Mya 3FT Wooden Bunk Bed



Important before assembly:

Read these instructions carefully before assembling or using the product.

Please check the contents of the boxes before attempting to assemble this product. The instructions will have a checklist of parts and fittings.

It would be sensible to lay a rug or a carpet on the floor where you intend to assemble the product, to avoid scratches and damaging the product or the floor.

Assemble the product as close to its intended final location/room as possible.

Do NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame.

This product or some parts of this product will be heavy. Please use an assistant when lifting.

Please keep small parts out of reach of children.

Always use on a level, even surface.

DO NOT jump on the product or any of its parts.

DO NOT use this product if any parts are missing, damaged or worn.

DO NOT use this product unless all fixings are secured.

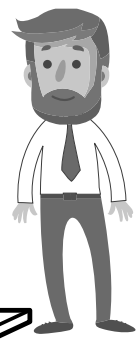

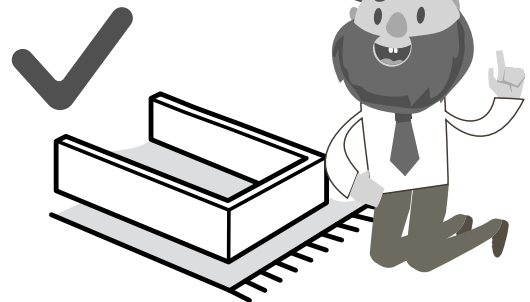
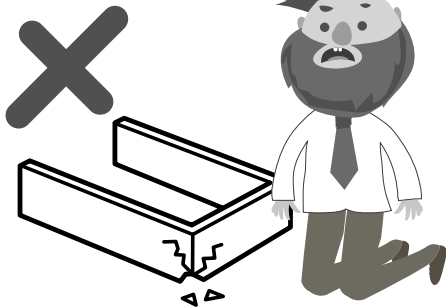

These tools are not necessary, but may help to assemble certain parts of the product.

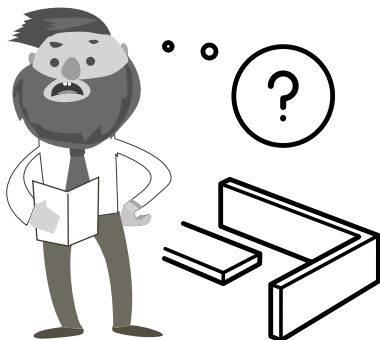
Do NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame.

It would be sensible to lay a sheet or blanket on the floor where you intend to work to avoid scratching this product and protect your floor.

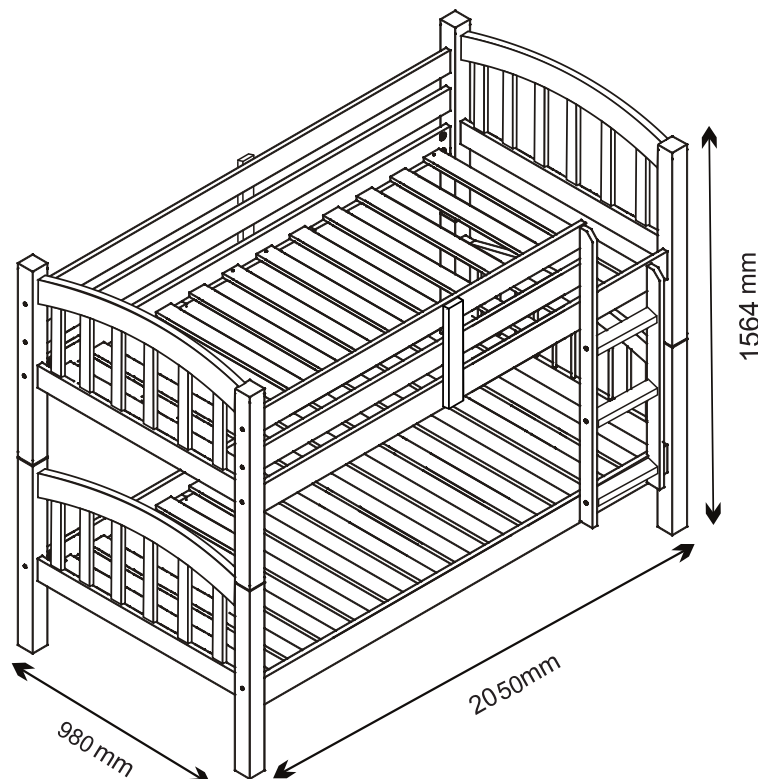
This product is heavy. Take extreme care when lifting to avoid personal injury or damage to the product.

This bed is heavy. Always lift the bed with two people.

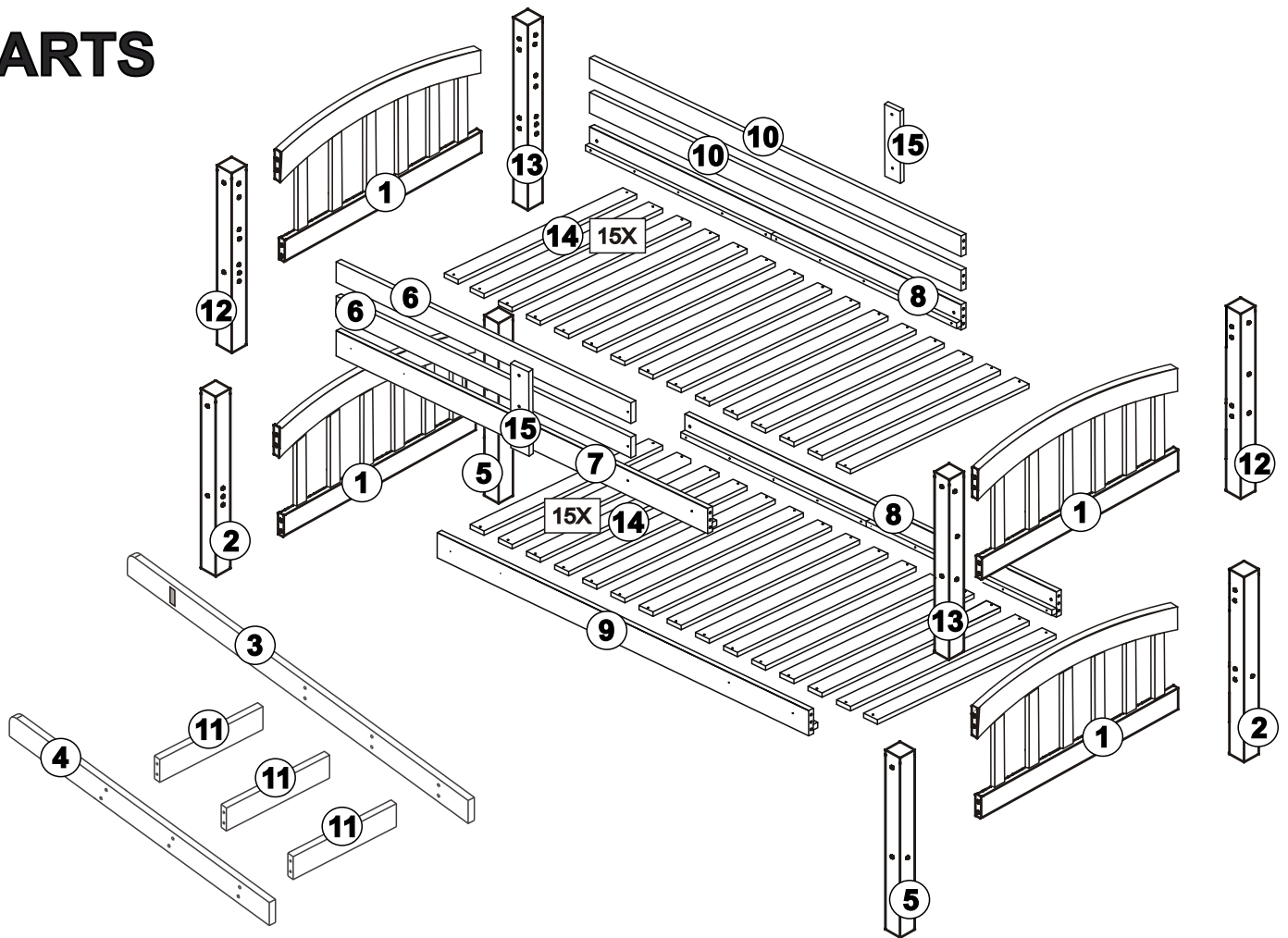
Assemble the product as close to its intended final position in the room as possible.














Keep any sharp objects away from the bed frame.

HANDY HINT: If you keep the hardware in a bowl during assembly you will be less likely to lose them.

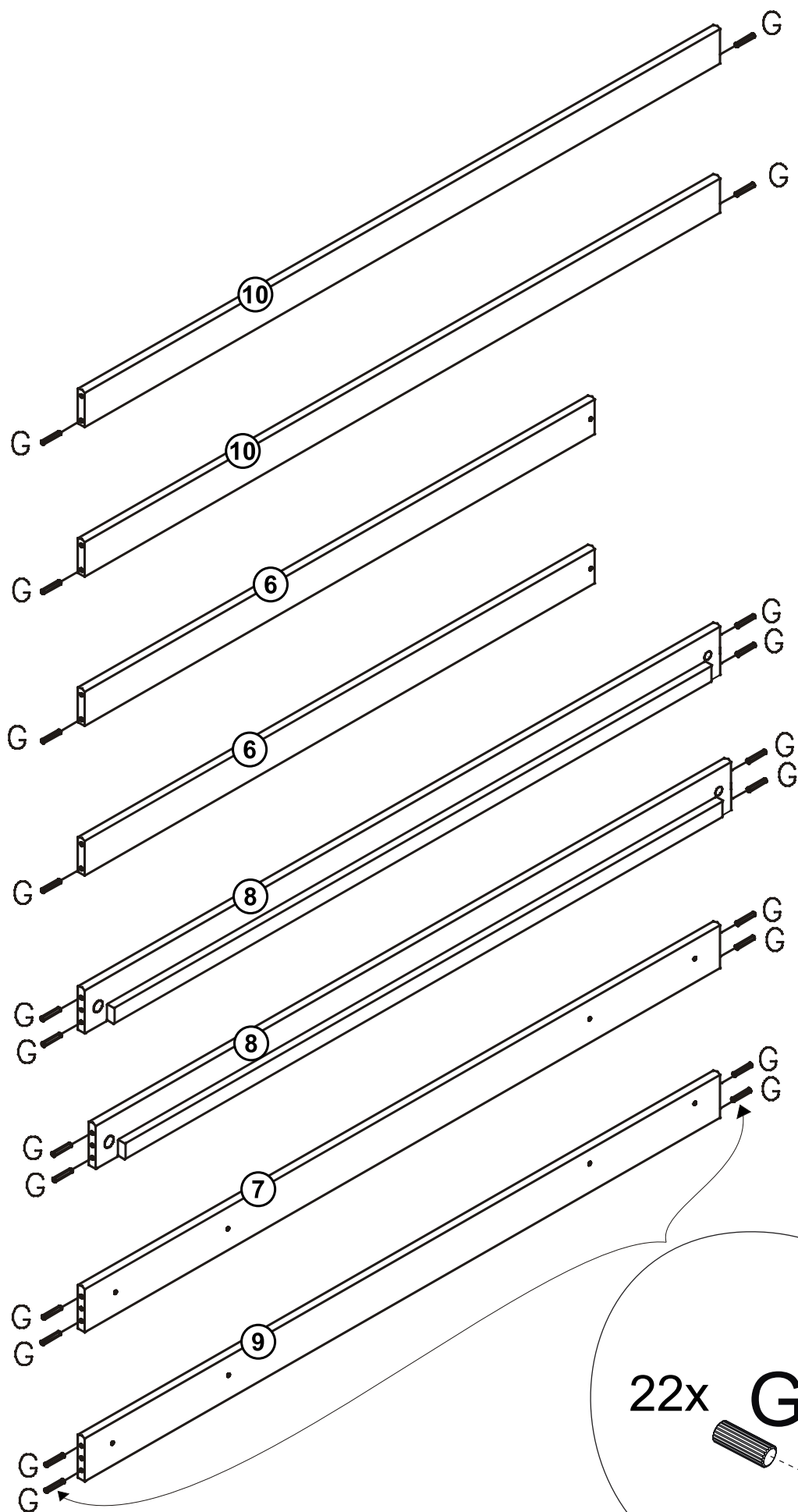

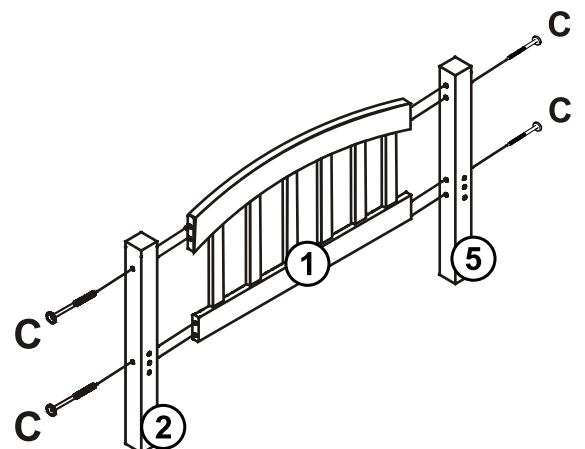
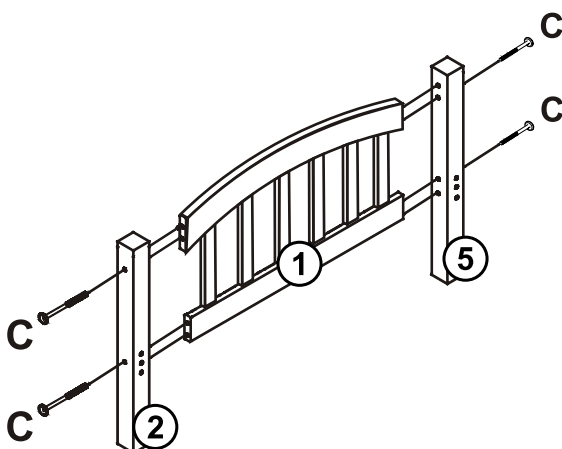
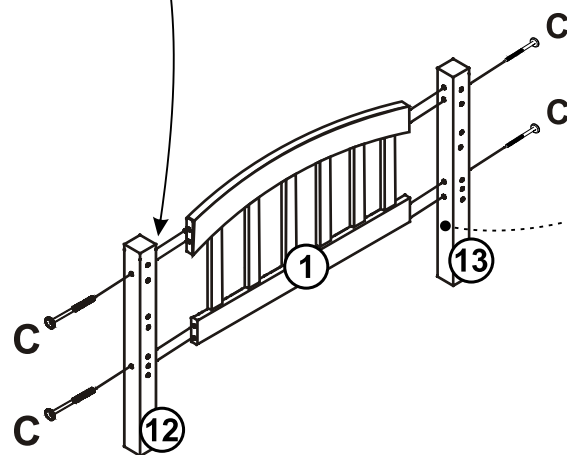
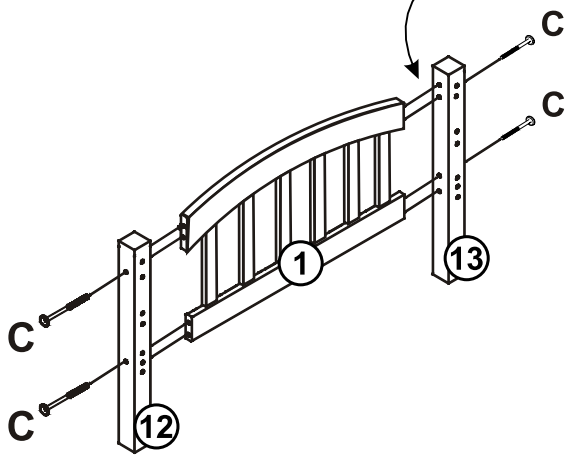
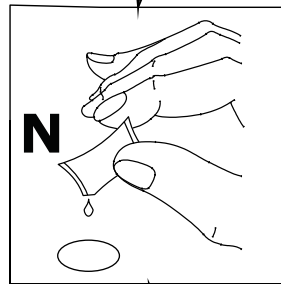
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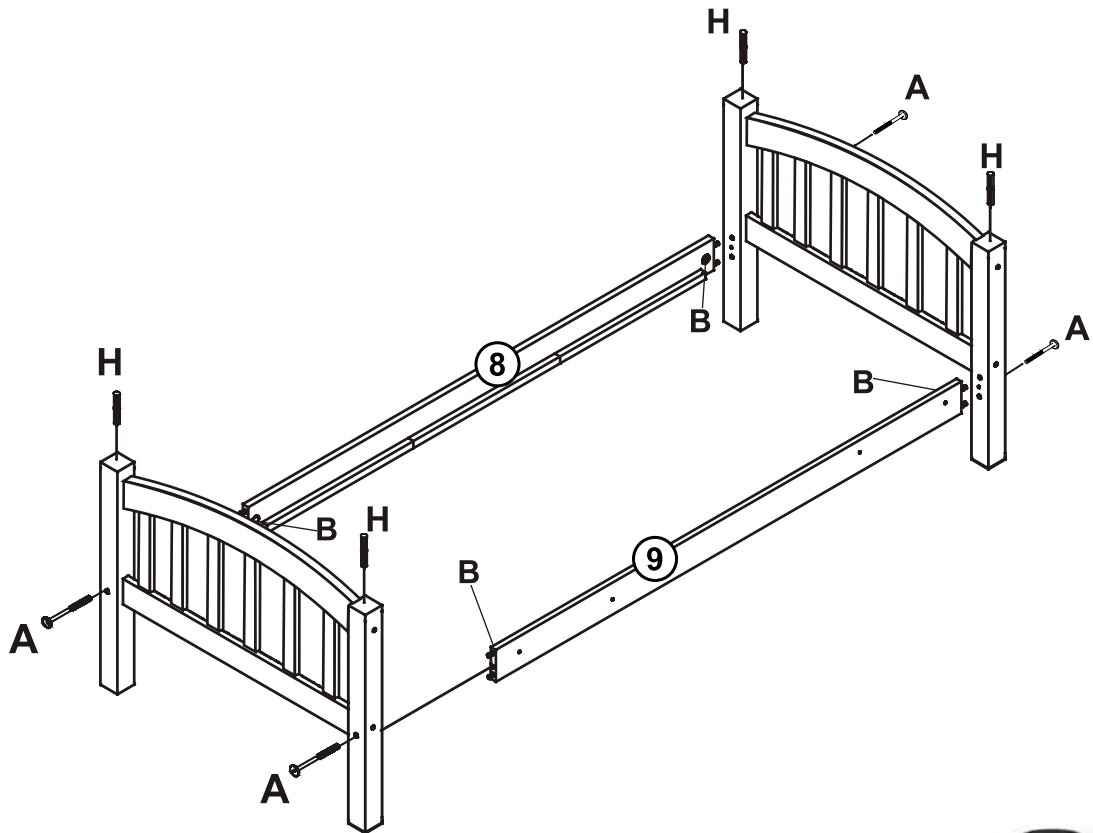


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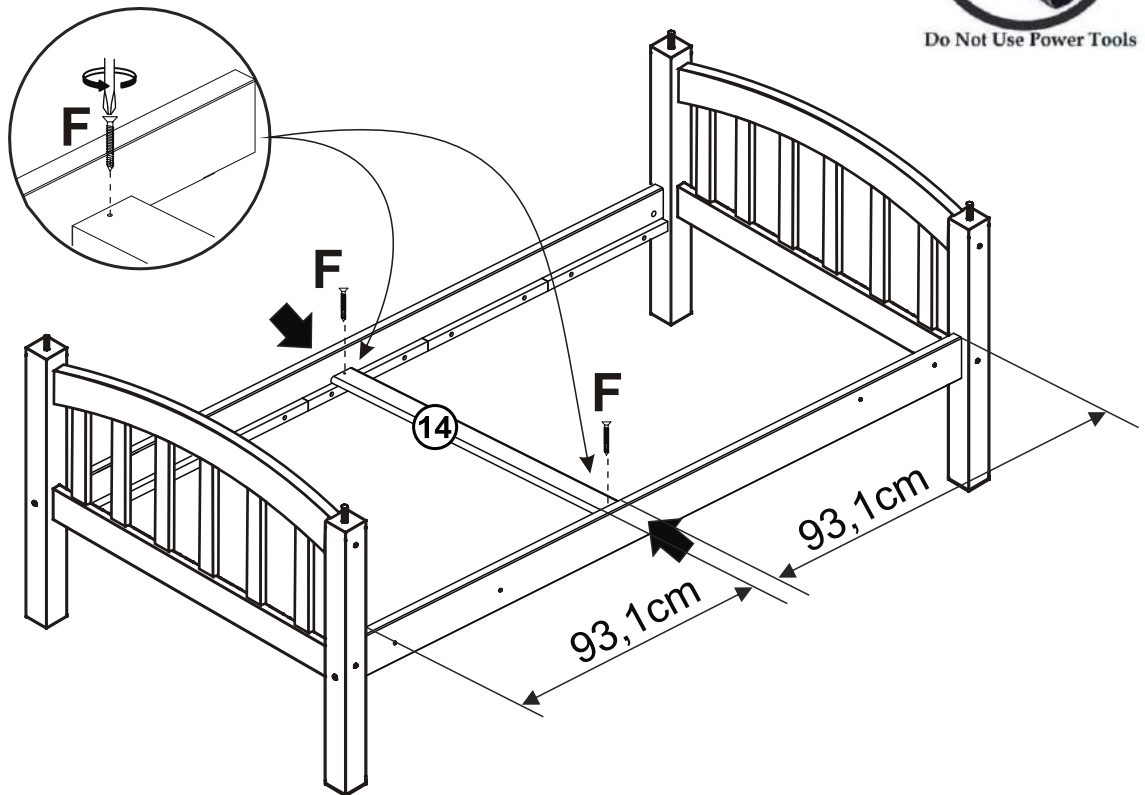


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BOTTOM TIER BUNK

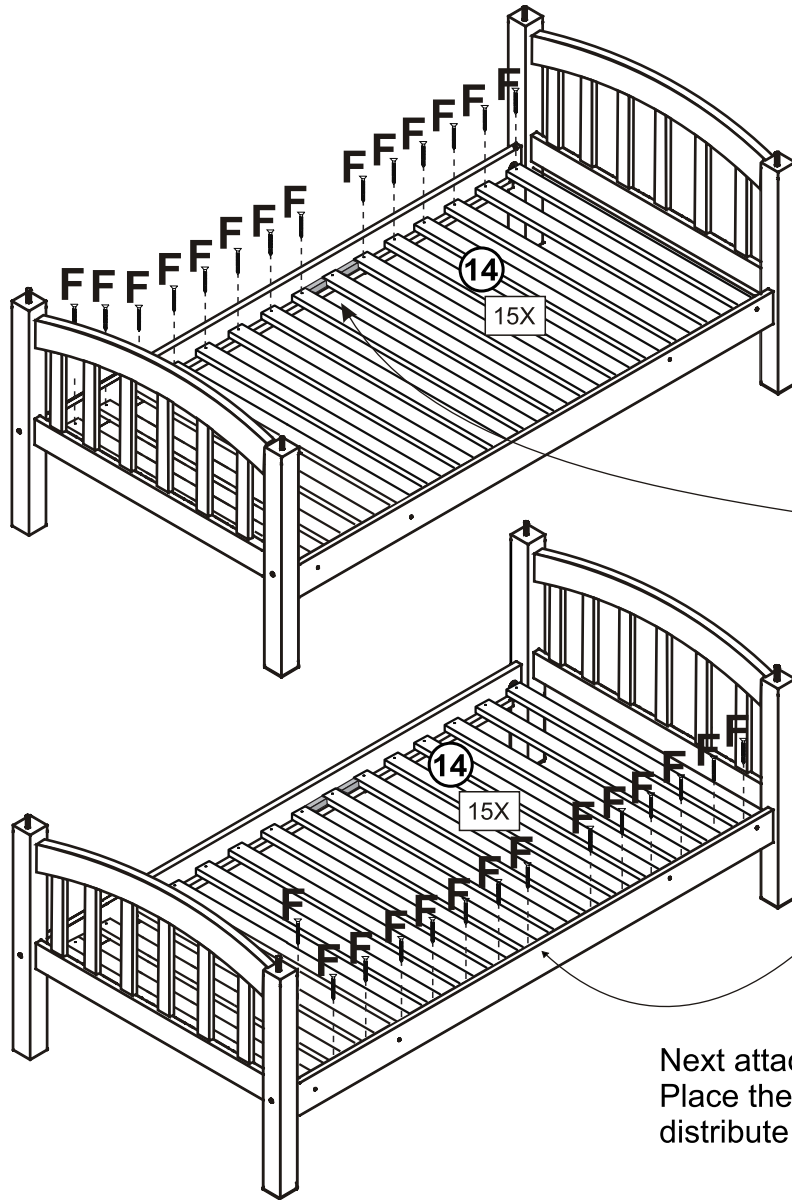


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Attach the centre slat first by pushing the side rails together so that the slat is flush against the side rail, before inserting the screws.

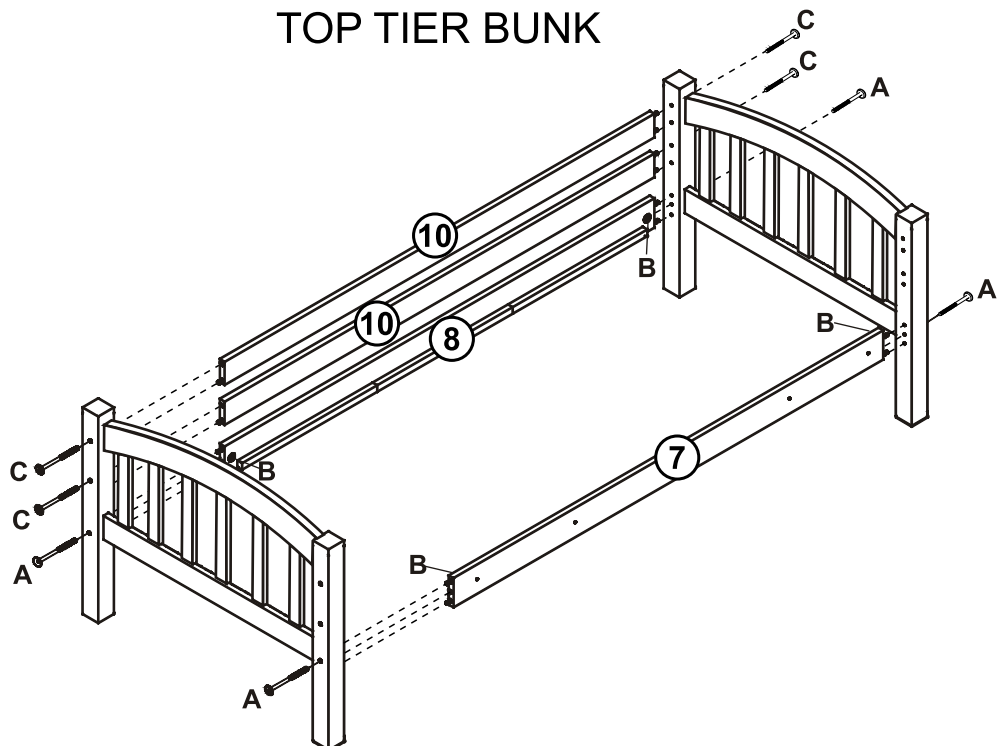
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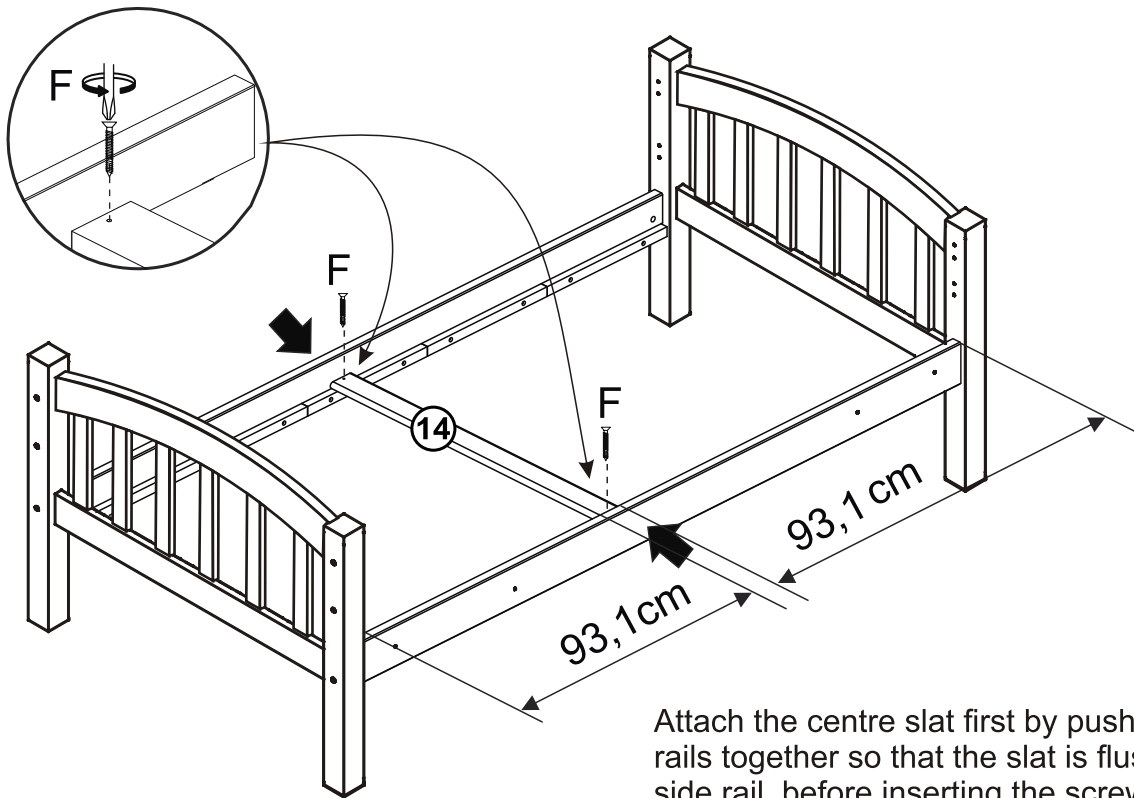
Next attach the remaining slats.

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TOP TIER BUNK

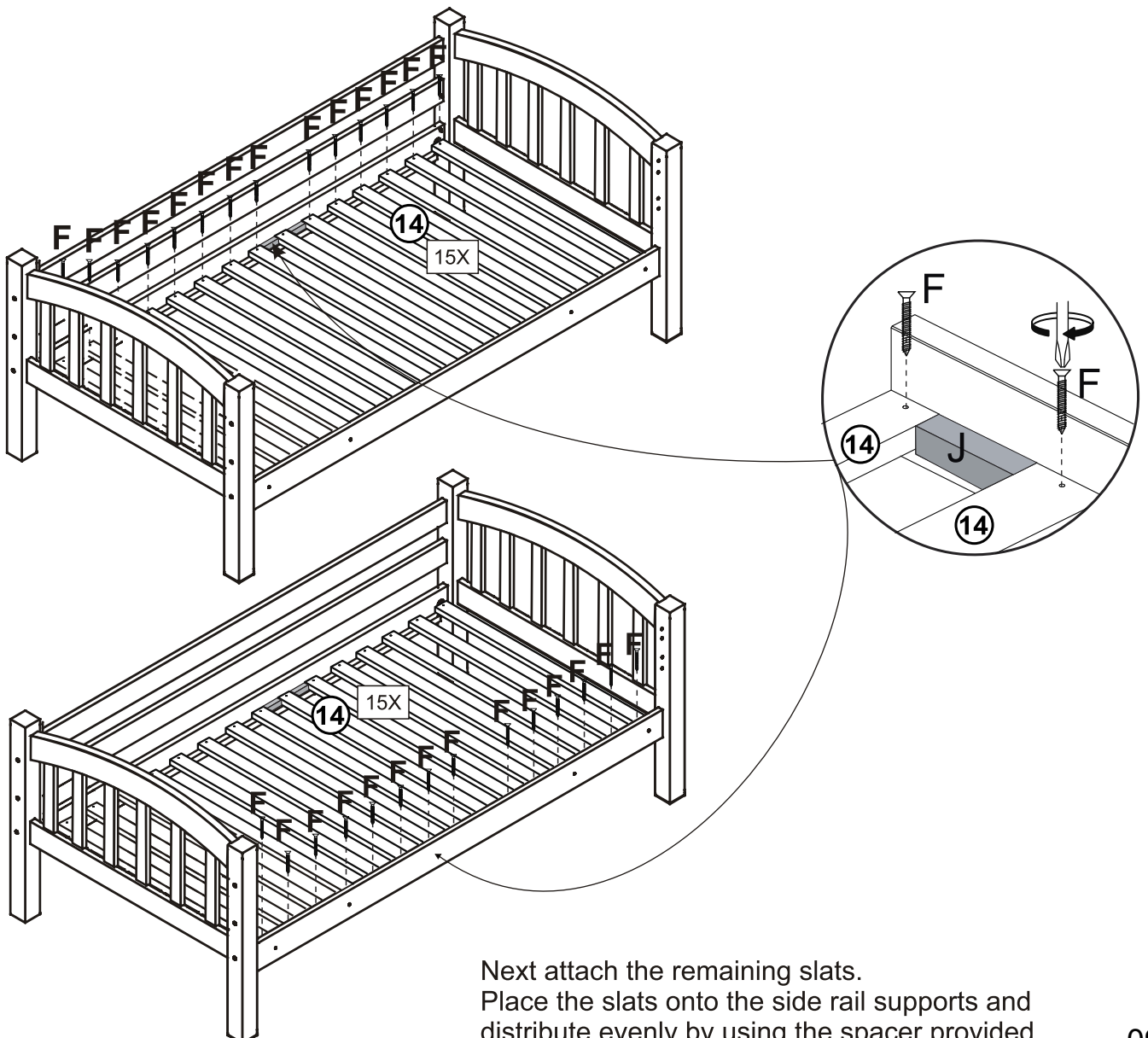


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Attach the centre slat first by pushing the side rails together so that the slat is flush against the side rail, before inserting the screws.

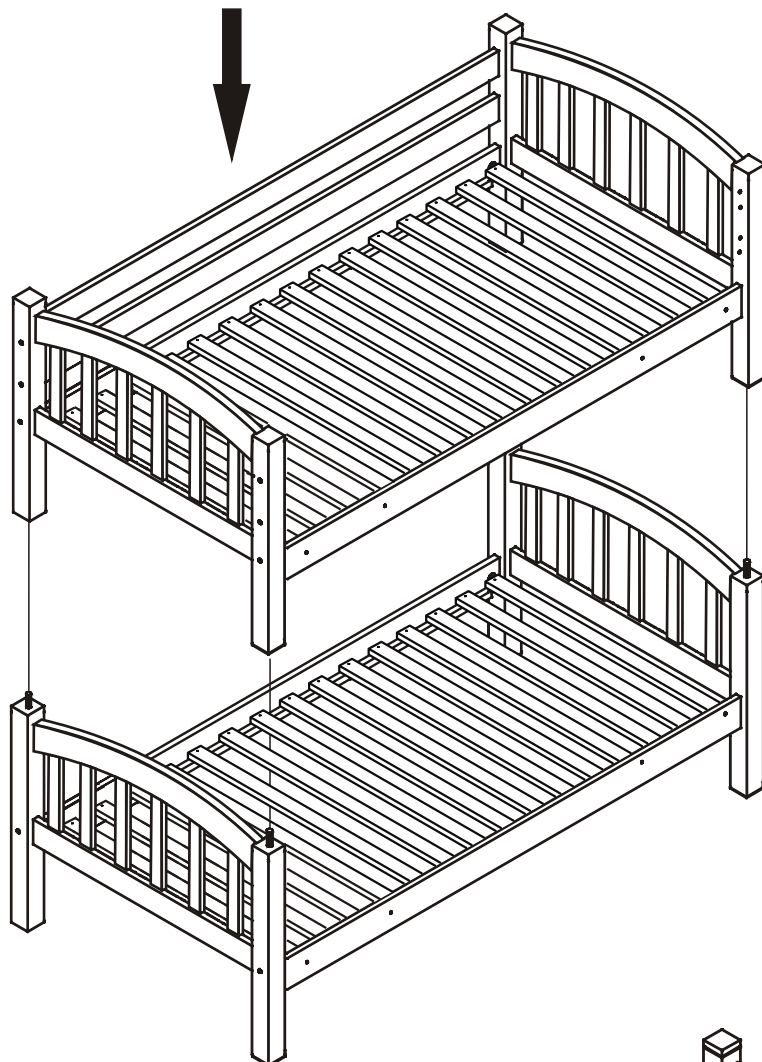
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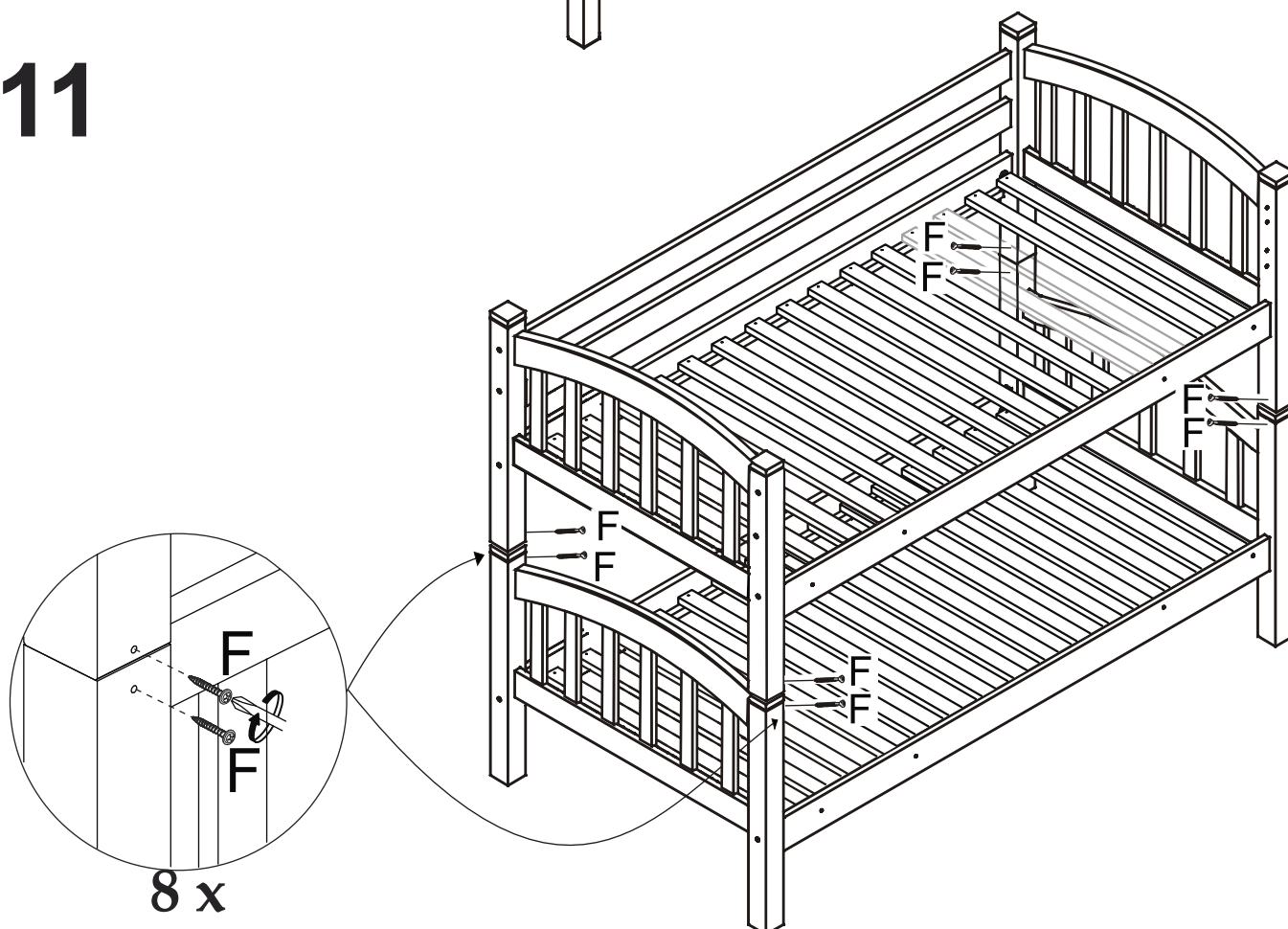
Next attach the remaining slats. Place the slats onto the side rail supports and distribute evenly by using the spacer provided.

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ASSEMBLY OF TOP AND BOTTOM TIERS

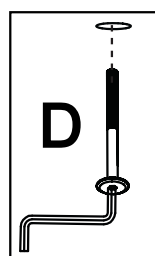
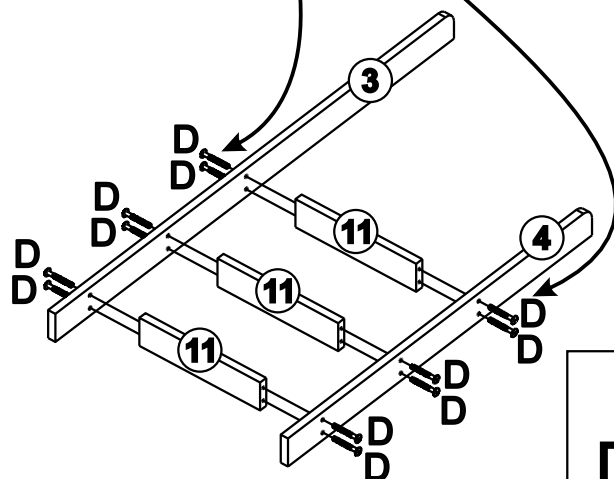
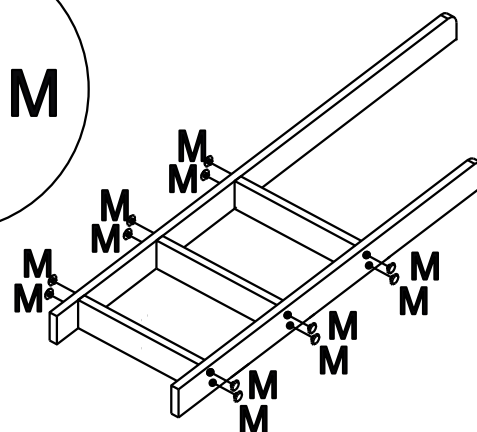
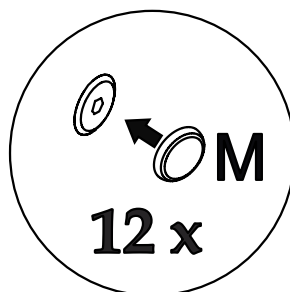
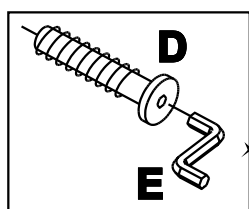


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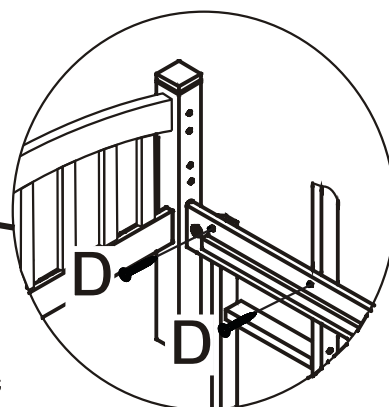


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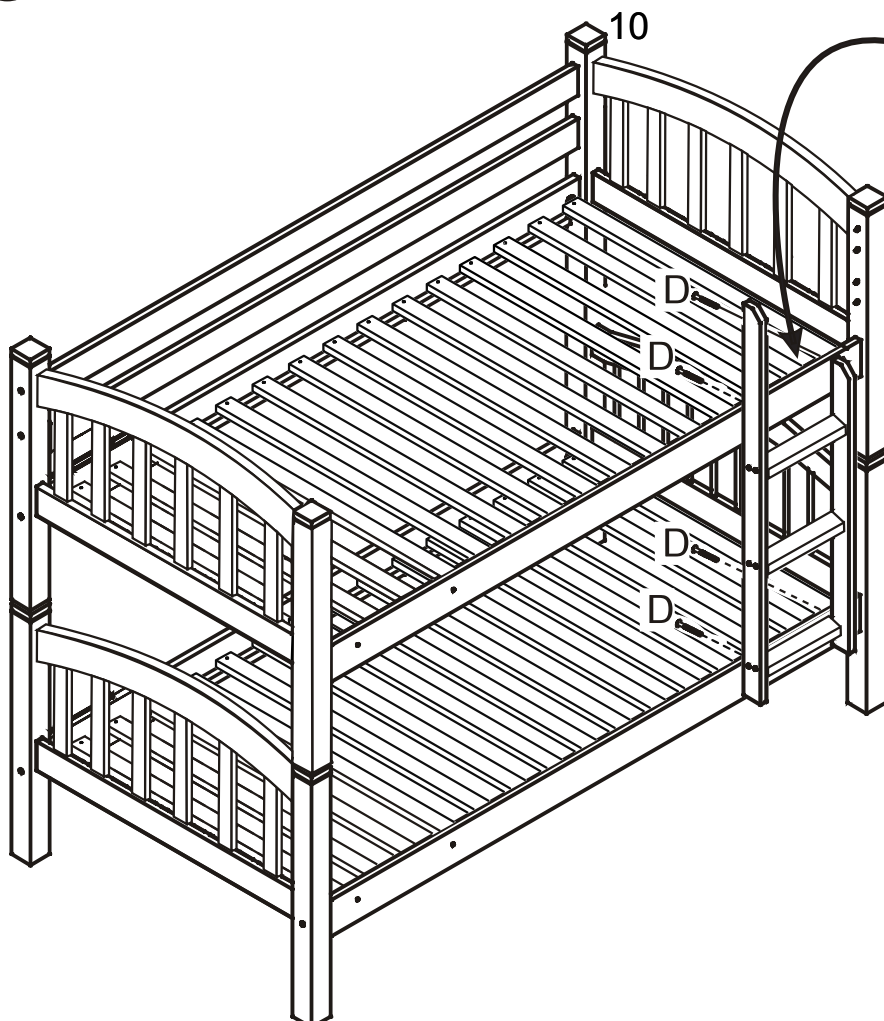
OPTION 1: ASSEMBLING LADDER ON RIGHT HAND SIDE



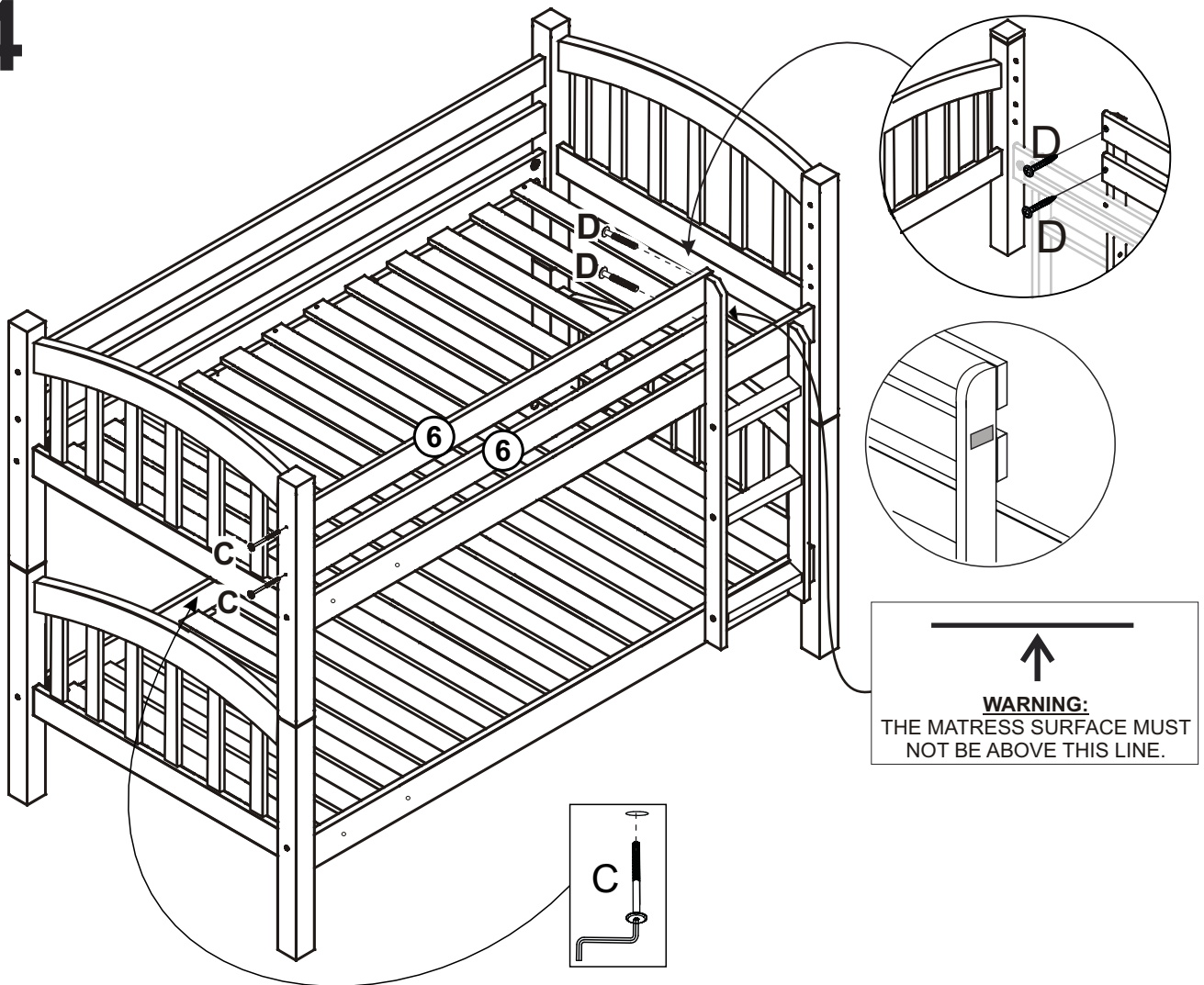
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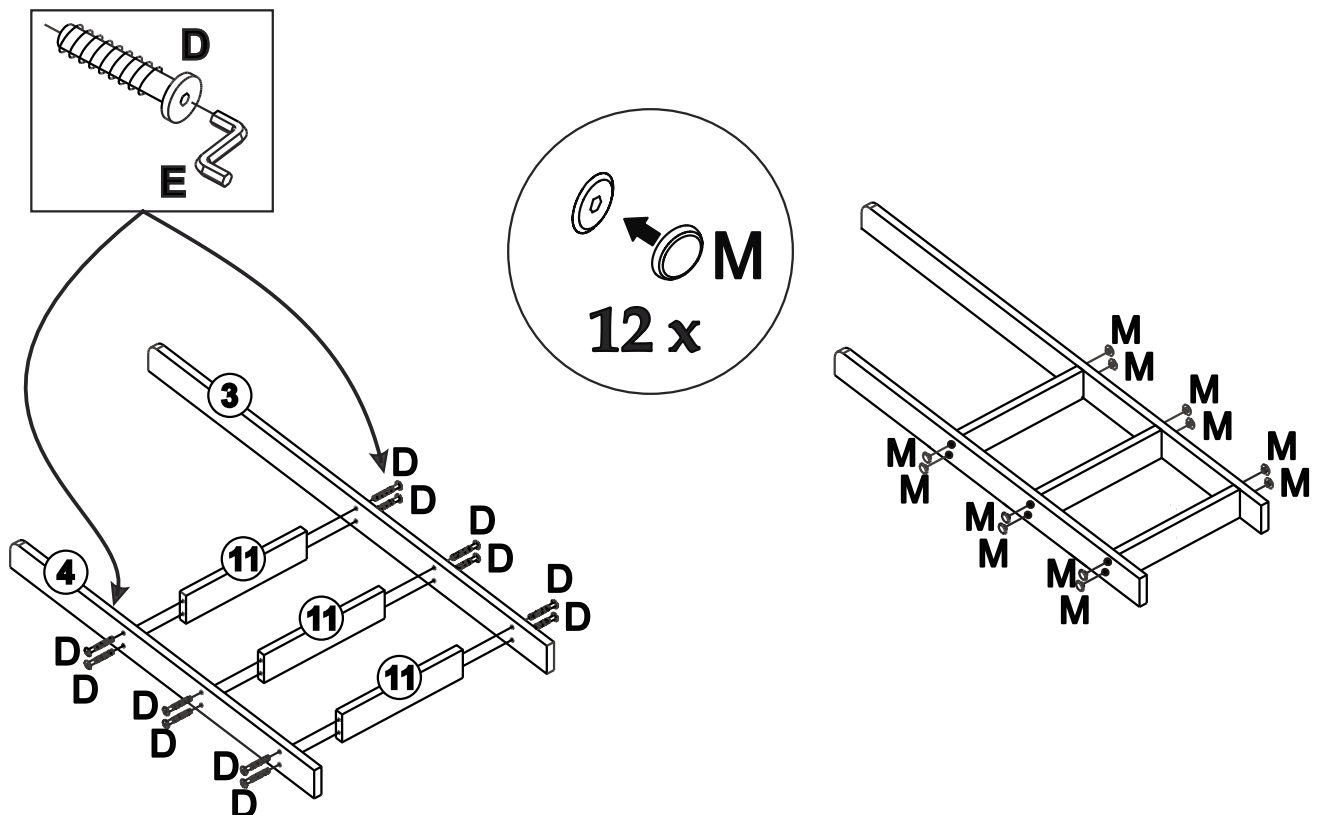


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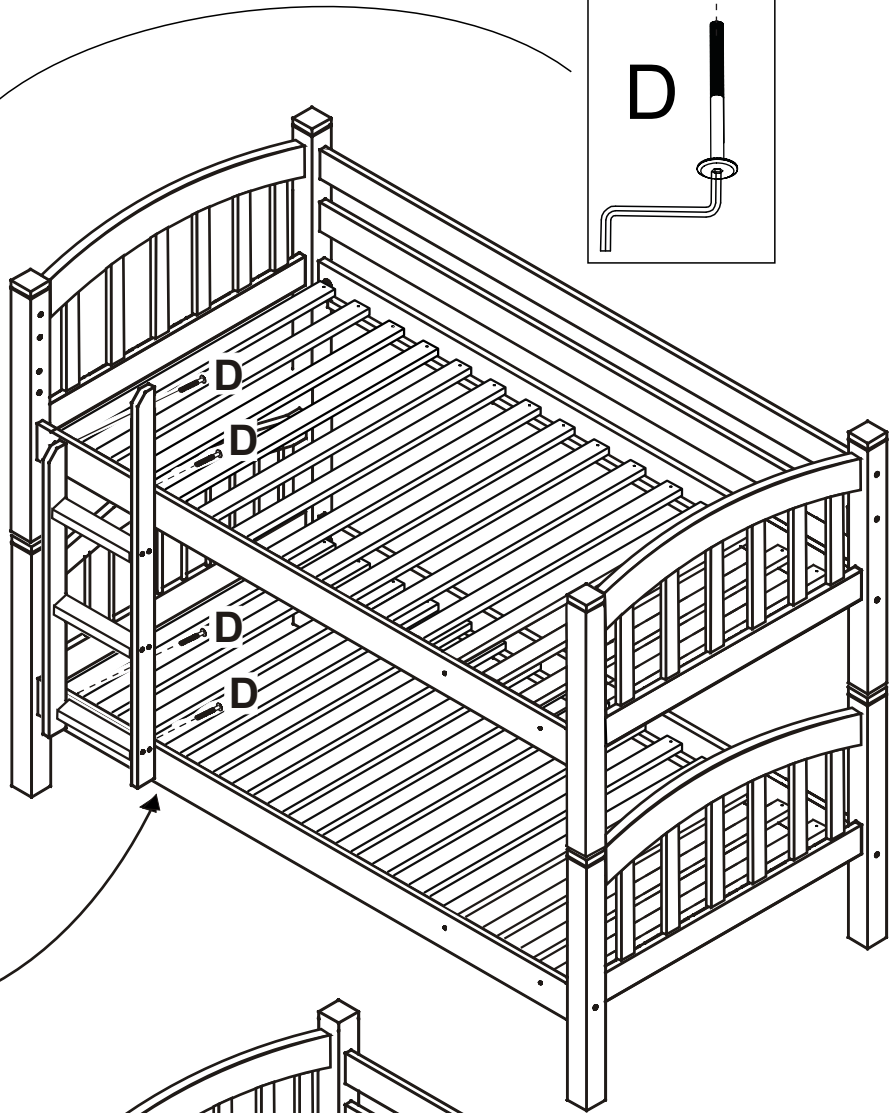
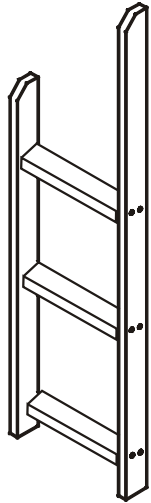
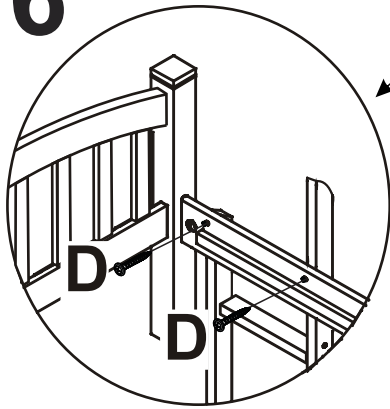


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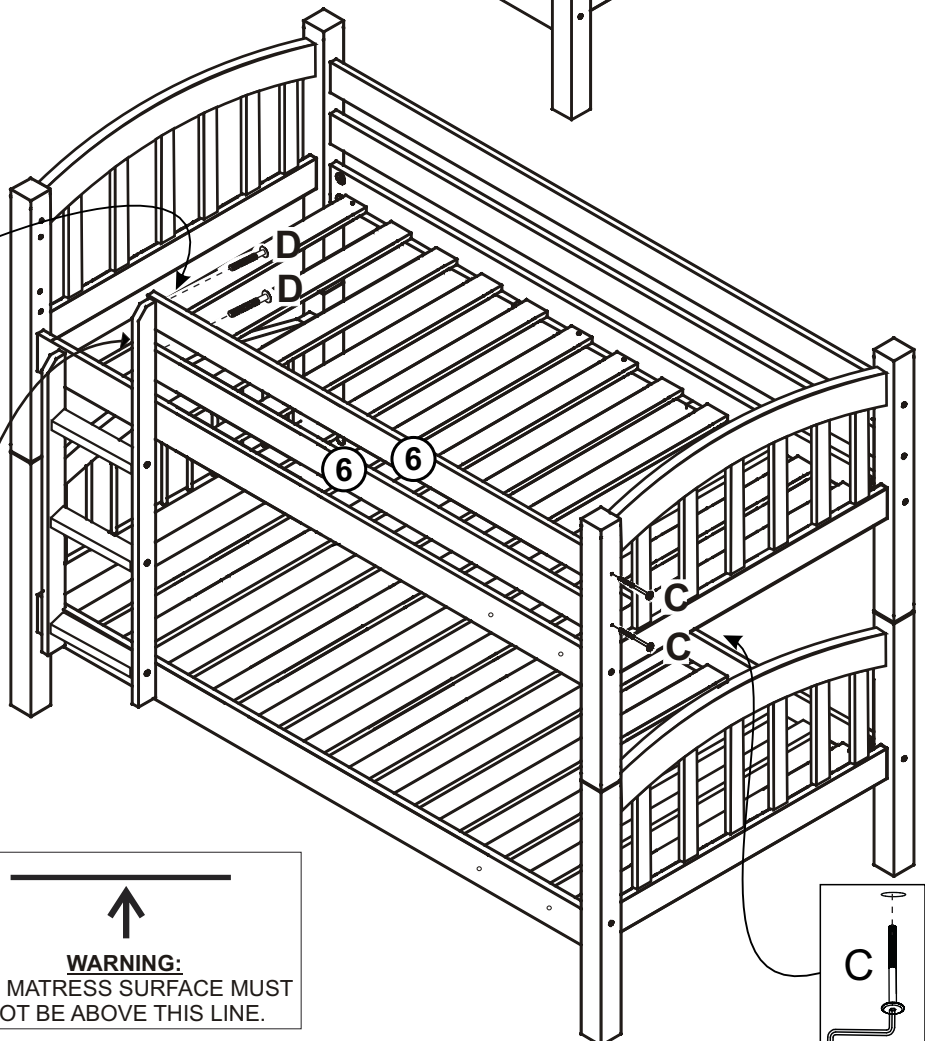
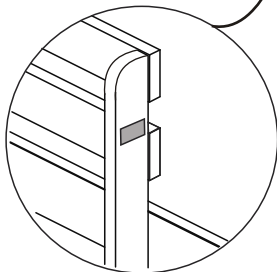
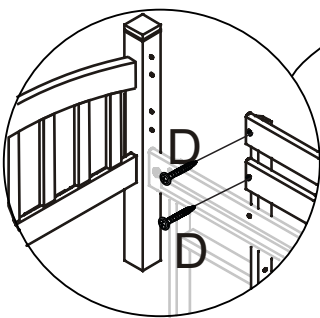
OPTION 2: ASSEMBLING LADDER ON LEFT HAND SIDE



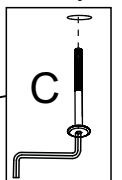
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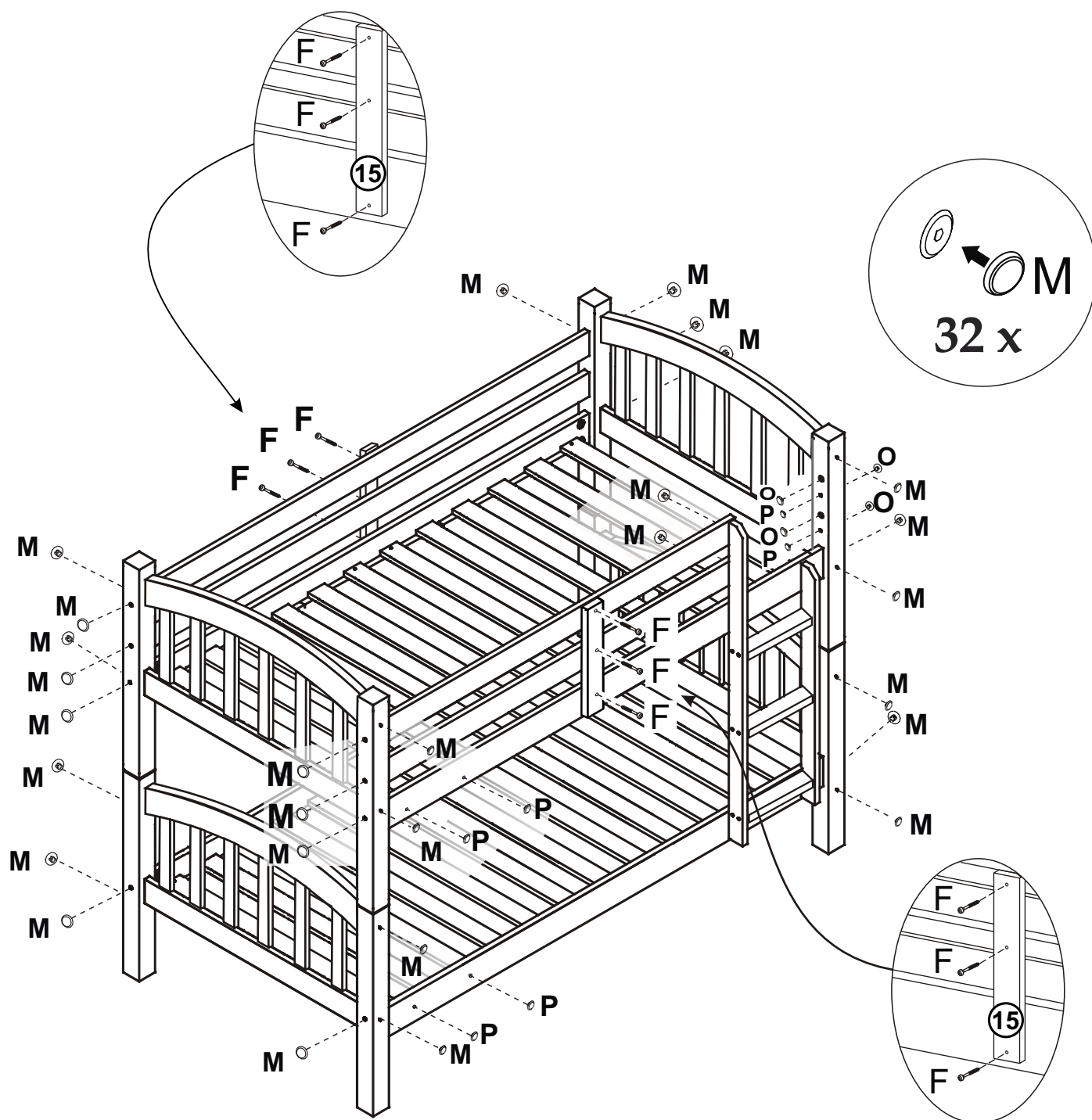
