Always use on a level, even surface.

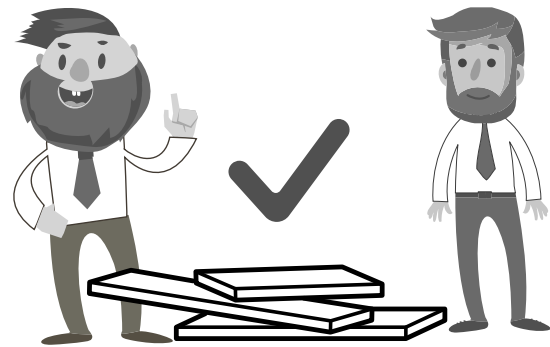
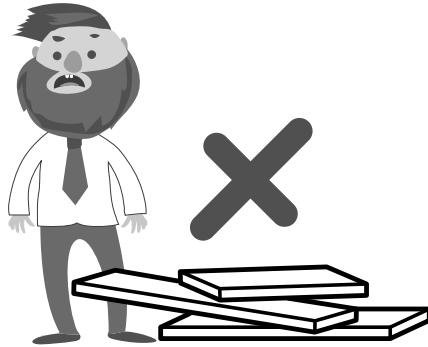
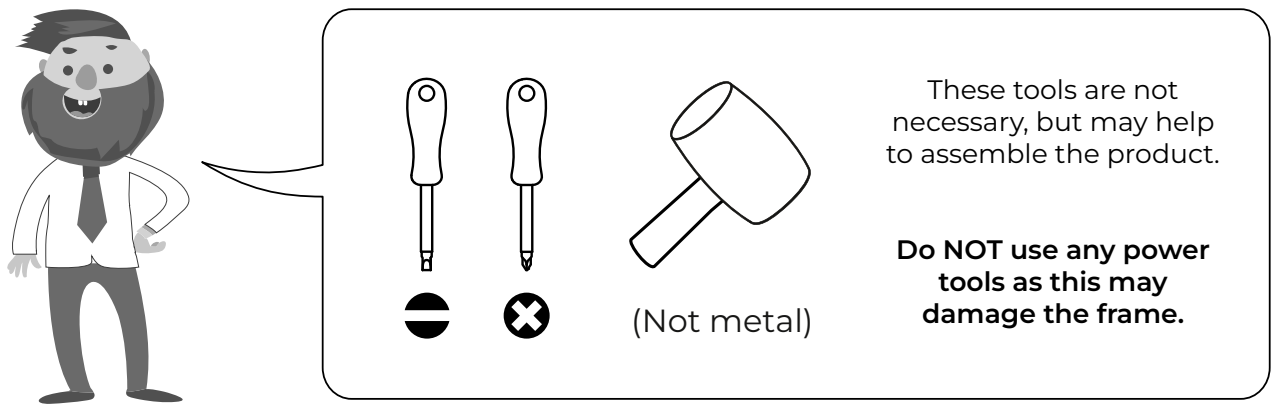

Never drag or push the pieces across a hard or stone floor as this will cause damage to the joints. Use a carpet or a rug for extra care.



















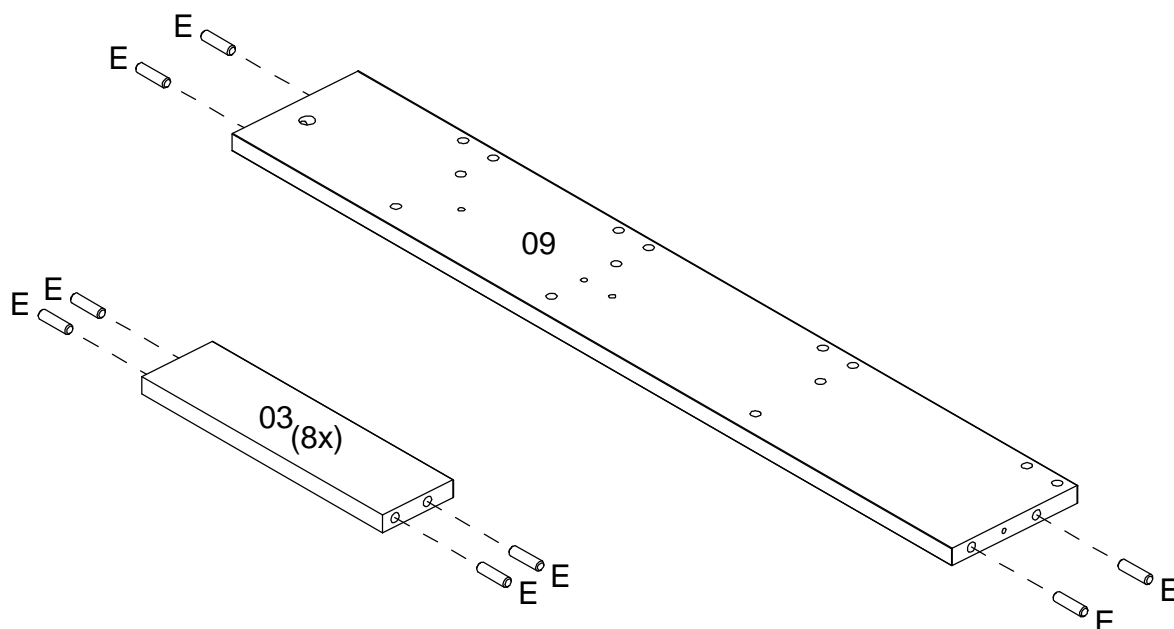
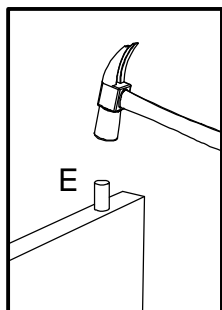
Step 1: Insert hardware part F1 using small mallet (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



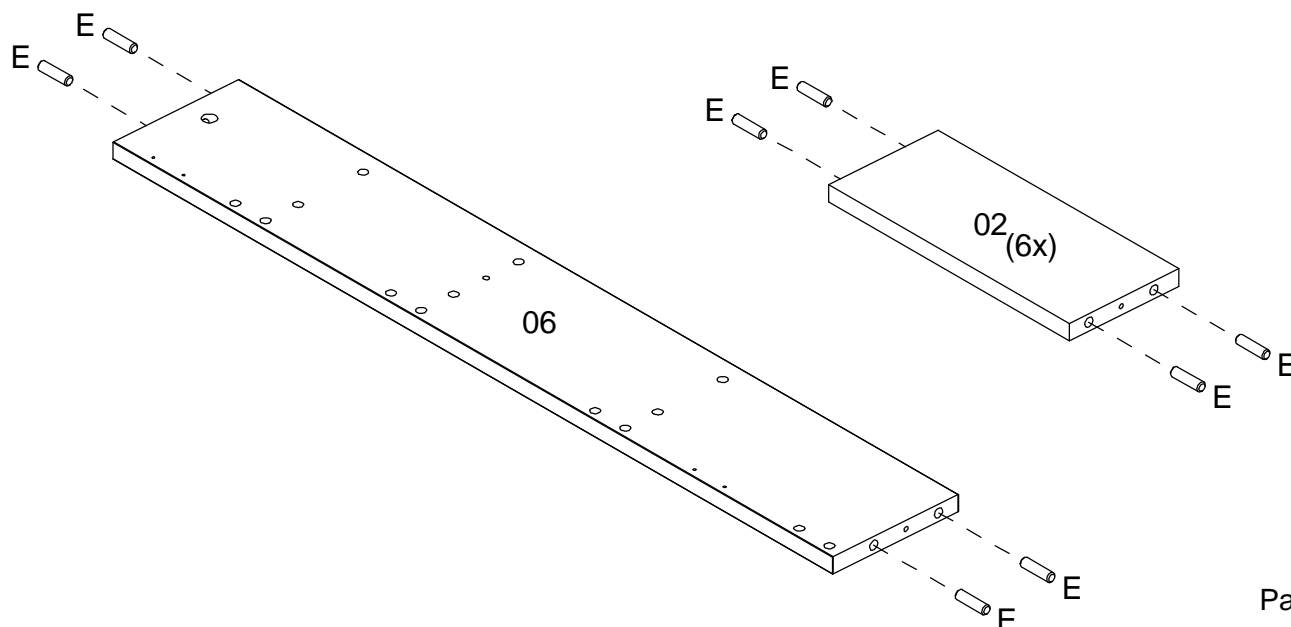
Step 2: Insert hardware part E using small mallet (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



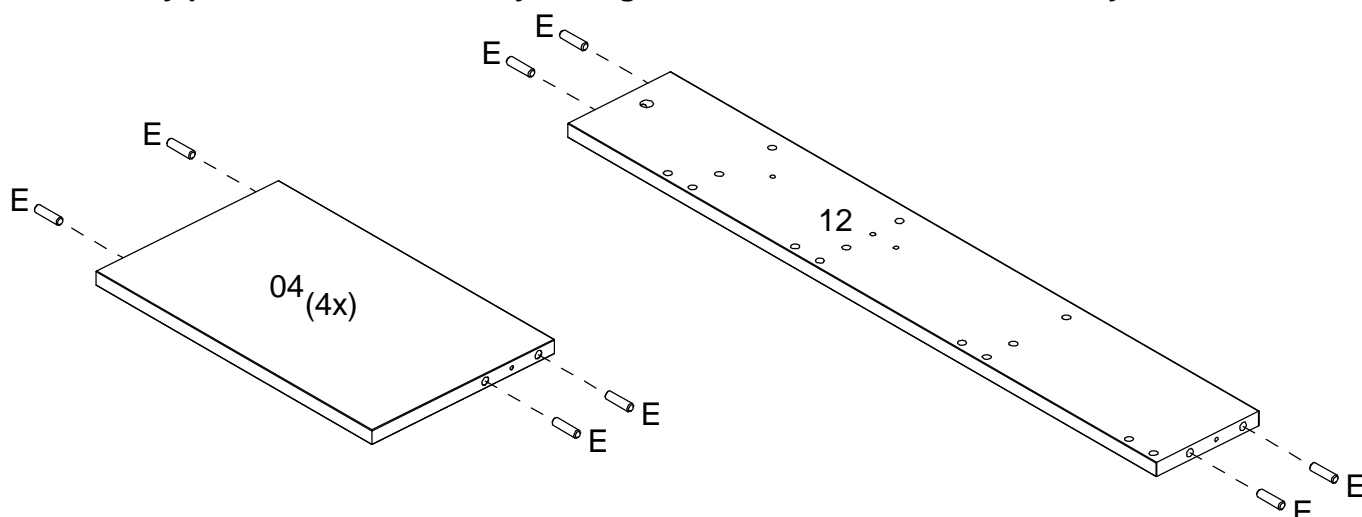
Step 3: Insert hardware part E using small mallet (not provided).

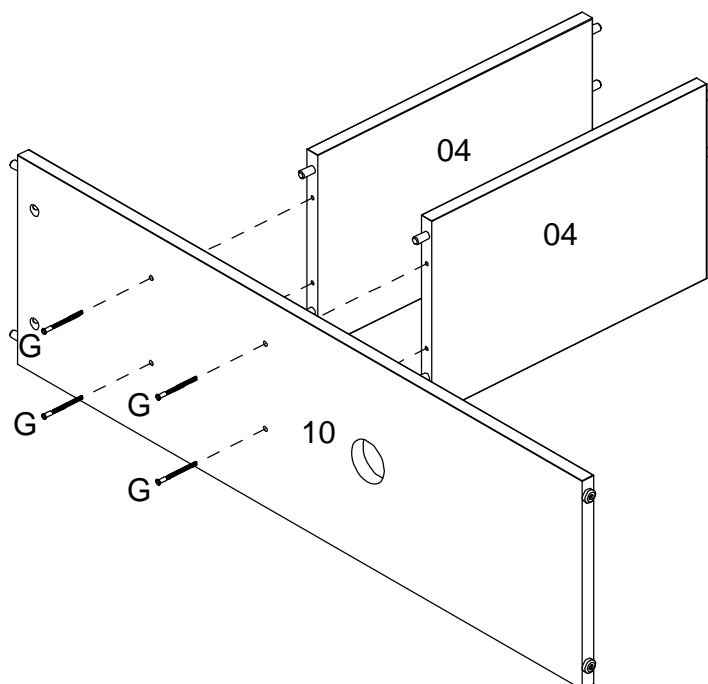
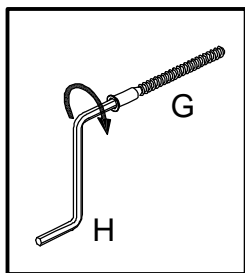
Step 7: Insert hardware part B5 using hardware part S and screwdriver (not provided).
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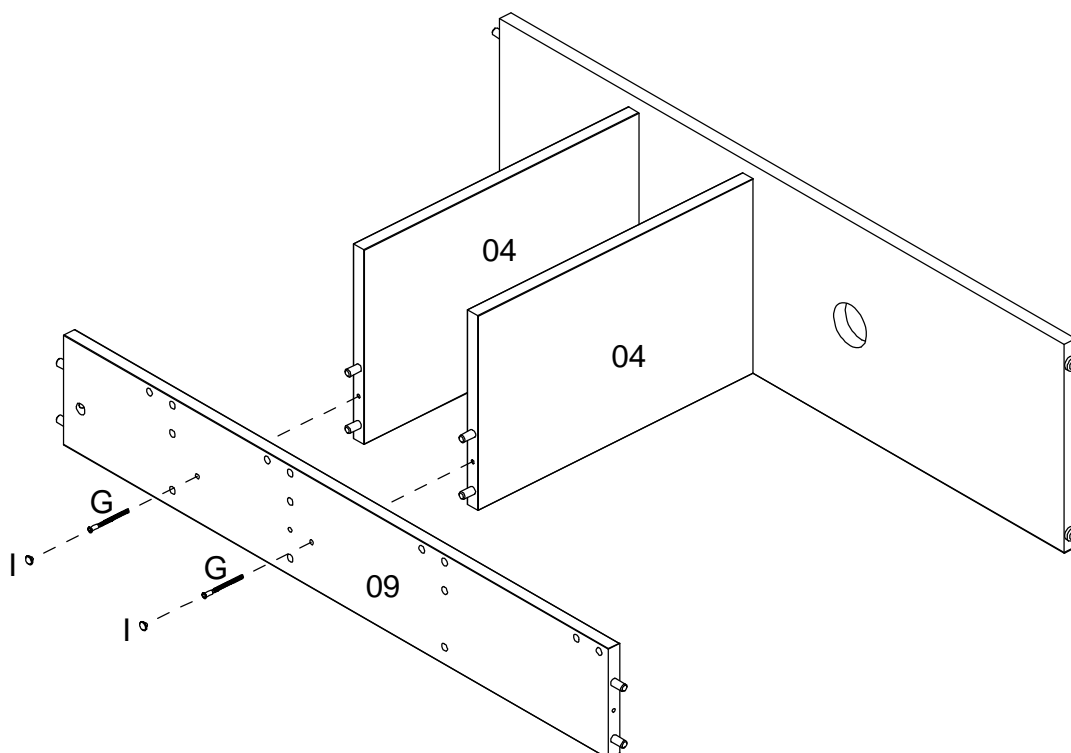
Step 8: Insert hardware part J with a screwdriver (not provided). Insert hardware part V15 using hardware part S and screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



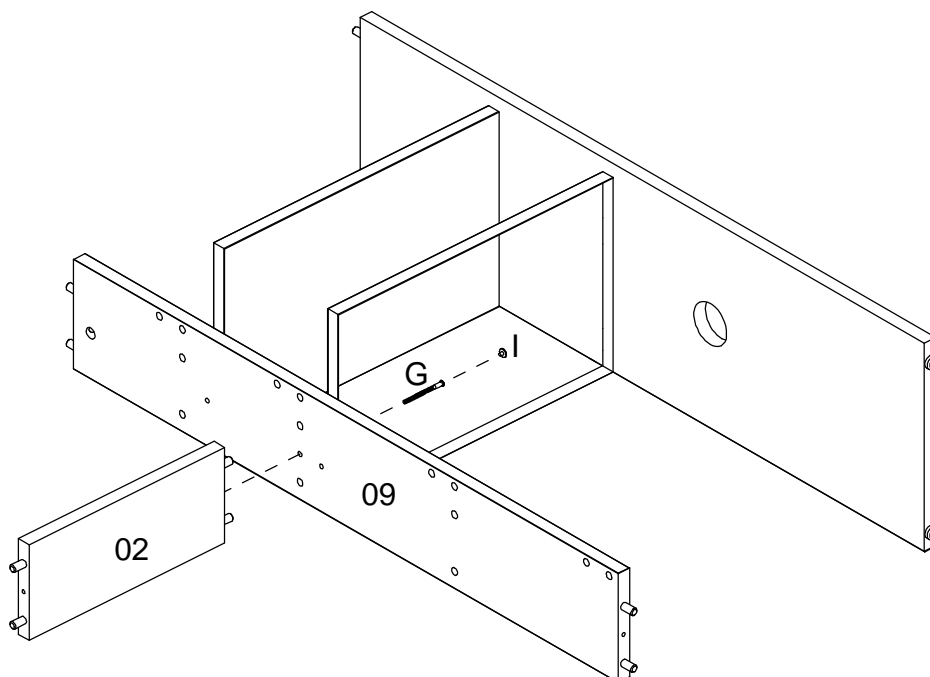
Step 9: Attach the shelf (04) to the left coast (10) using hardware part G and H.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



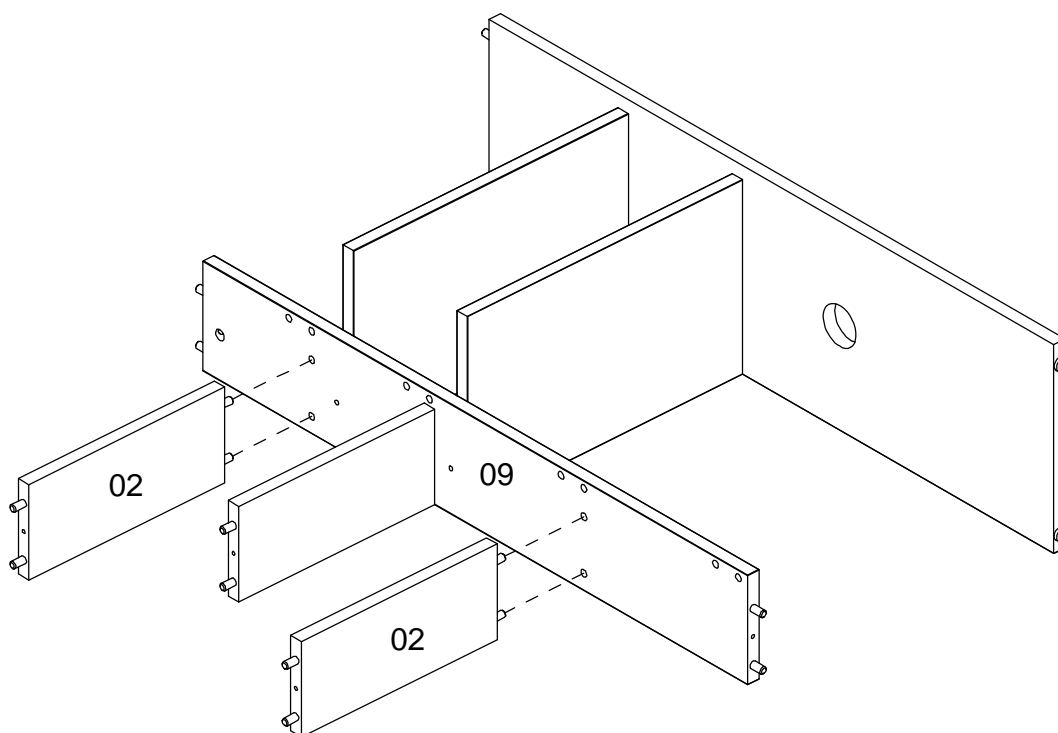
Step 10: Join the left division (09) to the assembled section using hardware part G,H and I.

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

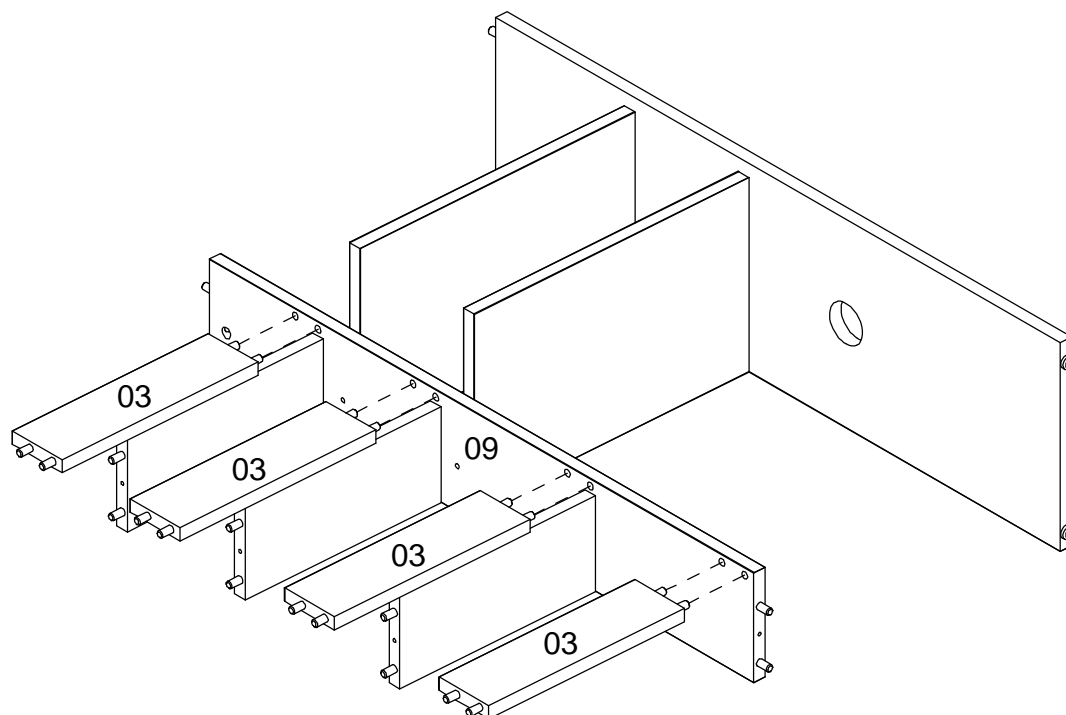


Step 12: Join the shelf smaller fixed module (02) to the assembled section.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



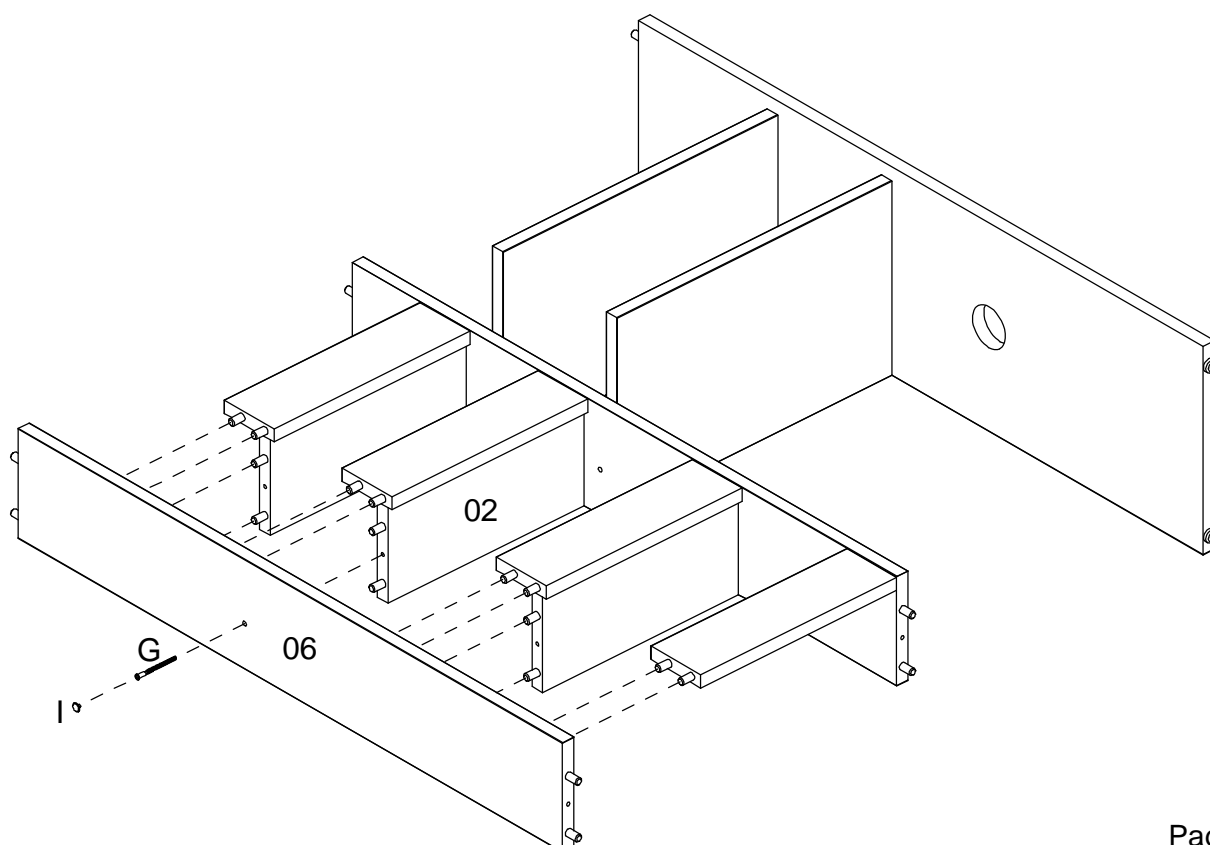
Step 13: Join the tray fixed module (03) to the assembled section.

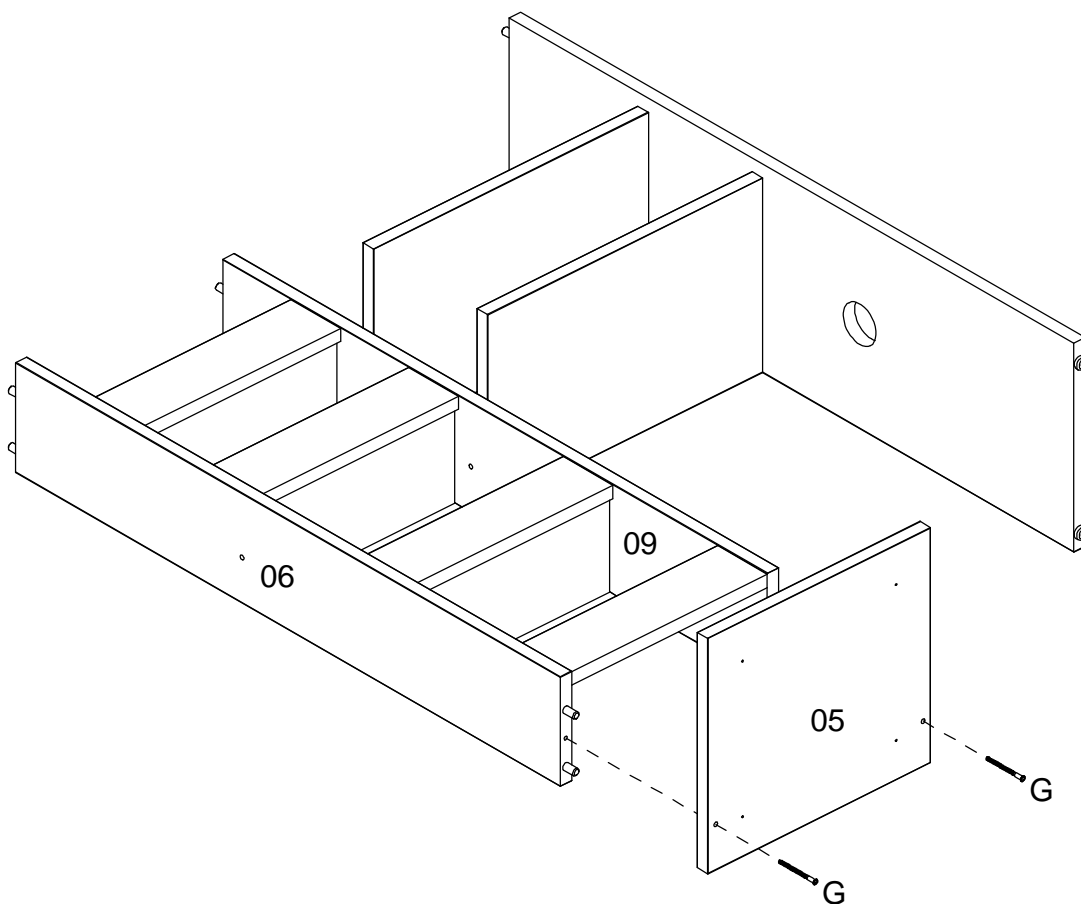


Step 14: Join the left side fixed module left (06) to the assembled section using hardware part G,H and I.

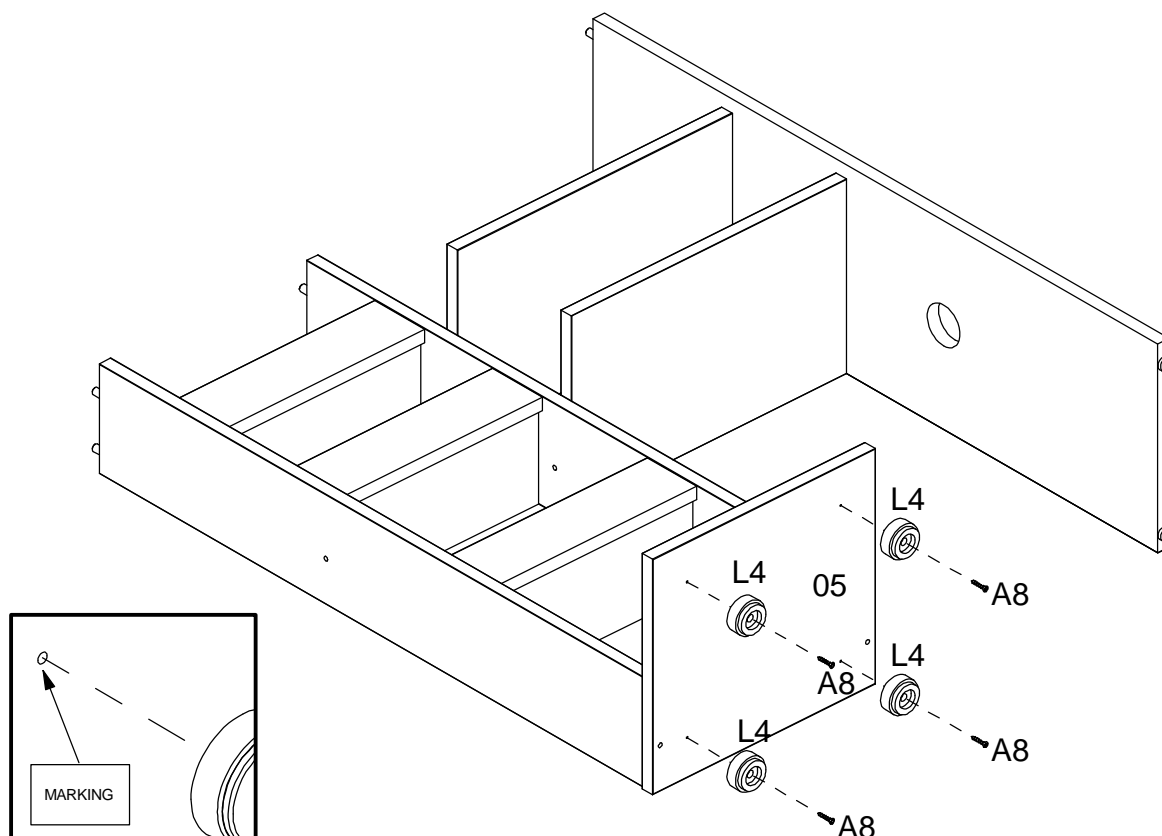

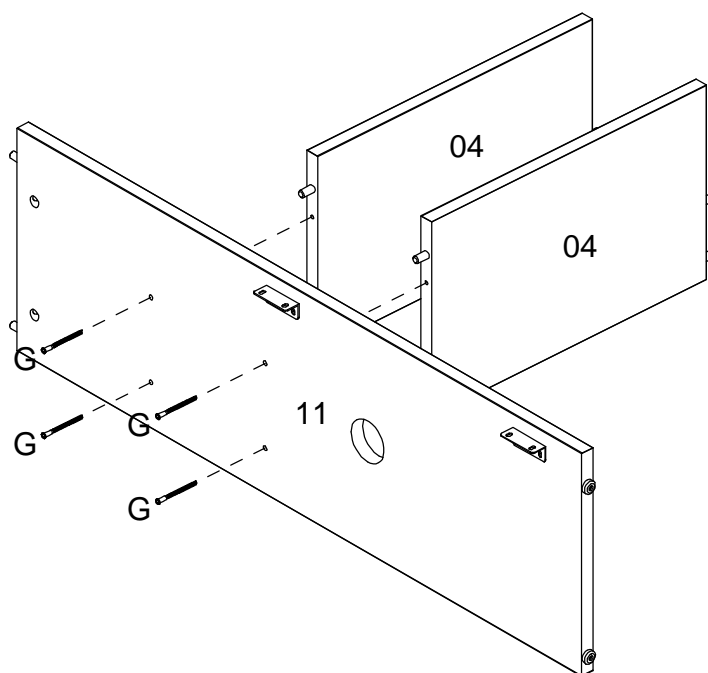
Step 15: Join the bottom base (05) to the assembled section using hardware part G and H.

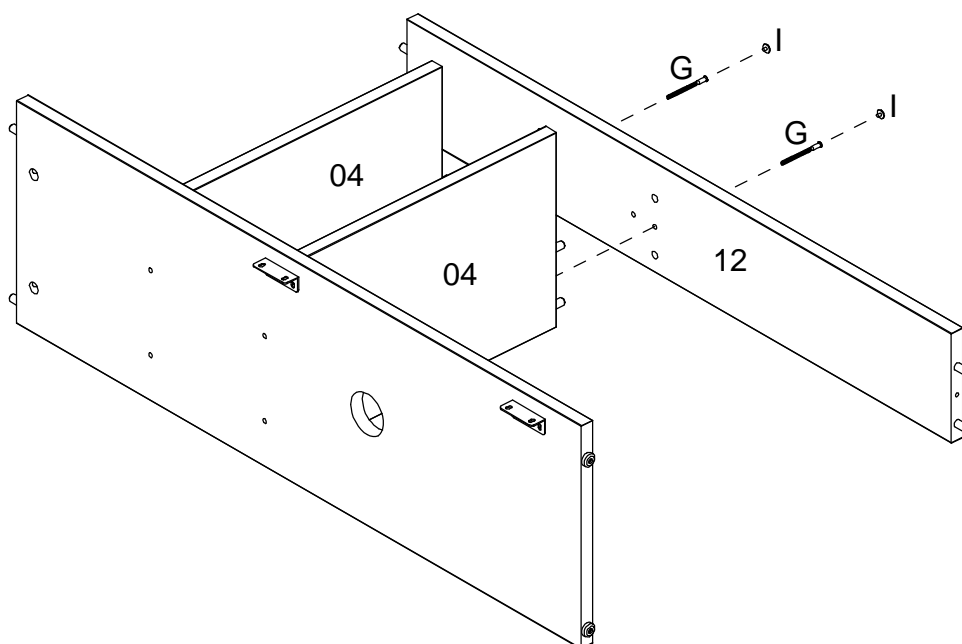
Step 16: Insert hardware part L4 using hardware part A8 with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



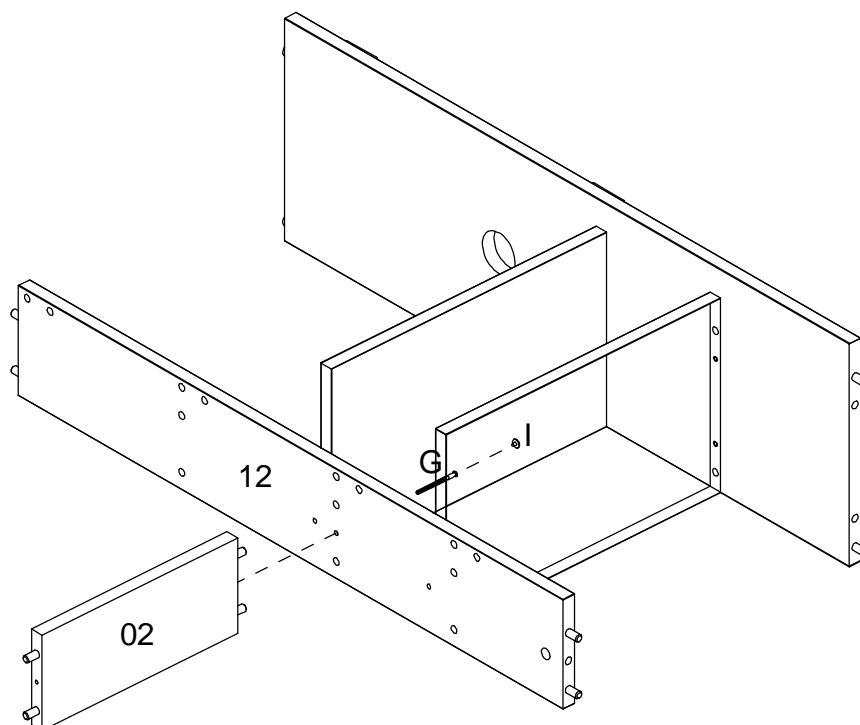
Step 17: Attach the shelf (04) to the right coast (11) using hardware part G and H.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



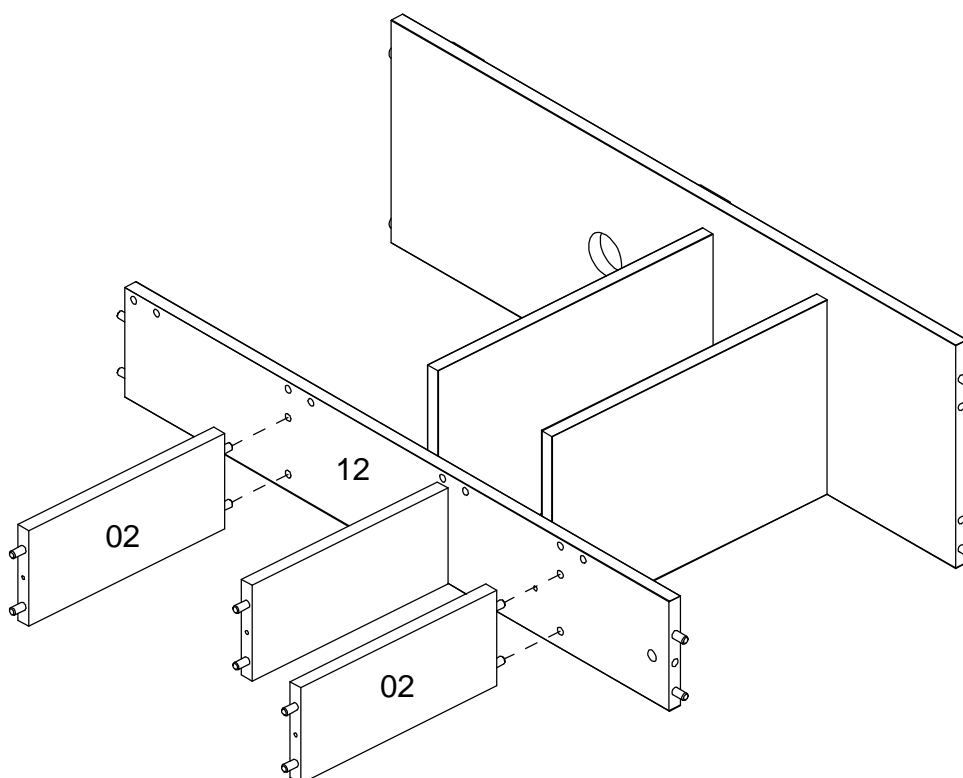
Step 18: Join the right division (12) to the assembled section using hardware part G,H and I.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



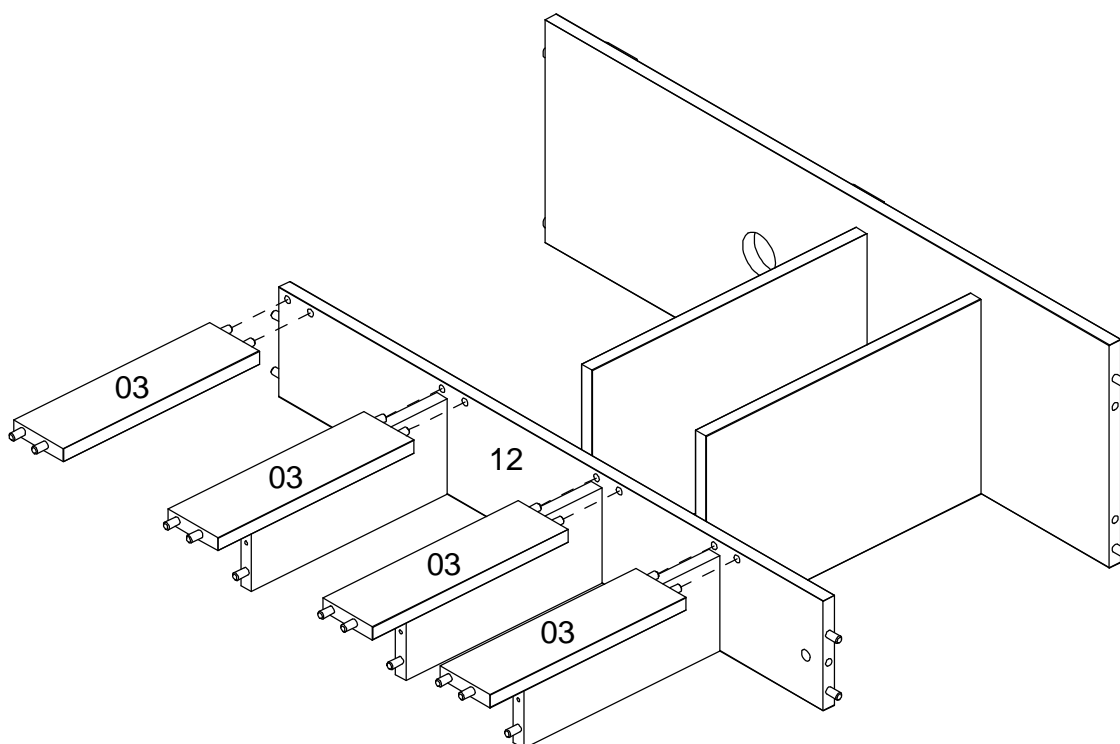
Step 19: Join the shelf smaller fixed module (02) to the assembled section using hardware part G,H and I.

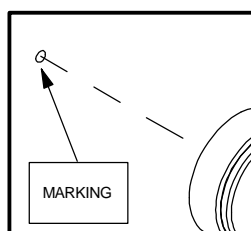
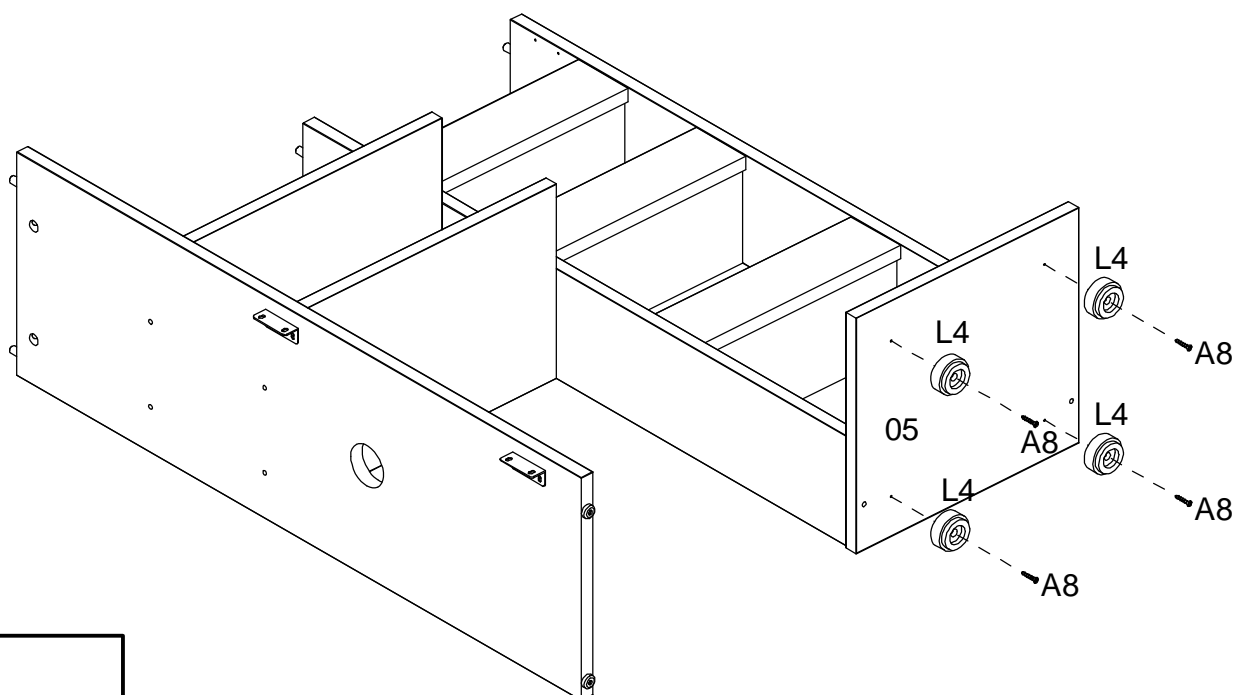
Step 22: Join the right side fixed module right (15) to the assembled section using hardware part G,H and I.

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

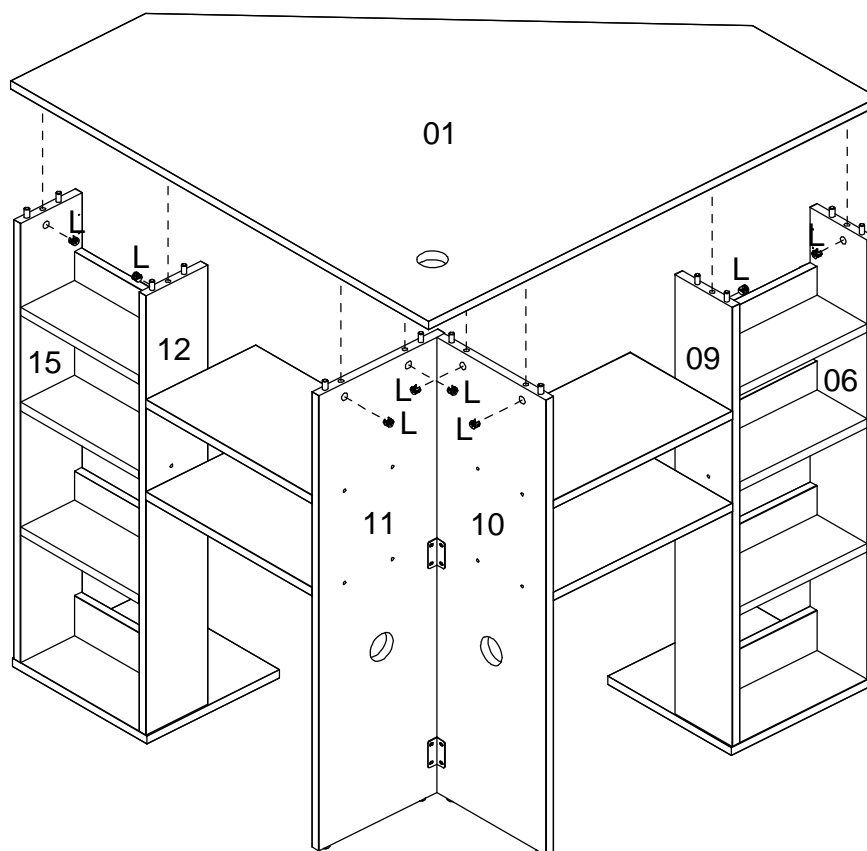
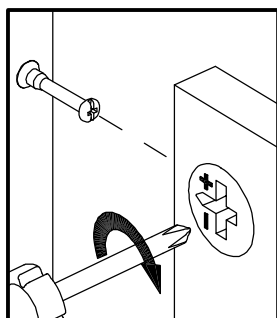


Step 24: Insert hardware part L4 using hardware part A8 with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

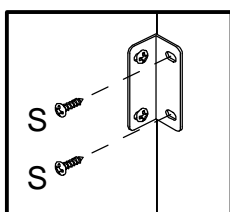
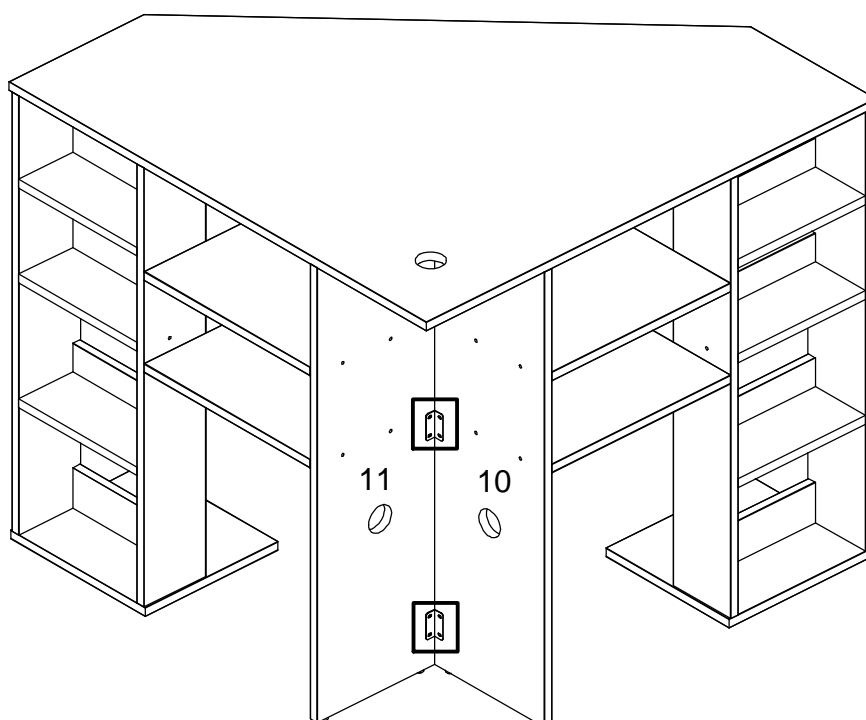


Step 25: Join the top (01) to the assembled section using hardware part L with a screwdriver (not provided)

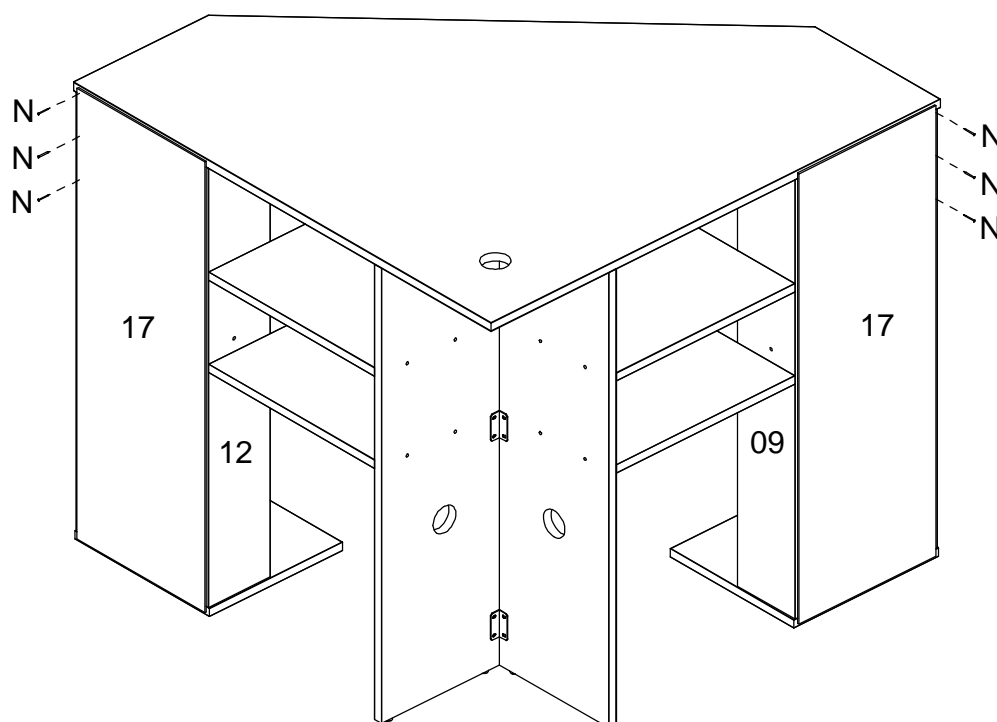
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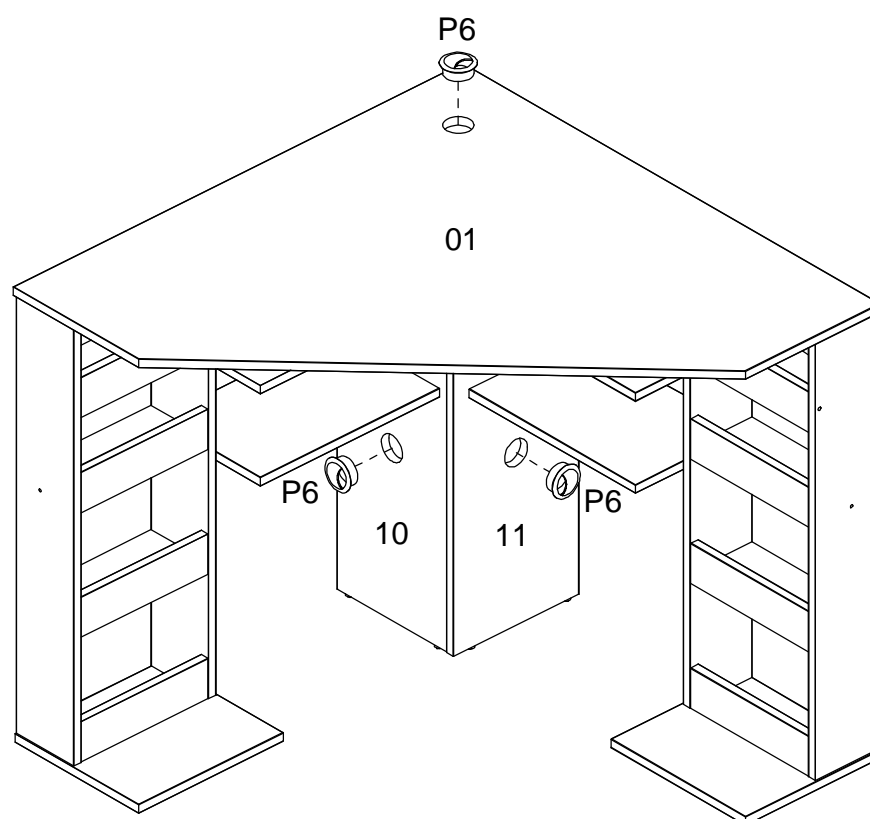
Step 26: Join the left coast (10) to the right coast (11) using hardware part S with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



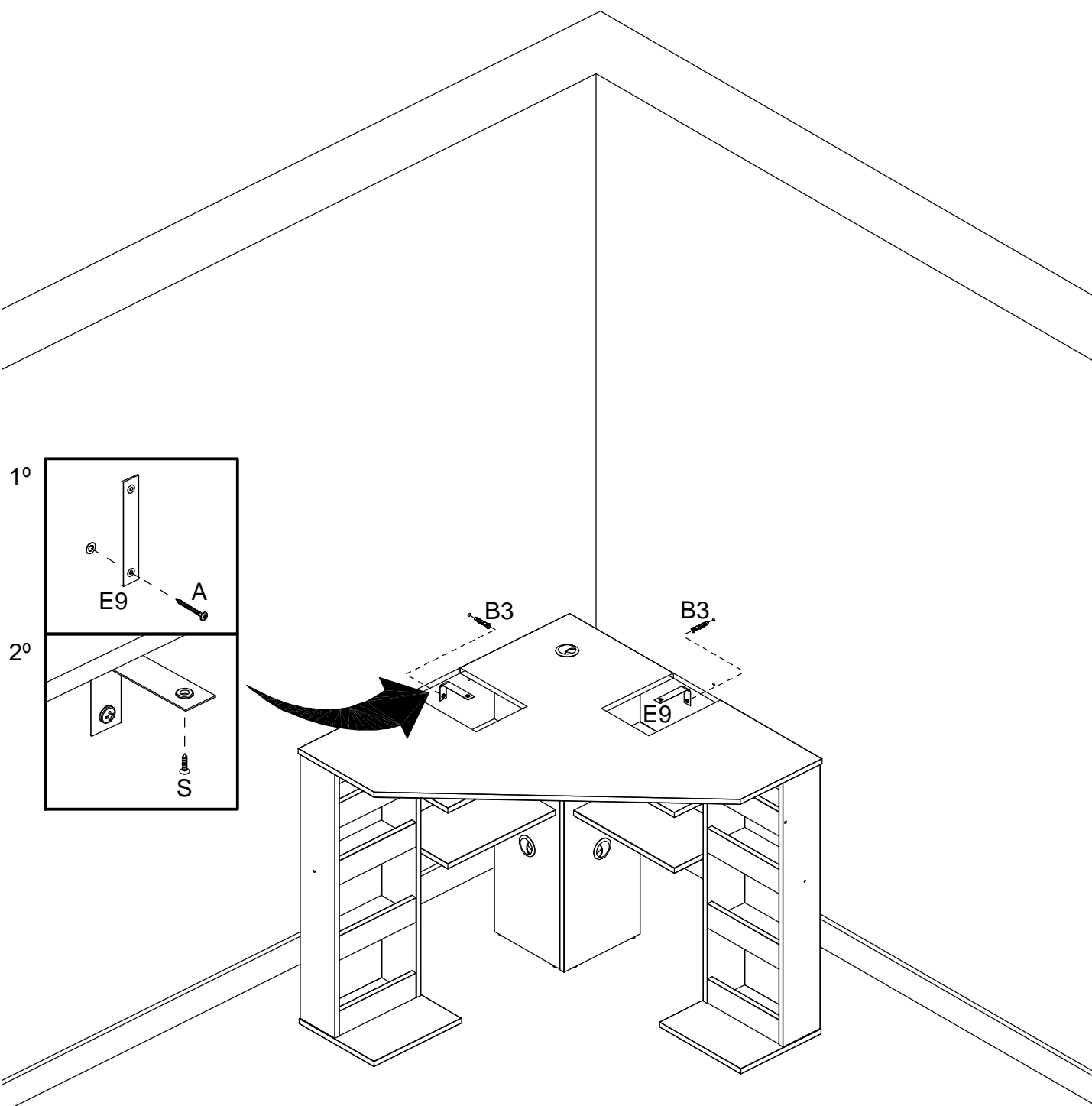
Step 27: Attach the coast (17) using the hardware part N and a small mallet (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Step 28: Insert hardware part P6.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

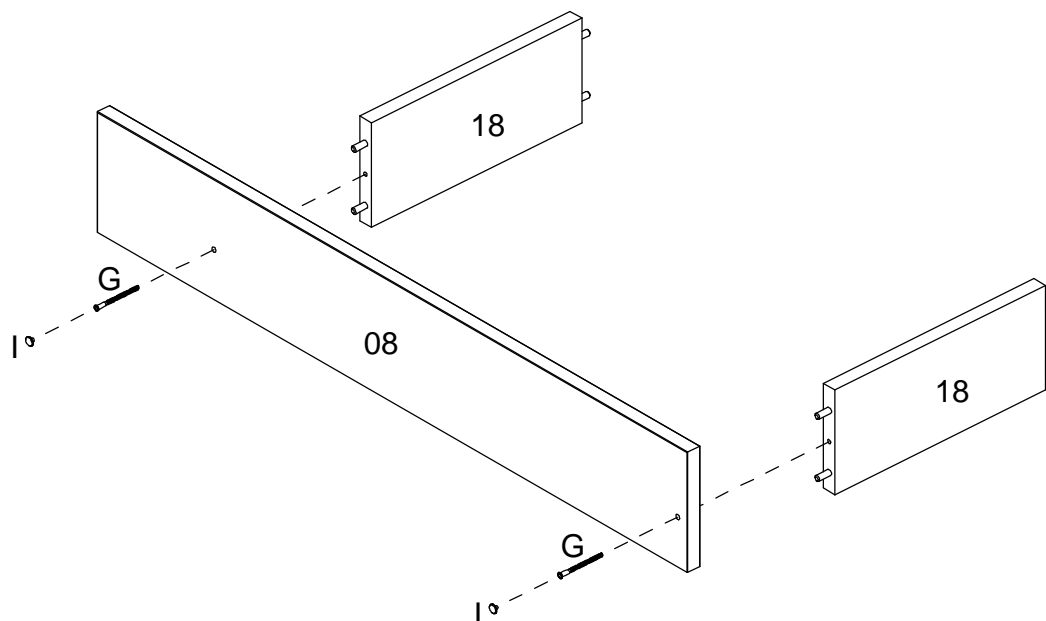


Step 29: To secure the item to the wall use hardware parts A, B3 and E9 using a drilling machine (not provided) and a screwdriver (not provided). Then attach hardware part S to the item with a screwdriver (not provided).
Birlea Furniture advise you use the wall straps provided to further enhance the safety of this product.



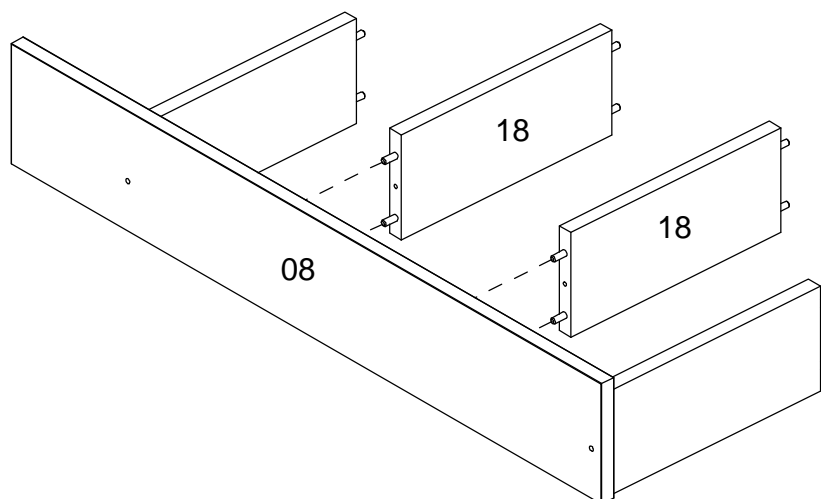
Step 30: Attach the right side door module left (08) to the smaller shelf door module (18) using hardware part G, H and I.

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

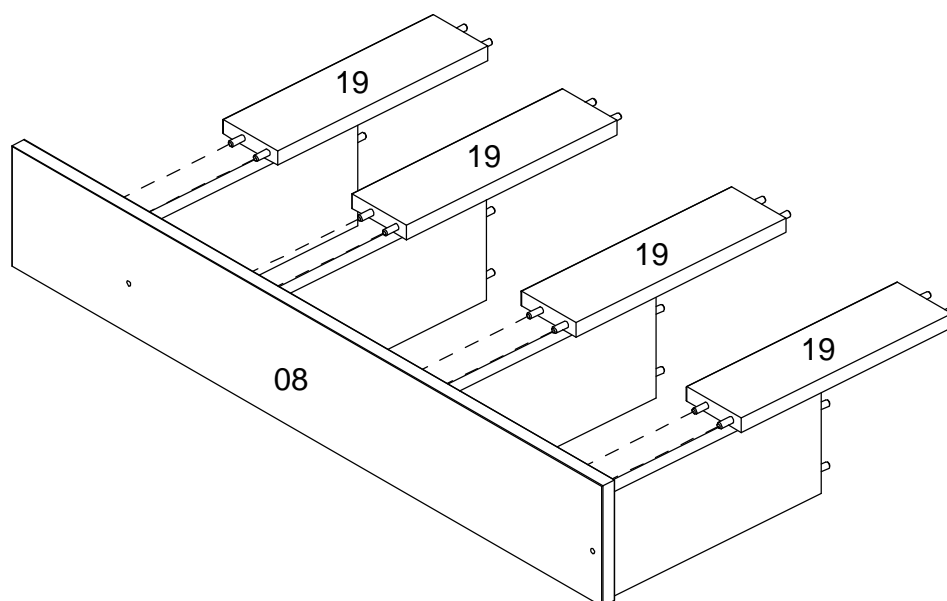


Step 31: Join the smaller shelf door module (18) to the assembled section.

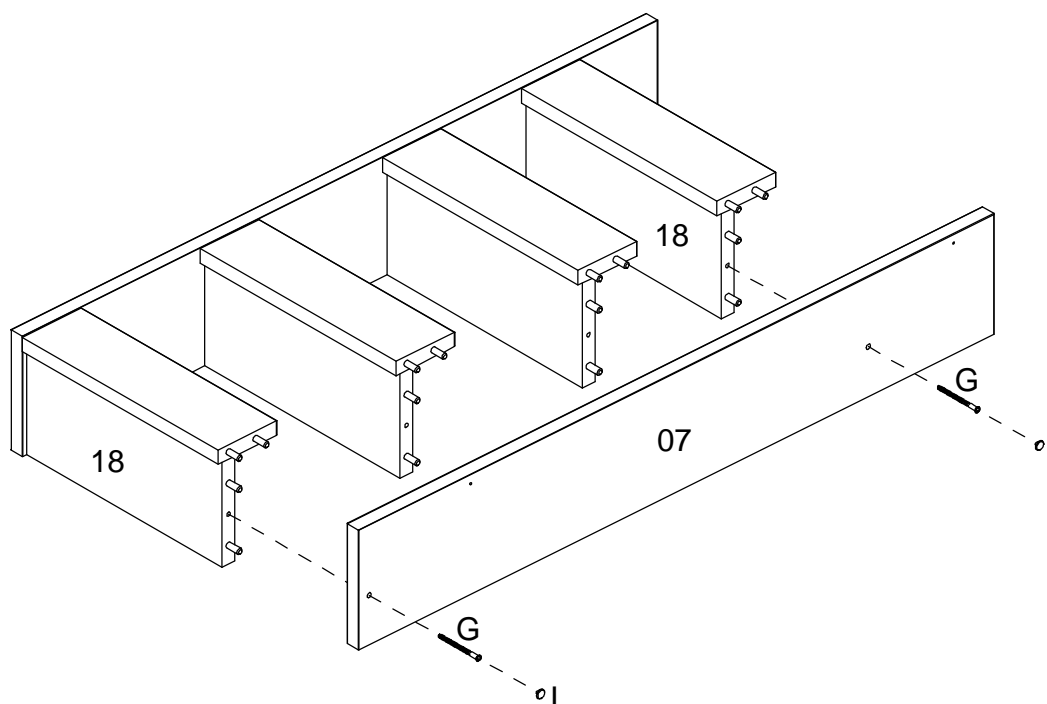

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

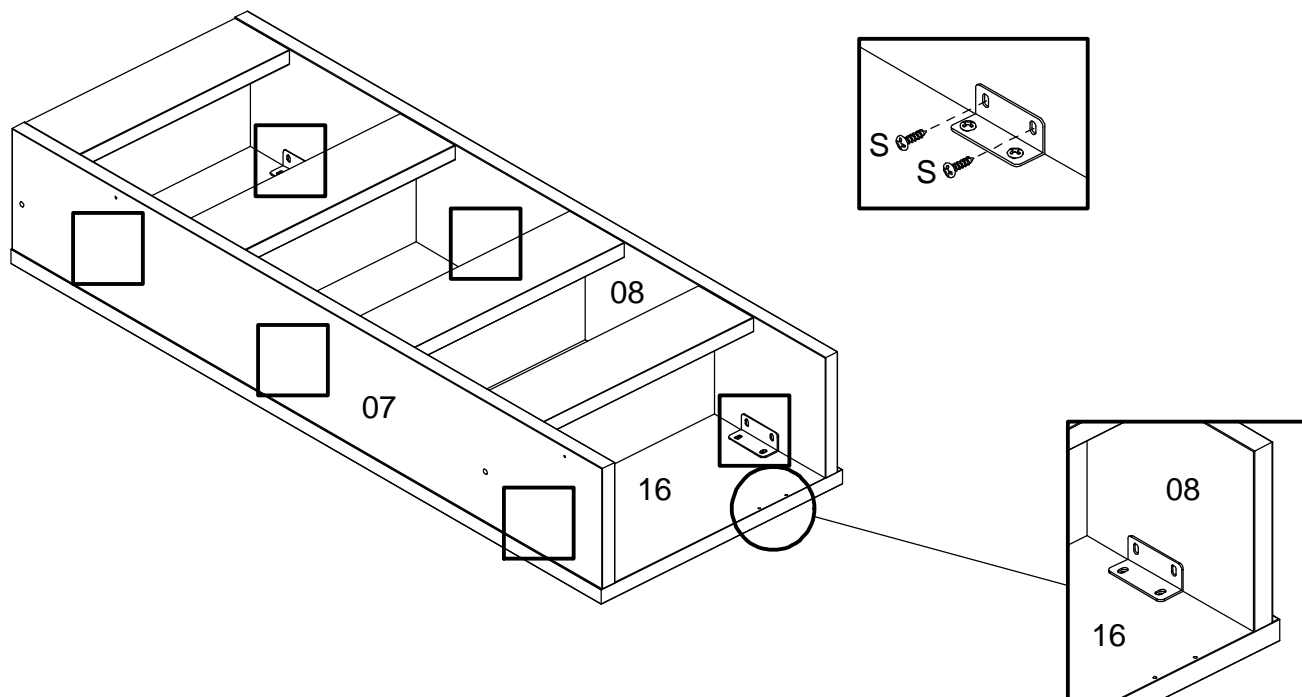


Step 33: Join the left side door module left (07) to the assembled section using hardware part G,H and I.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



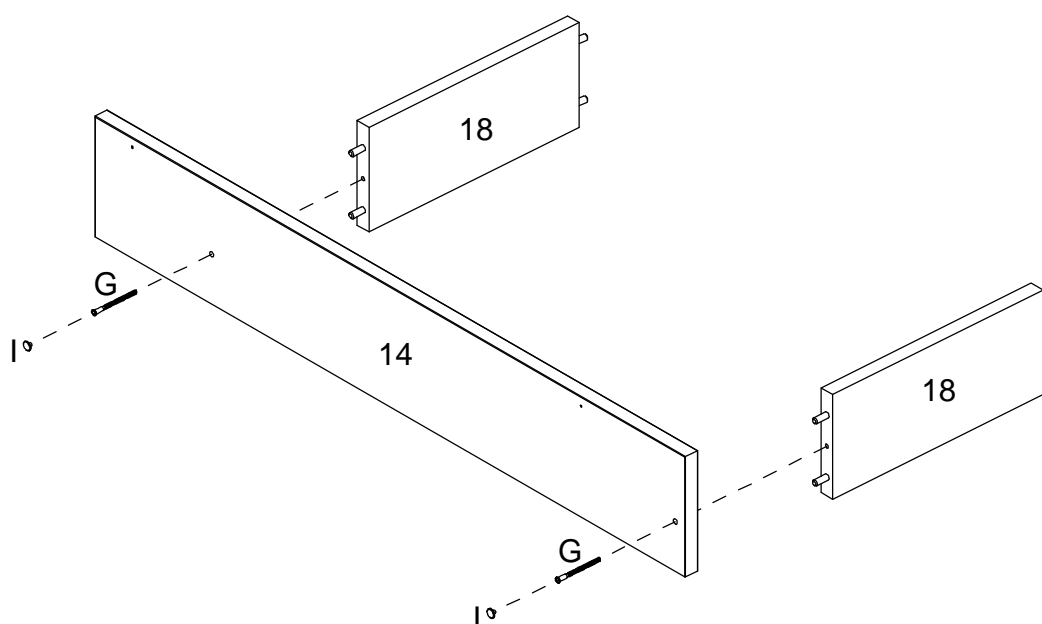
Step 34: Join the front door (16) to the assembled section using hardware part S with a screwdriver (not provided).

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.

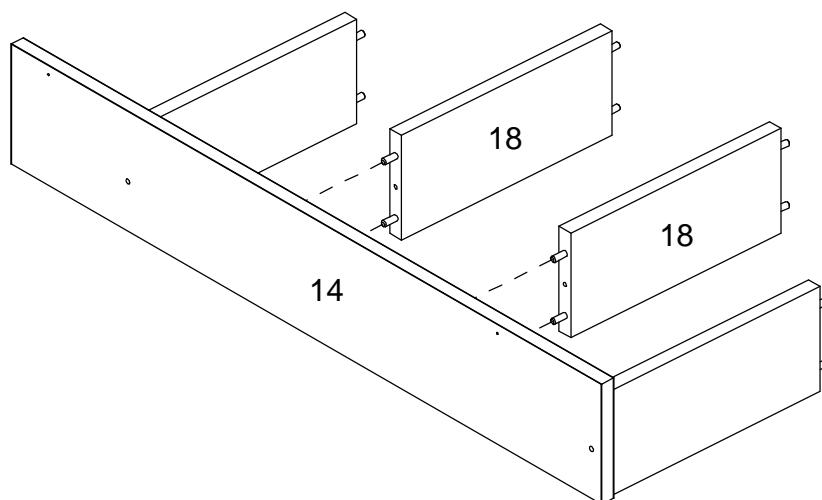


Step 35: Attach the right side door module right (14) to the smaller shelf door module (18) using hardware part G, H and I.

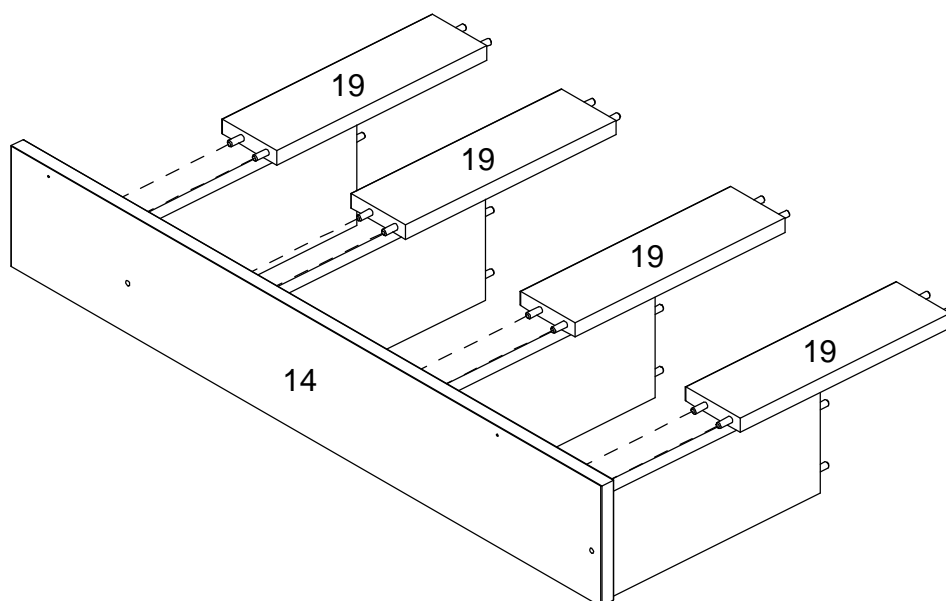

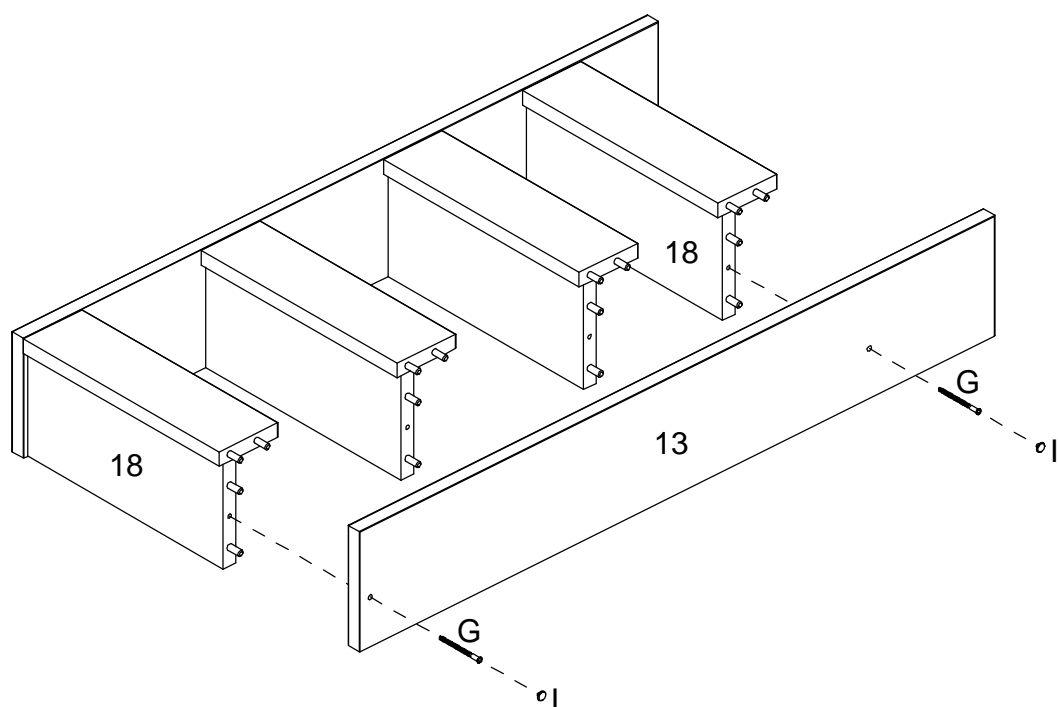
Step 36: Join the smaller shelf door module (18) to the assembled section.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



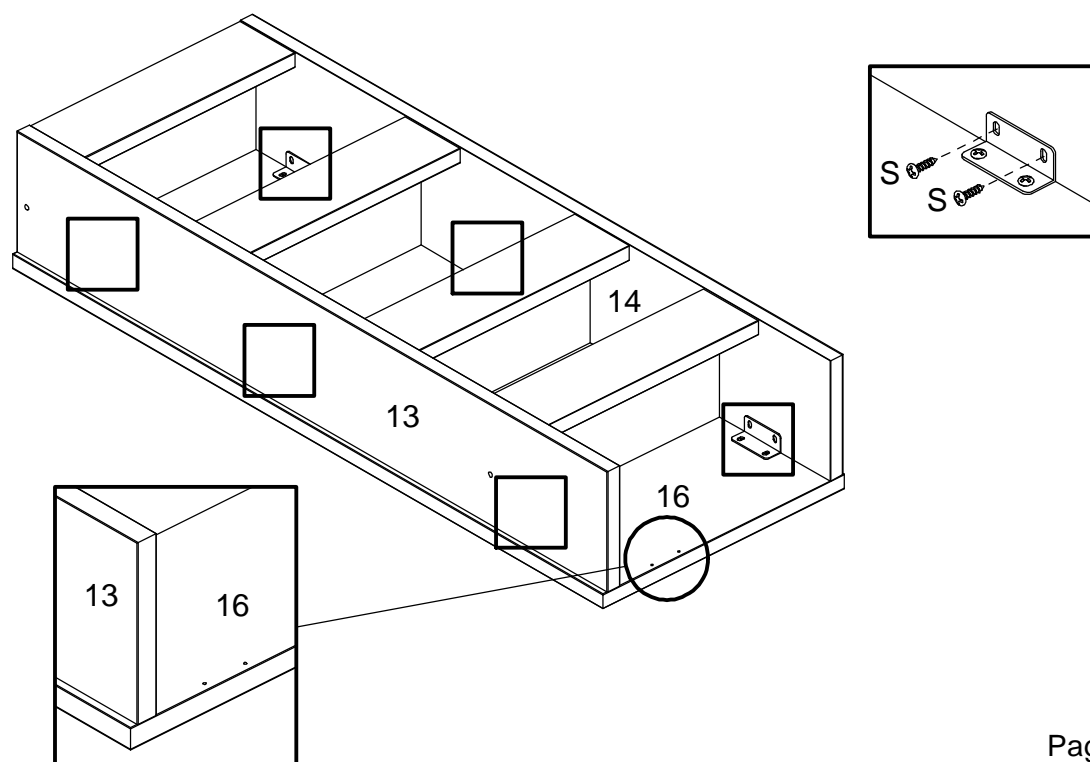
Step 37: Join the tray door module (19) to the assembled section.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



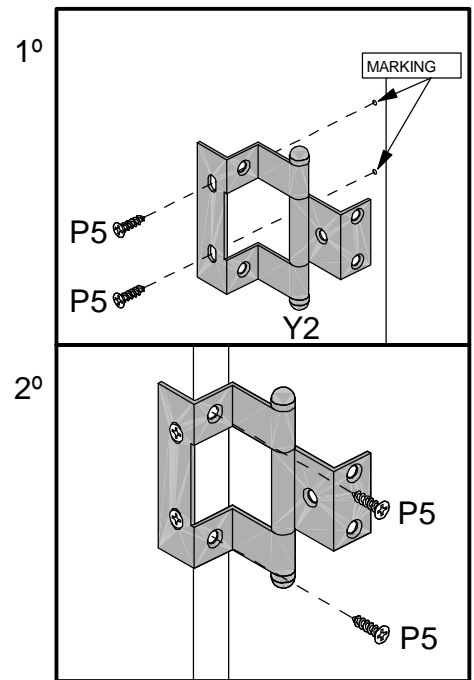
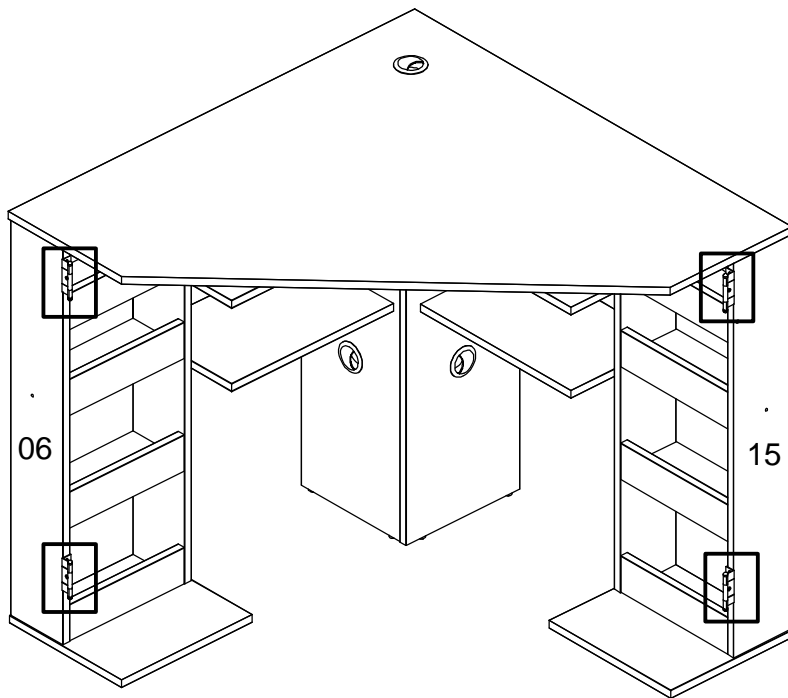
Step 38: Join the left side door module right (13) to the assembled section using hardware part G,H and I.
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



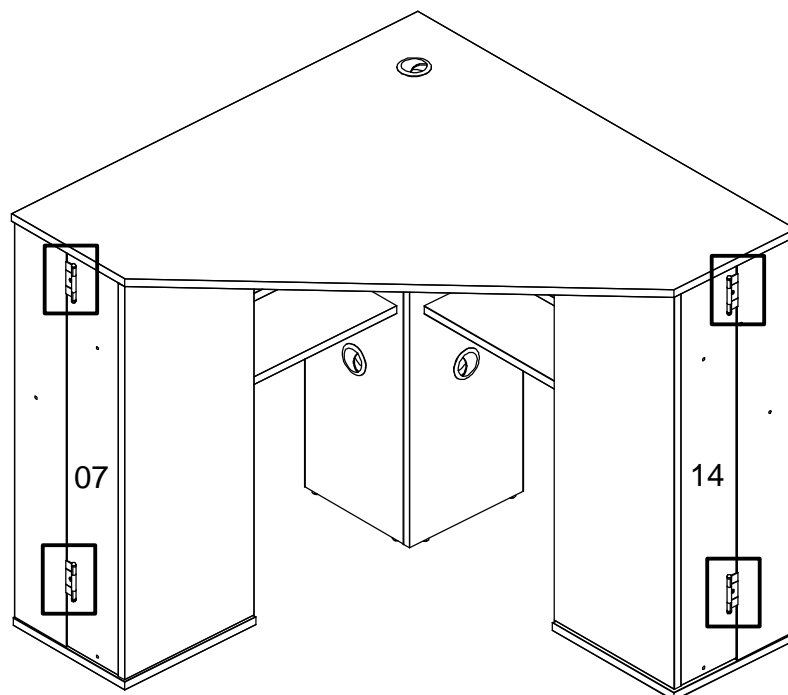
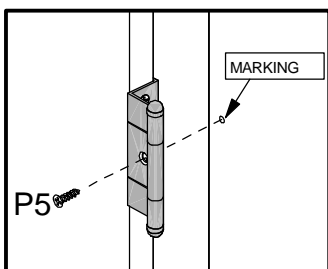
Step 39: Join the front door (16) to the assembled section using hardware part S with a screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



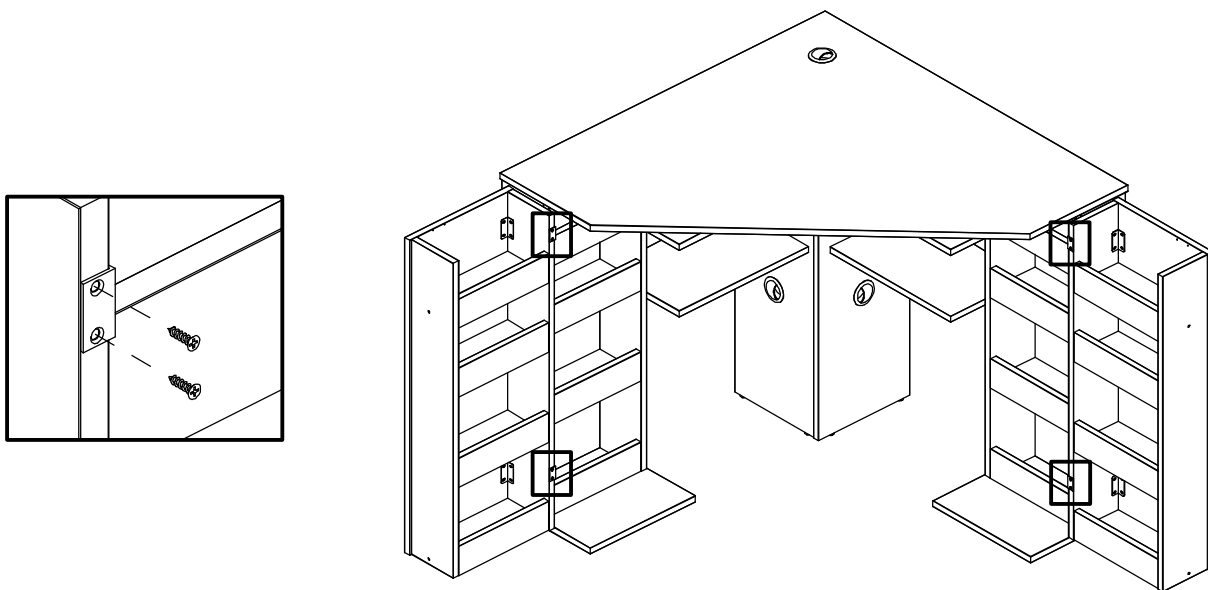
Step 40: Insert hardware part Y2 to the left side fixed module left (06) and right side fixed module right (15) using hardware part P5 and screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



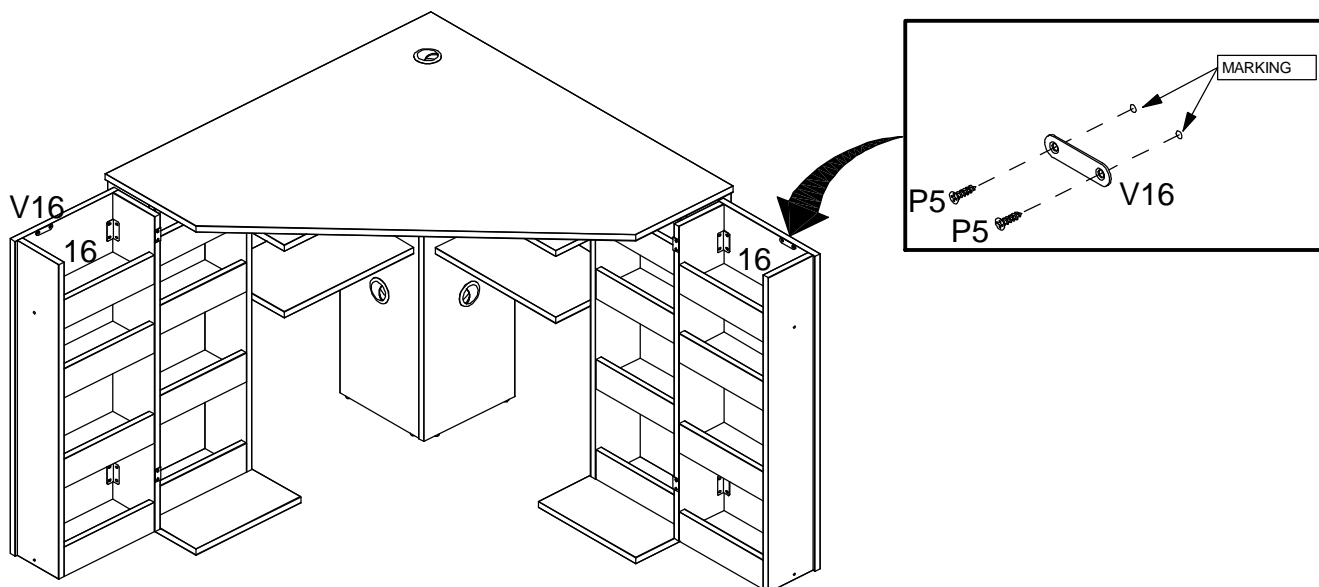
Step 41: Attach the doors left side door module left (07) and right side door module right (14) assembled section using hardware part P5 and screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Step 42: Open the doors to using hardware part P5 and screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Step 43: Insert hardware part V16 to the front door (16) using hardware part P5 and screwdriver (not provided).
DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



Please dispose of all packaging safely.

General Care & Maintenance

Wipe clean with a slightly damp cloth.
Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

Periodically check all screw & fixings to ensure they are secure.

When moving your product, carefully lift into place. Never drag or push the product across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints. If the product is used on hard flooring, such as wood or laminated floor, you must place some protection under the legs to stop the product from moving. If this is not adhered to, it could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.
