WILSON Fabric Ottoman Bed



Important before assembly:

Read these instructions carefully before assembling or using the product.

Please check the contents of the boxes before attempting to assemble this product. The instructions will have a checklist of parts and fittings.

It would be sensible to lay a rug or a carpet on the floor where you intend to assemble the product, to avoid scratches and damaging the product or the floor.

Assemble the product as close to its intended final location/room as possible.

Do NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame.

Health & Safety:

This product or some parts of this product will be heavy. Please use an assistant when lifting.

Please keep small parts out of reach of children.




Always use on a level, even surface.

DO NOT use this product unless all fixings are secured.




These tools are not necessary, but may help to assemble certain parts of the product.



Do NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame.

Never drag or push the pieces across a hard or stone floor as this will cause damage to the joints. Use a carpet or a rug for extra care.

Important Informations

Please take the time to carefully read through the whole of these instructions before you commence.

Keep these instructions for future reference.

Unpack, inspect and check of all of the contents.

Please dispose of all packing safely.

Small components parts could choke a child if swallowed.

We strongly recommend that you keep children well away from the work area.

It would be sensible to lay a sheet or blanket on the floor where you intend to work to avoid scratching this product and protect your floor.

This product is heavy. Take extreme care when lifting to avoid personal injury or damage to the product.

This bed is heavy. Always lift the bed with two people.

Assemble the product as close to its intended final position in the room as possible.

Keep any sharp objects away from the bed frame.

HANDY HINT: If you keep the hardware in a bowl during assembly you will be less likely to lose them.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

DO NOT: jump on this bed frame.

DO NOT: use this bed frame if any part is missing, damaged or worn.

DO NOT: use this bed frame unless all fixing are secured.

DO NOT: push the bed frame as this will damage the legs.

Always lift the bed frame with two people to reposition.

Always use on a level, even surface.

Following installation of the mechanism lift / pull the base up and down a few times to free of the system – the gas cylinders fitted to the system may be stiff when first time used or if the system has not been operated for a period of time. The mattress must be fitted to the base.

Use the strap handle to lift up the mattress base using two hands – Pull the mattress base down using two hands equally spaced from the centre of the mattress.

WARNING: If this bed is placed on a non-carpeted floor you must place some protection under all legs to stop the bed frame from moving. If this is not adhered to there is no guarantee if the bed frame collapses.

WARNING: This ottoman bed frame has a powerful, mechanism and after assembly should only be opened when mattress is in place.

CAUTION

DO NOT: allow children to operate the mechanism.

DO NOT: allow children near the lift base when operating the mechanism.

DO NOT: allow children in the area of the internal storage base.















Keep hands clear of the mechanism when operating the system.


DO NOT: stand inside the bed / on the internal storage base.

DO NOT: overload the internal storage.




Step 1:

To fix the left side rail (C) and right side rail (C) to the headboard (A) and footboard (B) you will need to use hardware parts 4 with the M5 allen key (13).


Step 2:

To fix the L-SHAPE BRACKET (14) to the footboard (B) you will need to use hardware parts 3 with the M5 allen key (13).

In order to make sure the side rail not bend inside, you will need to fix the part Support Center (J), by using hardware (3) with Allen Key M5 (13)

DO NOT fully tighten the screw part until all the screw is in the right hole position.





To install Hydraulic (H) to the (G), you will need to loose out the M8 HEX nut from the part (G). After the part (H) go inside the position, put back the M8 HEX Nut and tighten it using M8 Spanner (11).

To install the complete set of (G) to the left and right side rail (C), you will need to use hardware 5 and 7 with Allen key M5 (13).

To assemble part G, it is a must to make sure the hole go into the right position as shown in (NOTE). And before tighten the screw, please make sure part G is in same alignment in between left and right side rail.

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the bed frame and will invalidate any claims.

Step 6:

To put the 2 X BOTTOM PANEL (K), you will need to slightly raise up the beds from the footboard (B) and slot in the panel go direct to the headboard and continue the second pieces there after the first pieces was in right position.



COMPLETE

WARNING:

Take care when assembling the base, assemble the ottoman as closed to its final position. The Ottoman has a powerful mechanism and after assembly should only be closed and opened when the mattress is in place.

General Care

Wipe clean with a slightly damp soft cloth.

Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

When moving your furniture, carefully lift into place. Never drag or push the pieces across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints and could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.

Recommendations

Periodical re-tightening of fixings

Warning

This bed frame is heavy. Please use an assistant when lifting.


Notes

We've tried to make this bed frame as easy to assemble as possible. In the unlikely event that you have problems putting it together or damaged or missing pieces, please contact your retailer directly you purchased it from who will be able to resolve any issues.

When've correctly adjusted the centre support leg on this bed frame should be raised by 5mm from the floor with added weight of the mattress and bedding.

This bed may fail if it is used on a wooden floor WITHOUT the use of non-slip pads on all the support legs and bed posts.

If the bed is to be moved, carefully lift the bed frame rather than dragging to ensure that the centre legs do not become twisted and buckle.



Please dispose of all packaging safely.

General Care & Maintenance

Wipe clean with a slightly damp cloth.

Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

Periodically check all screw & fixings to ensure they are secure.

When moving your product, carefully lift into place. Never drag or push the pieces across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints and could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.
