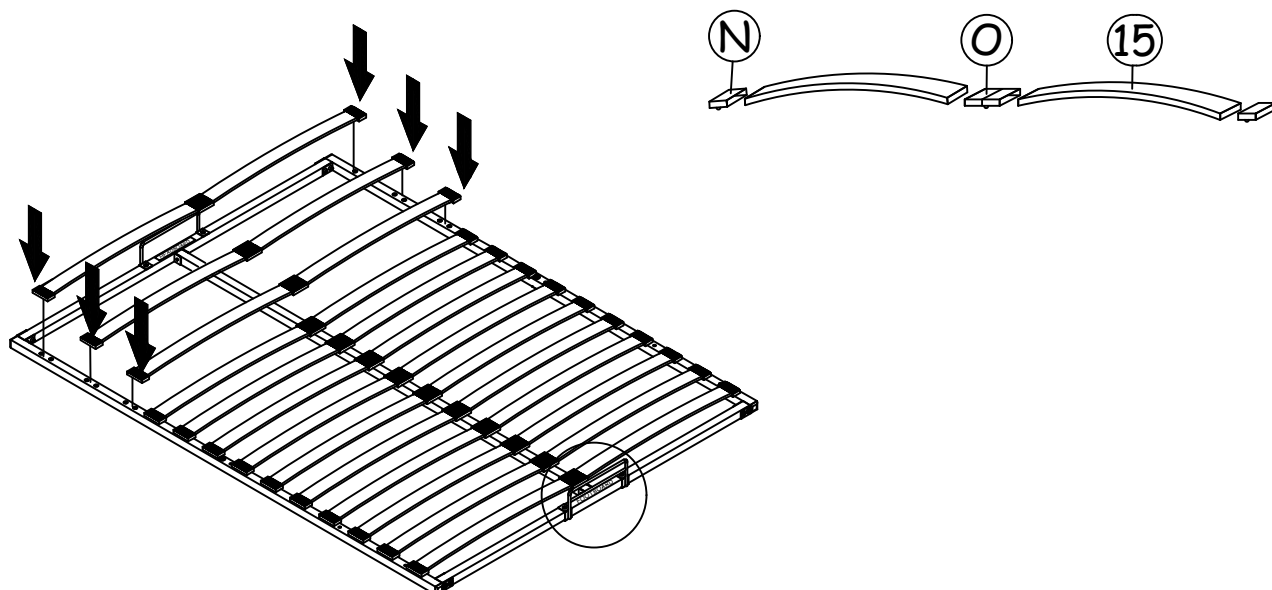

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



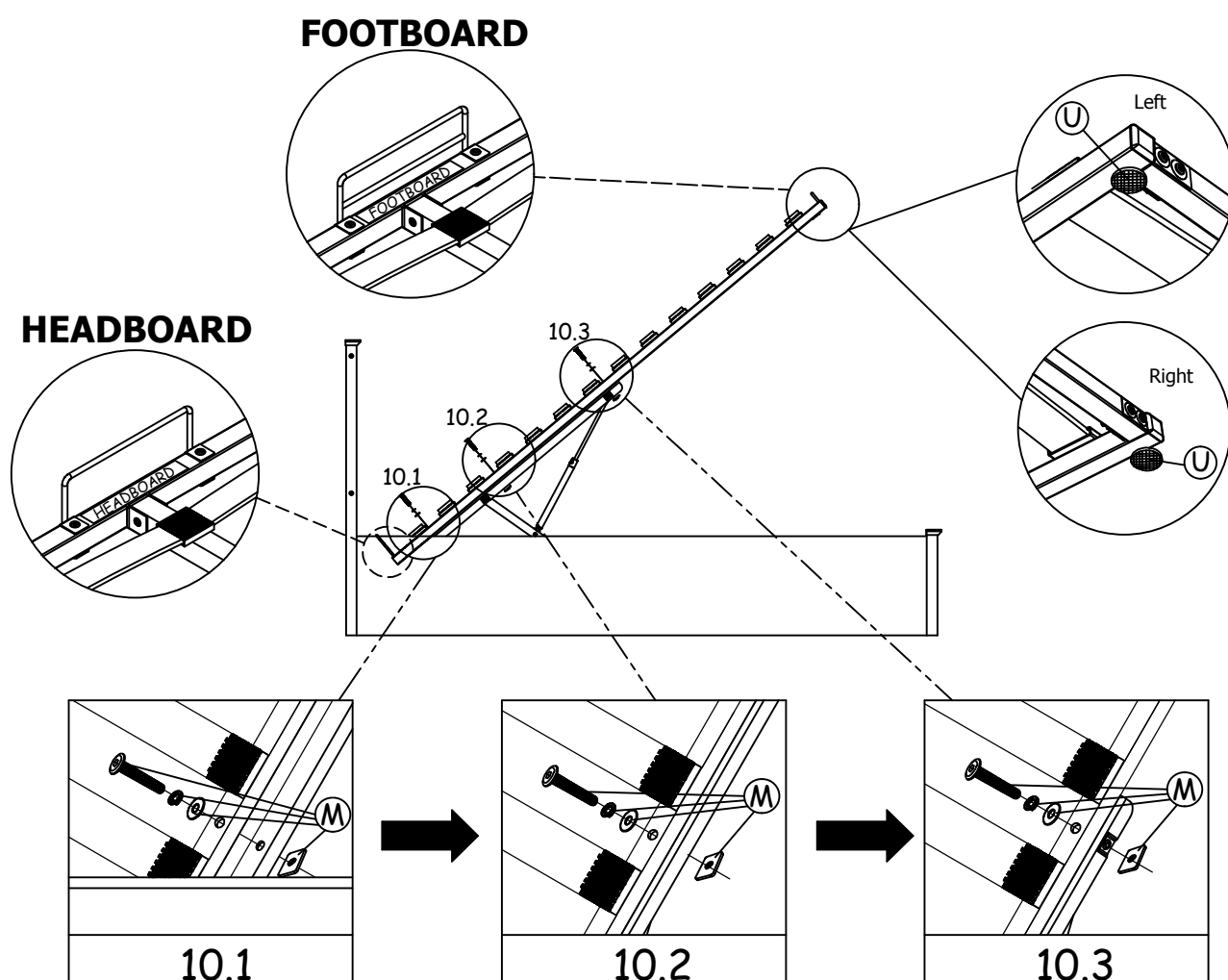
Step 9: Insert the slats (15) to hardware parts **N** and **O** then press into the base making sure they are secure.

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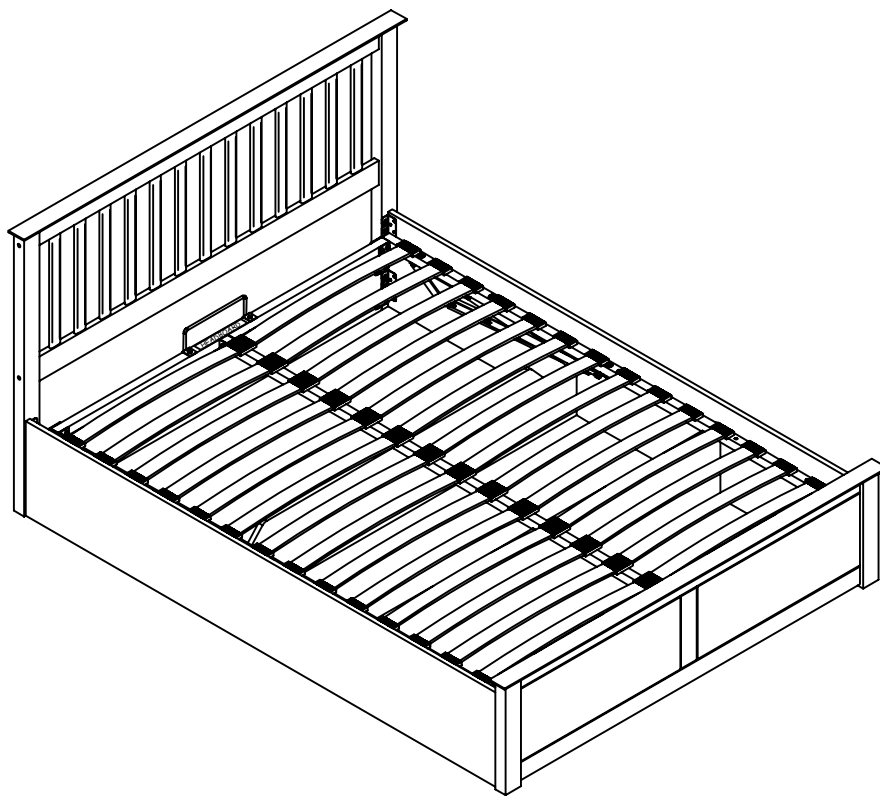
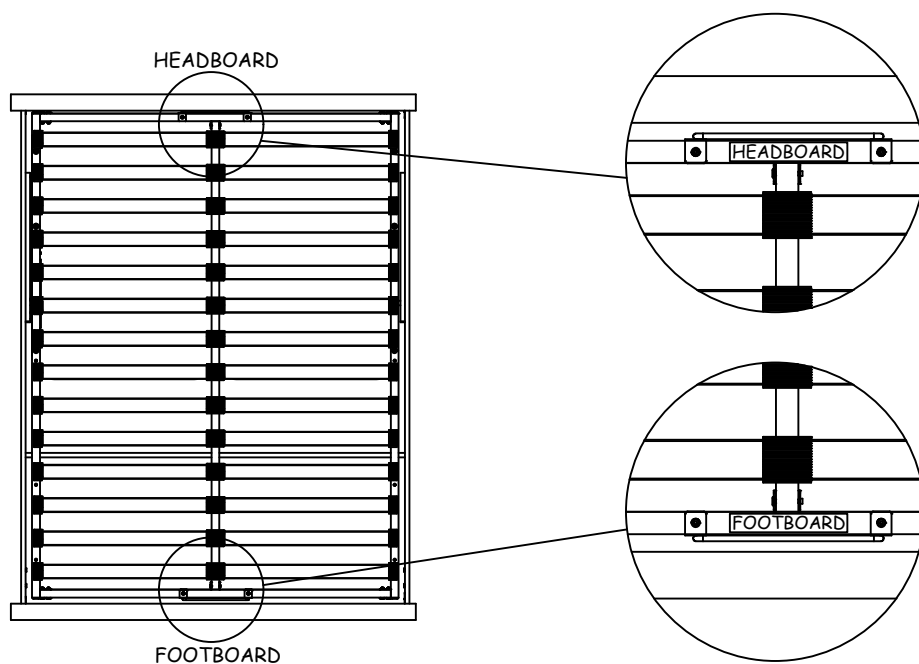


Step 10: Assemble the bed base on the right & left hydraulic frame and fix bolts **M** starting from ' 10.1 ' to ' 10.3 ' as shown and stick it the self adhesive **U** as shown.

Important note : **Do not tighten the bolts yet!**, and this assemble must be done by two persons.



Step 11: Tighten all bolts and screws now. Top view of assembly bed.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

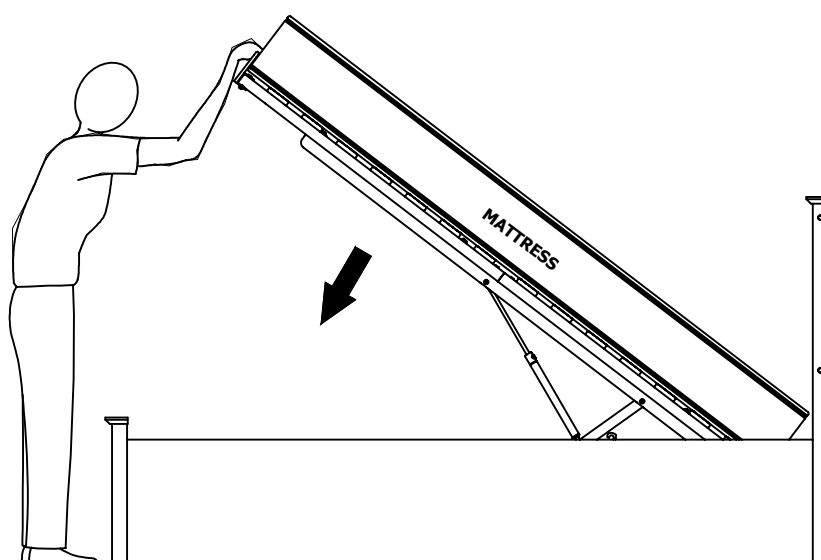


IMPORTANT NOTE

WHEN THE BED IS BUILT AND THE MATTRESS FRAME IS AT 45 DEGREE ANGLE PLEASE PLACE THE MATTRESS ON THE BED.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE WEIGHT OF THE MATTRESS IS REQUIRED TO HELP CLOSE THE BED.

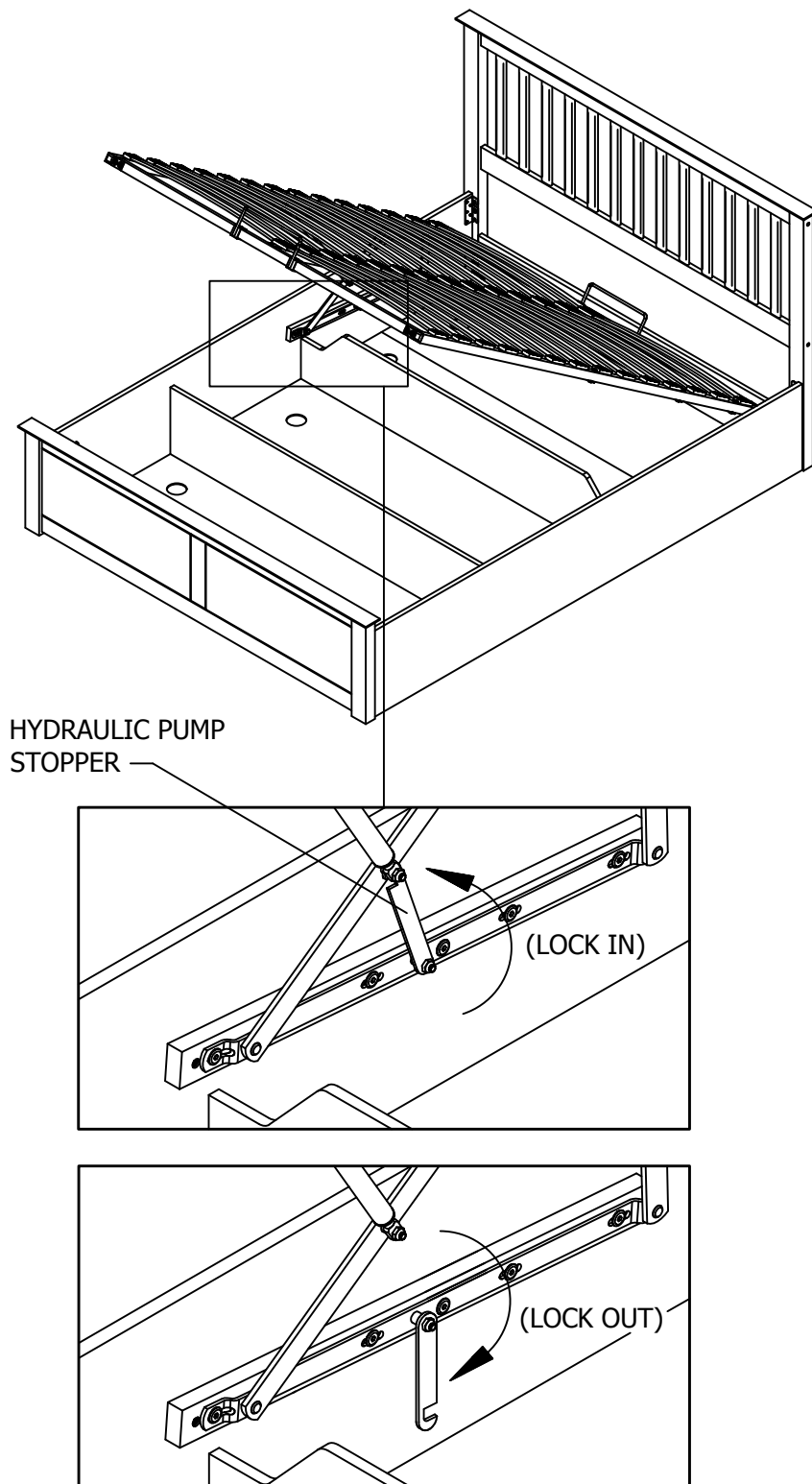
TO LOWER THE SLEEPING PLATFORM STAND AT THE FOOT END OF THE BED AND PUSH SHARPLY DOWNWARDS USING BOTH HANDS.



WARNING: Take care when assembling the base. Assemble the ottoman as closed to its final position. The Ottoman has a powerful, mechanism and after assembly should only be opened when the mattress is in place.

CAUTION :

PLEASE USE HYDRAULIC PUMP STOPPER FOR SAFETY PURPOSE.



Important for Ottoman and other gas lift beds

Please follow these final steps to ensure the best experience with your new bed

- Please ensure the pistons are fitted to the bed frame.
- Please place the mattress on top of the bed frame.
- Standing at the foot of the frame (looking at the headboard) open the base and then press quite forcefully down on the mattress – please do not attempt to do this without the mattress being in place.
- Please do not pull on the strap handles.
- Please note as the pistons are full of gas – you will need to press heavily to release the compressed gas.
- Once done the pistons should start operating as normal.



Please dispose of all packaging safely.

General Care & Maintenance

Wipe clean with a slightly damp cloth.
Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

Periodically check all screw & fixings to ensure they are secure.

When moving your product, carefully lift into place. Never drag or push the product across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints. If the product is used on hard flooring, such as wood or laminated floor, you must place some protection under the legs to stop the product from moving. If this is not adhered to, it could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.
